

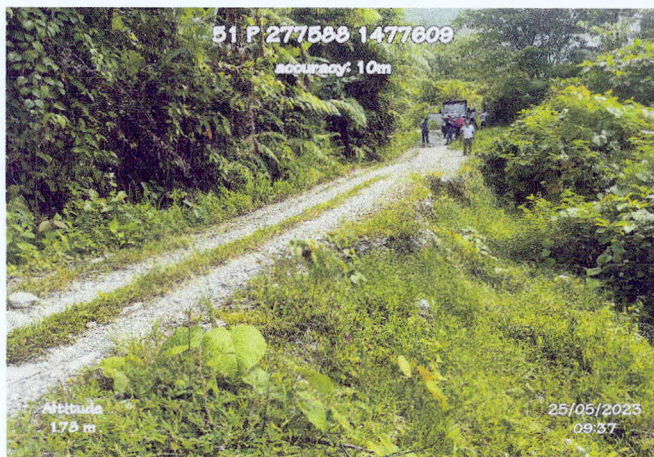

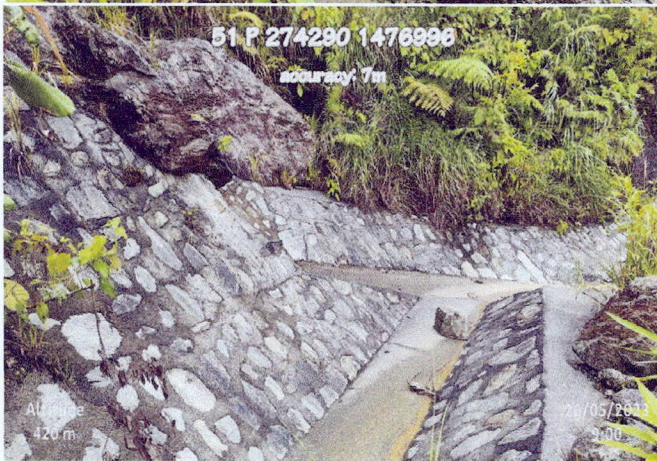



COMPANY PROFILE

- **ORMIN POWER, INC.** (Ormin Power) is a power generating company duly organized and existing under the laws of the republic of the Philippines with corporate address at ORMECO Compound, Barangay Sta. Isabel, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro. It was duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) on April 27, 2009.
- Ormin Power is a dynamic emerging power company focused on the exploration and development of environment friendly, timeless and renewable source of energy. Its primary purpose is to provide power generation and electricity supply services to distribution utilities, including but not limited to, electric cooperatives; to install, build, own, lease, maintain, or operate power generation facilities, using fossil fuel, natural gas, or renewable energy; and to engage any and all acts which may be necessary, or convenient, in the furtherance of such power generation services.

I. PROJECT / PLANT DESCRIPTION

10 MW INABASAN MINI HYDRO POWER PLANT

- Mini-Hydro will contribute immensely to the stabilization of supply of power and in lowering the generation cost mix in Oriental Mindoro. In this light, it is rational that more renewable energy projects such as mini-hydro plants are needed to be put up to provide for a more stable base load operation, reduce the system's loss and lower further the generation mix of Php 6.50/kwh as of May 2008. Not only this, the international oil prices per barrel is continuously increasing, thus our government is facing the challenge of safeguarding the Philippine economy from the adverse effects of soaring petroleum cost.
- The development of the country's hydropower resources is essential to meeting energy demand over the next ten years. The Department of Energy aims to double current generating capacity from hydropower resources by 2013, as provided for under the Renewable Energy Policy Framework.

- In particular, Oriental Mindoro has the most number of hydropower potentials totaling to 14, which can contribute 137,520 kW of the total 193,737kW estimated for the region. The biggest potential sites located in the said province particularly in the municipalities of San Teodoro (39,500kW), Bongabon (28,000kW), Baco (24,000 kW) and Naujan (18,000kW). Hydropower potential in MIMAROPA accounts for 15.4% of Luzon's over-all resource potential.
- For the exploration, development and utilization of the hydropower resources, Ormin power has secured the following contracts, permits, licenses and certifications from different Government Agencies, to wit:

