In connection with the above cited subject, please be informed that the undersigned personnel conducted wildlife traffic monitoring in Calapan City Air and Sea ports and Puerto Galera Sea ports for the month of June, 2023.

That, on June 05, 2023, the team conducted monitoring in Calapan City Seaport located at Brgy. San Antonio, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro. We coordinated with Port Police Superintendent, Franzer Rayos of Philippine Ports Authority, Calapan City. Accordingly there were no incidence of transport/arrival of wildlife in the port for the month of May to June, 2023. Also during our monitoring on that day there were no incidence of transport/arrival of Wildlife.

That, after our monitoring in seaport we monitored the Calapan City Airport located at Brgy. Suqui, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro. We coordinated with Civil Intelligence Security, Marvelous Marvin Soriquez of Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines. Accordingly, there were no incidence of transport/arrival of Wildlife. The airport is rarely use only by known people/VIPs, military personnel and aviation school.

That, on June 06, 2023, the team conducted monitoring in Puerto Galera Seaports located in Barangays of Balatero and Muelle, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro. We coordinated with OIC, Ma. Elena A. Gozar of Port of Puerto Galera. Accordingly, there is no incidence of transport/arrival of wildlife in the said ports on the month of May to June, 2023. Also during our monitoring on that day there is no incidence of transport/arrival of Wildlife.

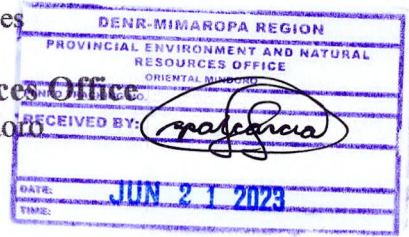

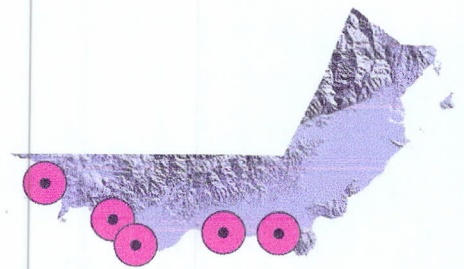
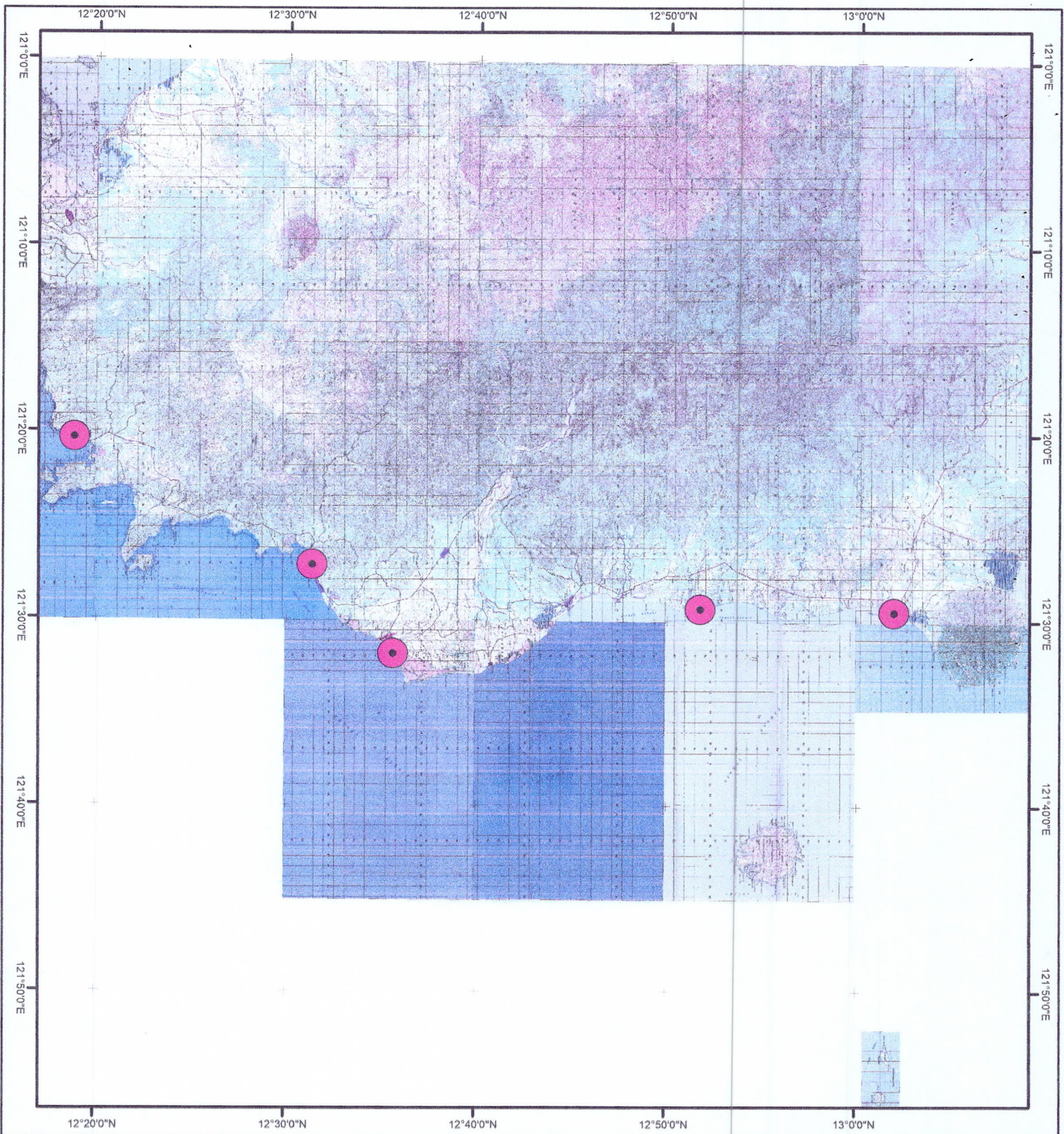
During monitoring with the partner agencies (LGU and PPA), the teams did not see/observed smuggled forest products and wildlife.

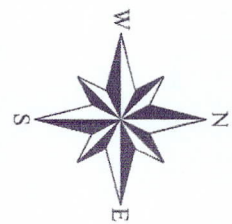
