This pertains to the target activity on the Maintenance and Protection of Coastal and Marine Ecosystem (e.g. reduction of threats and enforcement)- Conduct of direct activities (Coastal clean-up and Crown of Thorns extraction) under 001 Management of Coastal and Marine Resources/Areas of Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS), Taytay-San Vicente, Palawan.

Please be informed that on May 13, 2023, this Office participated in the conduct of simultaneous coastal clean-up activity at Barangay New Guinlo and Barangay Pancol, all within the municipality of Taytay, Palawan. In Barangay New Guinlo, a total of fifty (50) sacks of garbage weighing 100kgs were collected consist of assorted plastics (i.e. labo, candy wrapper, instant coffee sachet), fishing net, nylon, and empty bottles. Likewise, in Barangay Pancol, a total of eight (8) sacks of garbage weighing an estimated of 65kgs were collected consist of 30kgs of plastic bottle (softdrinks), 27kgs of plastics (i.e. labo, disposable cups, shampoo sachet, assorted plastics) and 8kgs of diapers.

The activity was attended by a total of forty-one (41) participants composed of fifteen (15) males and twenty-three (23) females including three (3) Senior Citizen in Barangay New Guinlo, Taytay, Palawan and thirty-nine (39) participants composed of eleven (11) males and twenty-eight (28) females in Barangay Pancol, Taytay, Palawan.

The collected garbage's were properly disposed in the designated Material Recovery Facility (MRF) of the barangay.

Be informed further that, on May 30, 2023, this Office conducted the extraction of Crown of Thorns (COTs) at Barge Laot, Barangay Tumbod, Taytay, Palawan. The team were able to collect a total of eight (8) COTs weighing an approximate of five (5) to seven (7) kgs and ranging from 30-50 centimeter. Likewise, said COTs were buried for proper disposition. The team were composed of seven (7) males and one (1) female.

This Office recommends to continuously conducted the regular monitoring of COTs in order to minimize its proliferation as well as strengthen the Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) campaign to the Barangay LGUs in coordination with the partners regarding the Republic Act 9003 known as Ecological Solid Waste Management (ESWM).