- **Hydropower Service Contract.** On March 25, 2010, Ormin Power has been appointed and constituted by the Department of Energy as the exclusive party to explore, develop and utilize the Renewable Energy (RE) resources within contract area along Inabasan River in the Municipality of San Teodoro, Oriental Mindoro pursuant to Hydropower Service Contract (RE Contract).
- **Department of Energy Certificate of Registration.** On March 25, 2010, Ormin power was registered as a RE Developer of 10MW Inabasan Hydroelectric Power Plant (Inabasan Project) located in the Municipality of San Teodoro, Oriental Mindoro by virtue of the Certificate of registration issued by the Department of Energy with Registration No. HSC-2010-03-132.
- **Environmental Compliance Certificate.** On July 30, 2010, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources issued an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC-R4B-1007-0110) in favor of the Inabasan Mini-Hydropower Project with total area of 47,000.00 square meters with plant capacity of 10MW located in San Teodoro, Oriental Mindoro.

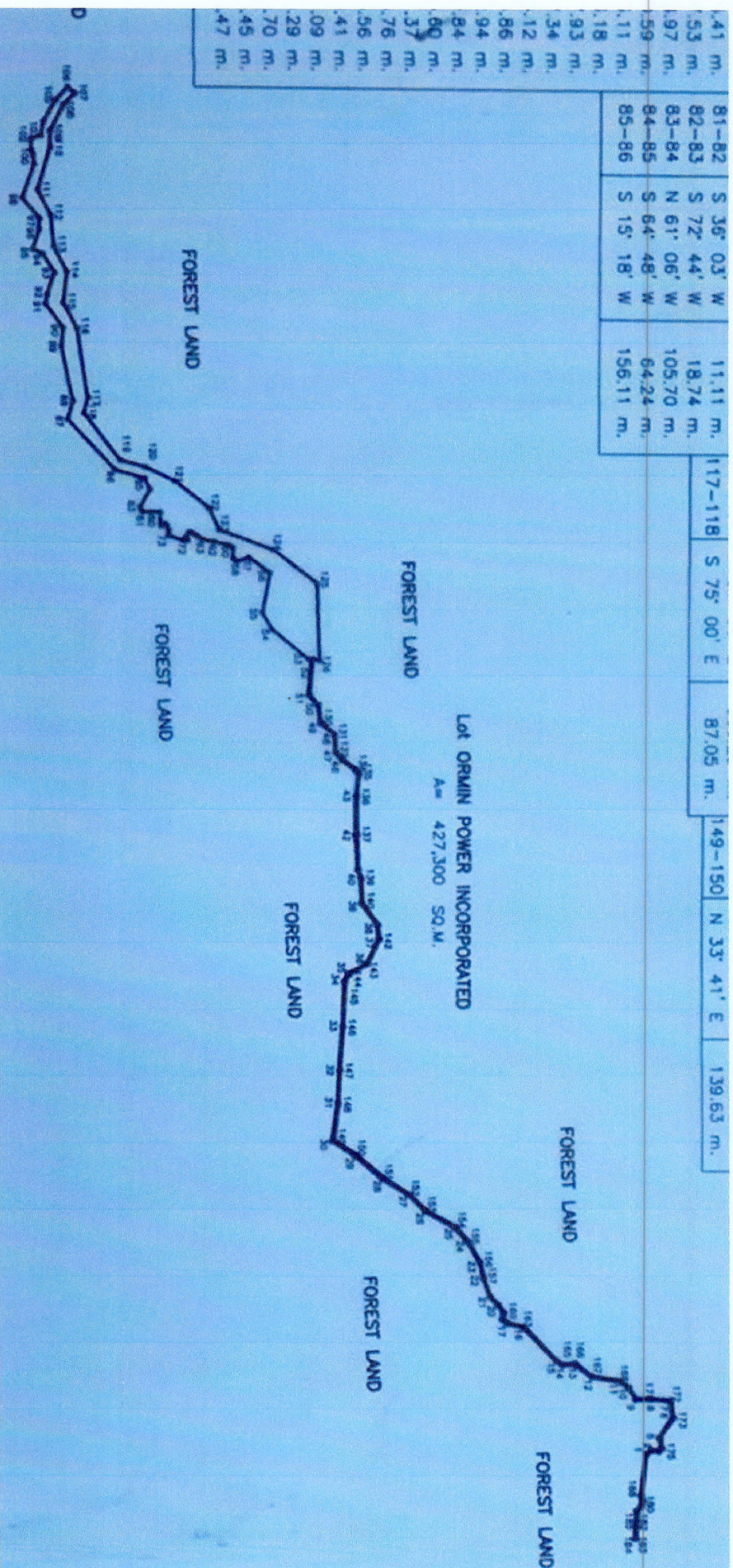
- **Compliance Certificate (Certificate of Compliance to the FPIC Process and Certificate that the Community has given its Consent).**

