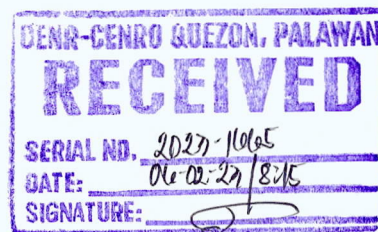

**SUBJECT : REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED ACTIVITIES FOR THE CELEBRATION OF MONTH OF THE OCEAN (MOO) 2023**



This pertains with the Presidential Proclamation No. 57, series of 1998 declaring the Month of May of every year as “THE MONTH OF THE OCEAN” in the Philippines and providing for the conduct of activities for its Celebration in which instructed all local governments, state colleges and universities, government-owned or controlled corporations whose operations are directly or indirectly relevant to the development and management of our ocean resources, non-governmental organizations, people’s organizations, and the private sector, shall spearhead the observance of “The Month of the Ocean” of each year through the conduct of activities that highlight conservation, protection and sustainable management of Philippine coastal and ocean resources;

In view hereof, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) – Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (DENR-CENRO) Quezon, Palawan facilitated the following activities in line with the celebration of Month of the Ocean with this year’s theme “Sustainably Feed the Global Population, to wit:

**1. COASTAL CLEAN – UP**

Lasyap Beach, Bgy. Maasin, Quezon, Palawan

Lasyap Beach is one of the tourist destinations in the Municipality of Quezon, Palawan located in Bgy. Maasin, Quezon, Palawan.

On May 23, 2023, the DENR – CENRO Quezon, Palawan spearheaded a coastal clean – up within the coastal area of Lasyap. Invited participants were the resort owners within the area together with their representatives, Barangay Officials, volunteers and CENRO Quezon employees. The activity was started with a prayer followed by a welcome message from the barangay Official and an inspirational message given by CENRO Renato S. Gonzaga. Aside from giving an inspirational message, CENRO Gonzaga also discussed the Presidential Proclamation No. 57 to enlighten the volunteers on the Month of the Ocean emphasizing this year theme “Sustainably Feed the Global Population”. six (66) volunteers were participated in, thirty – eight (38) male and twenty – eight (28) female with a total of 10 sacks of trash were collected. Cigarettes butts, Pet bottles and Disposable cups were the most trash collected. The collected trash were properly disposed by the LGU to the Sanitary Landfill.

**2. INFORMATION, EDUCATION & COMMUNICATION (IEC) CAMPAIGN**  
Aramaywan Elementary School (AES), Bgy. Aramaywan, Quezon, Palawan

On May 22, 2023, the IEC Team of DENR-CENRO Quezon, Palawan conducted an Information, Education & Communication campaign to the Grade 5 students (2 sections) of the Aramaywan Elementary School. The campaign was started with a prayer followed by a welcome message by the Teacher In-charge, Norlyn Malvas. Topics are DENR Mandates and Organizational Structure discussed by Forester II Janes T. Panes, Planning Officer, Climate Change being discussed and explained by the Information Officer, Marine Debris by ECOMS II Elany P. Sanico, Pawikan by ECOMS II Michelle J. Sebido and Child Marriage by Forest Technician II Margelyn S. Mandapat. Right after each topic discussions Forest Technician II Richelle C. Ojario facilitated a short Question and Answer portion and a student who answers correctly would receive a pen or a water tumbler. A total of forty-eight (48) pens and three (3) water tumblers were given to the students in a total of fifty – eight (58) students were participated in the campaign, twenty-one (21) male and thirty-seven (37) female.

These conducted activities were one of the many ways we can help combat the issue of marine debris, raise awareness on marine pollution, improve waste management and an action to inspire people on the desire for a cleaner, safer, and healthier environment.