On December 20, 2011, the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) issued a Compliance Certificate (Certificate of Compliance to the FPIC Process and Certificate that the Community has given its Consent) with Control Number CCRIV-11-12-49 certifying that Ormin power has substantially complied with the procedures and process requirements for the issuance of Certificate Precondition and the Free and Prior Informed Written Consent prescribed under NCIP Administrative Order No. 01, Series of 2006, otherwise known as the FPIC Guidelines of 2006 for its Mini-Hydro Power Project located along the Sitios Alukmay, Langkaan, kawayan, Inabasan/Biawan, Kapasian and Suyong, Barangay Caagutayan, all in the Municipality of San Teodoro, Province of Oriental Mindoro.

- Under NCIP En Banc Resolution No. A-060, Series of 2011 dated December 1, 2011, the NCIP approved the issuance of a Certificate Precondition for the proposed Mini-Hydro Project subject to the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by the Ormin Power, the indigenous People/indigenous Cultural Communities of Sitio Alukmay, Langkaan, kawayan, Inabasan/Biawan, Kapasian and Suyong, Barangay Caagutayan, all in the Municipality of San Teodoro, Province of Oriental Mindoro, and the NCIP.
- **Water Permit.** On January 26, 2012, the NWRB issued Water Permit No. 022530 in favor of Ormin Power which superseded the Conditional Water Permit No. 06-16-10-009 previously issued.

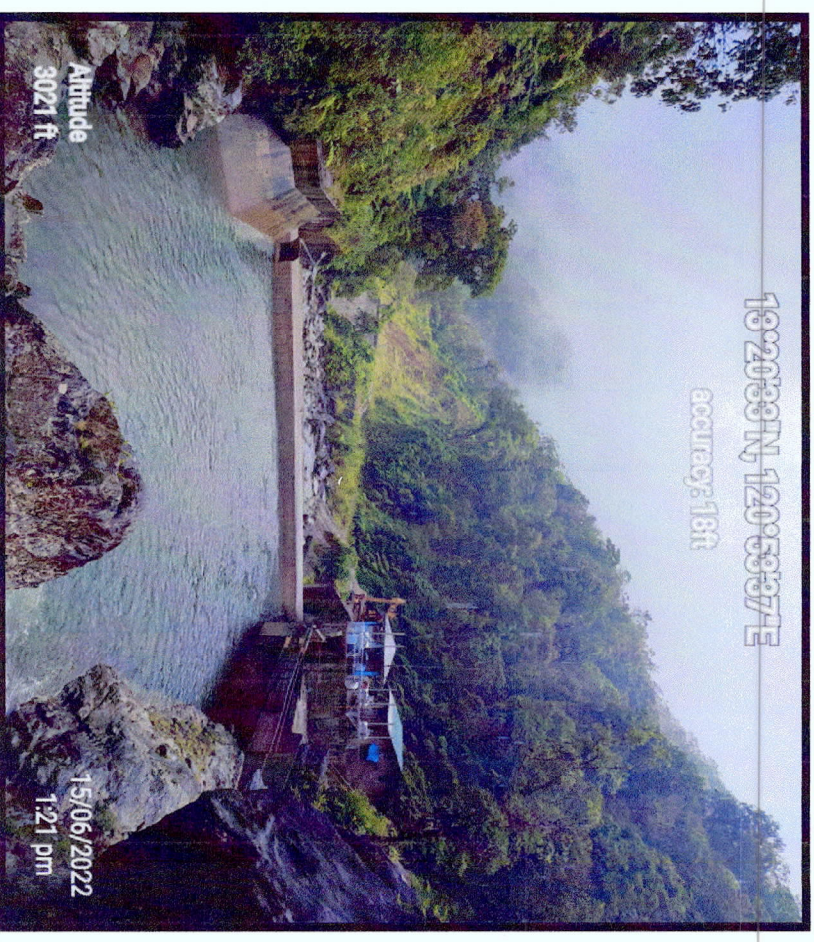
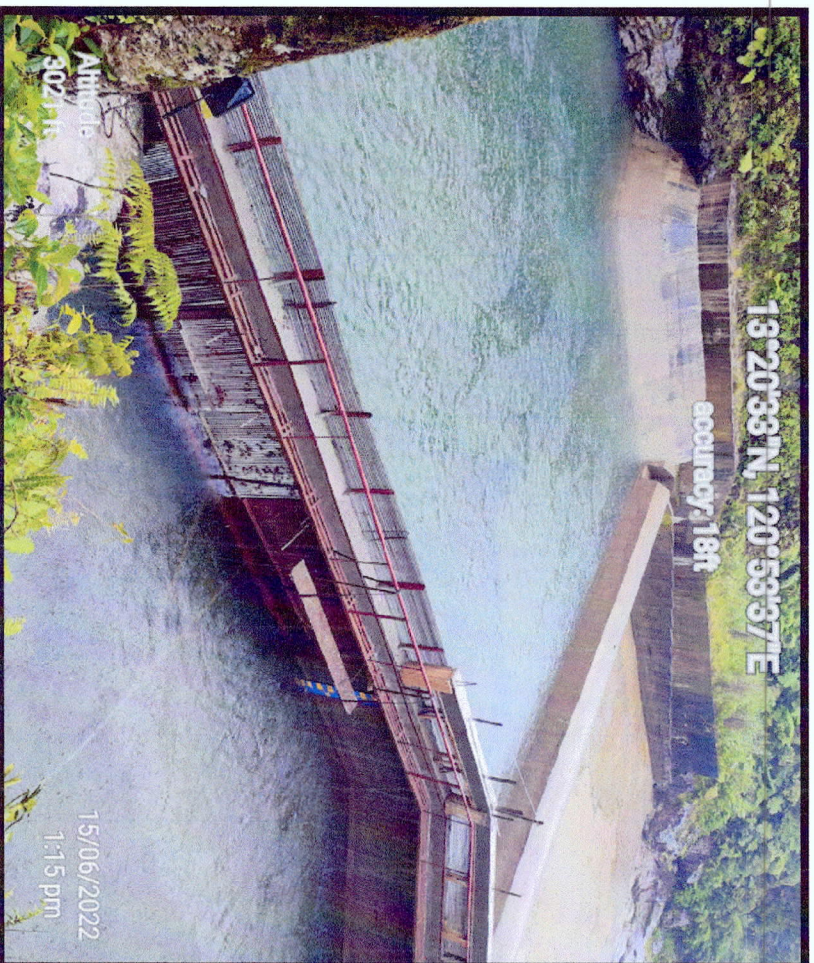
- Pursuant to the RE Contract, Ormin Power has completed and concluded the Feasibility Study and Detailed Engineering Design of the Inabasan project. Presently, Ormin Power is Pursuing the development of the Inabasan project.
- On July 18, 2012, a Power Supply Agreement (PSA) was executed by and between ORMECO and Ormin Power for the Inabasan River Mini-Hydro Power plant project.
- The PSA cooperation period shall be for a period of twenty five (25) years effective upon the commercial operation of the Power Station has been declared by and between Ormin Power and ORMECO, subject to extension upon agreement of the Parties.

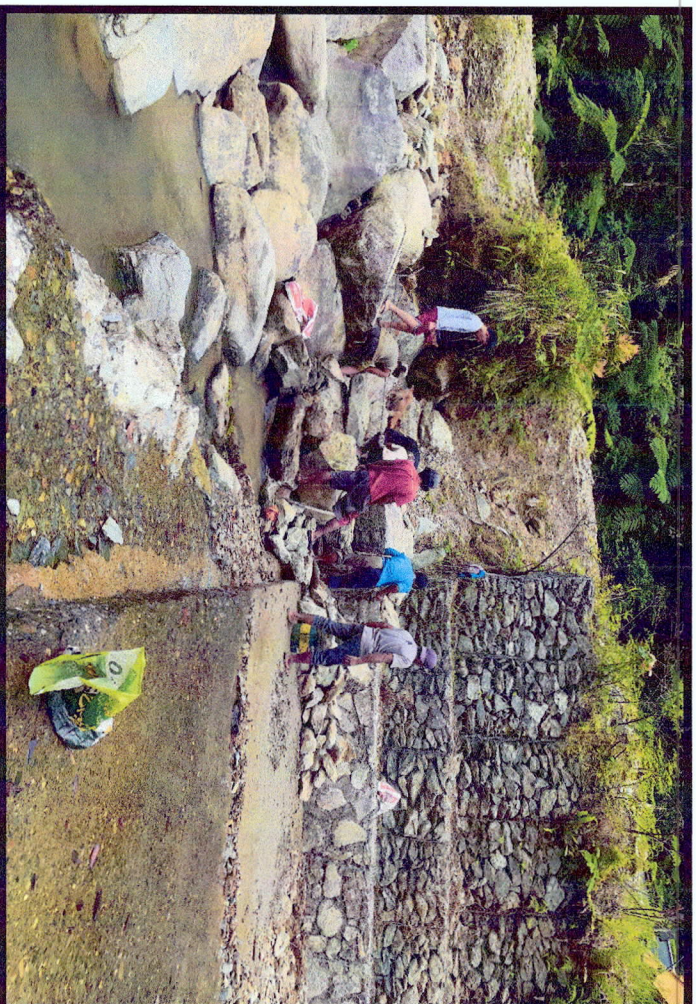
IV. ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION

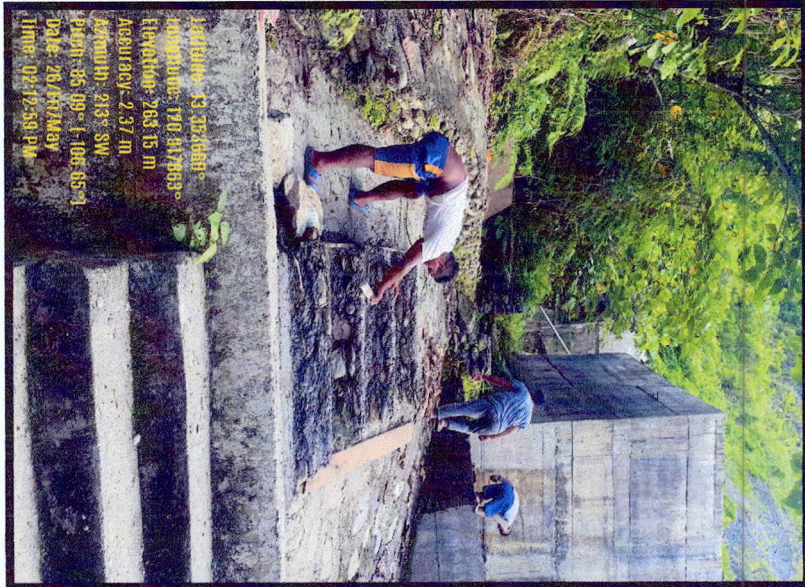

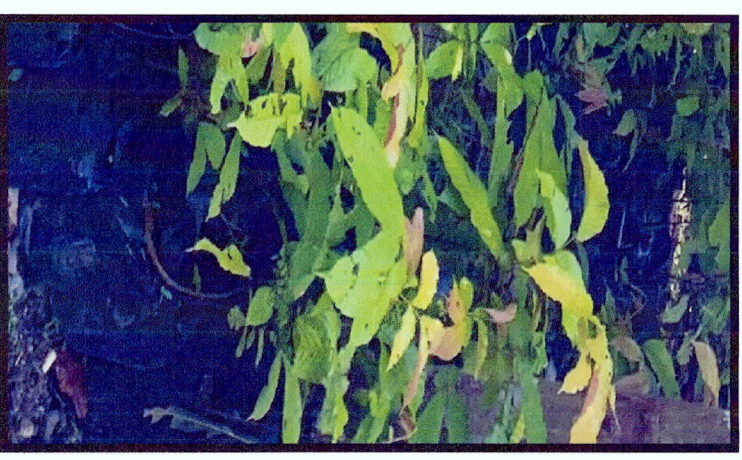

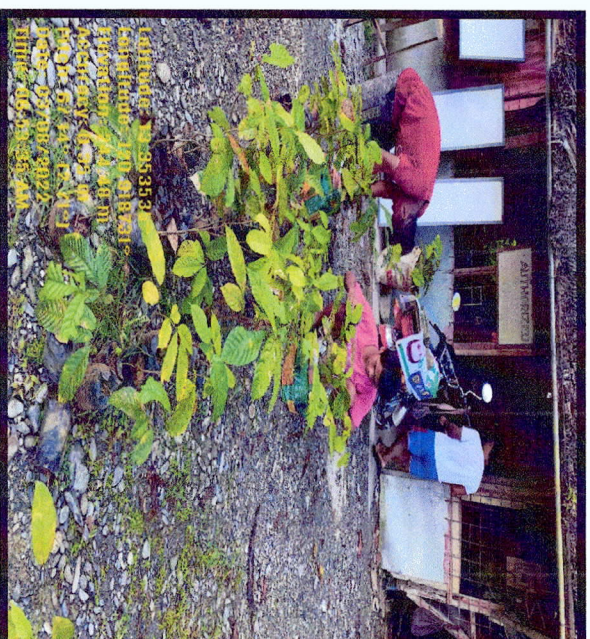

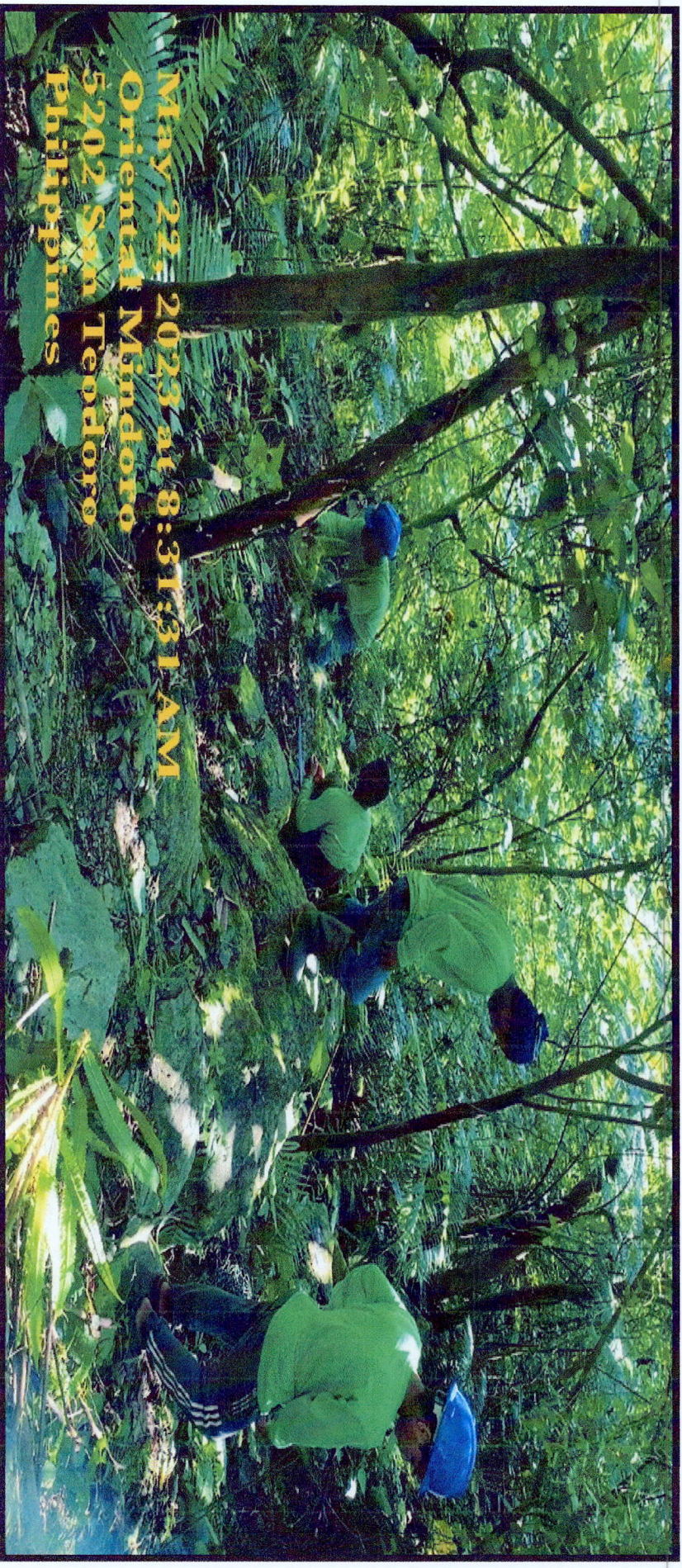
