I. OPENING PROGRAM

The Task Force meeting was conducted on June 1, 2023 attended by forty-seven (47) participants (12 female, 35 male) The meeting was attended by members from National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), Philippine Army, 1st Provincial Mobile Force Company (PMFC), PG-ENR Office, Philippine National Police (PNP) and Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) of Puerto Galera, San Teodoro, Baco, Naujan, Victoria, Socorro, and Pola. The meeting was started at 8:30 o'clock in the morning with an opening prayer followed by singing of Philippine National Anthem.

Forester Leonida A. Mindaros presented the members of the Task Force and explain the objectives of the meeting. She also mentioned the meeting of the Task Force is once a year or as need arises.

Message

Chief MES Ricardo R. Natividad welcome all the participants specially for the members of the PNP for being active in Environmental Protection through continuous apprehension of illegally cut lumbers/flitches and for the joint checkpoint operation of the Task Force. Chief Natividad appeal to the Task Force members for continues support to DENR in protecting our Environment.

II. OBJECTIVES

- a. To educate the SAKAL Task Force members on Land laws and related laws and Republic Act 9275 or "*Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004*".
- b. Discussion of the draft Resolution No. 2023-01: conduct of joint Checkpoints and/or signing thereof.

III. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION

a. Land Management and Administration

LMO III Maria Alva Renelyn Culla-Umali discussed the following:

➤ DENR Land Sector Mandates

She said that the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) through the Land Management Bureau LMB) and field offices is mandated to administer, survey, manage and dispose Public alienable and

disposable (A&D) lands and those public lands not placed under the jurisdiction of other government agencies.

➤ Legal Principles of land Management

She discussed some of the Legal bases, Constitutional provisions on natural resources, Article XII, Section 2 of 1987 Philippine Constitution, Major land administration and Management laws in the Philippines and other key legislation and mandates on Land Administration and Management.

She pointed out the Article XII, Section 2, 1987 Philippine Constitution or “All lands of the public domain, waters, minerals, coal, petroleum, and other mineral oils, all forces of potential energy, fisheries, forests or timber, wildlife, flora and fauna, and other natural resources are owned by the State. With the exception of agricultural lands, all other natural resources shall not be alienated. The exploration, development, and utilization of natural resources shall be under the full control and supervision of the State.”.

➤ Administration and DENR Modes of disposition

She said that before a land can be titled, it has to be classified Alienable and Disposable (A&D). This means that forest lands or still unclassified lands, cannot be alienated or opened for private appropriation. The same thing to foreshore lands, military reservations, public highways and municipal streets, and navigable bodies of water. She also discussed the classification of lands, agencies that deals with land administration and management and modes of acquiring public lands.

She discussed in details about Public Land Application for Agricultural Free Patent such as qualifications of the applicant, where to file the application, checklist of requirements for the Agricultural free Patent (documents to be submitted by the applicant), documents to be secured by the CENRO/Implementing PENRO, area limitation and signing authority (below 5 has is PENRO) and time frame (took 130 calendar days transmitted to ROD if the approving authority is PENRO).

She discussed and explained What is Lease, lease of lands of the public domain, who may apply for lease, term of lease and checklist of requirements in the preparation and execution of Lease Contract, what is Foreshore, requirements in filing of Foreshore Lease Application, steps in leasing public lands, Special patent, coverage of special patent and modes of disposition.

She also discussed the criteria for Residential free patents, criteria for residential free patents, limits of areas, documentary requirements, processing of applications and the process flow.

She further expounded the DENR Administrative Order No. 2021-07 "Guidelines on the establishment of legal easements along the seas, rivers, lakes esteros and creeks.

b. Republic Act 9275 or the "Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004"

Forester Carlotta Levinia R. Jugno discussed and explained the following:

- Importance of water
- Purpose of Clean Water Act
- Coverage
- Water Quality Management Area
- Water body classification and usage of freshwater intended beneficial use
- Water body classification and usage of Marine waters intended beneficial use. For unclassified water bodies, classification shall be based on the beneficial use as determined by EMB.
- Water pollution permits and charges
- Types of wastewaters
- Discharge permit
- Who may apply for waste water discharge permit
- Requirements in securing discharge permit
- Grounds for revocation of permit

She mentioned that any discharge of wastewater into any water bodies and/or land shall be ground for immediate issuance of cease-and-desist order to any person, facility or business entity.

She also mentioned that any person, facility or business entity that operates without a discharge permit will be issued a Notice of Violation and will be invited for Technical Conference convened by the EMB-Regional Office or the board for the purpose of giving the respondent or his duly authorized representative, the opportunity to contest the basis of A NOV as well as the basis of the applicable fines or penalties, informing the respondent of the possibility of imposition and/or accrual of fines and obtaining a commitment from the respondent to implement remedial measures to abate or mitigate the pollution complained of, or undertake to comply with required licensing or permitting conditions or requirement, or requirements of the regulations, as applicable, among others.

In addition to her presentation, she explained the duties or power of Pollution Adjudication board (PAB) such as the following:

- Recommend to the DENR Secretary the imposition of fines for acts of omission prohibited under Section 27 of the Act
- Recommend to the DENR Secretary the issuance of Cease-and-Desist Order for acts of omission prohibited under Section 27 of the Act
- Recommend closure, suspension of development or construction, or cessation of operations or, where appropriate, disconnection of water supply under Section 28 of the Act
- Recommend filing of criminal charges against violators of acts prohibited by Section 28
- Recommend to the DENR Secretary to order the Local Water District or private water supplier to disconnect the water service of the violator

- Revoke or suspend a discharge permit
- Determine liability for clean up

She also discussed the Section 28 of RA 9275: Fines, Damages and Penalties. Any person violates any prohibited acts of this law shall be fined in the amount of not less than 10,000.00 nor more than 200, 000.00 for every violation. The fines shall be increased by 10% every two (2) years to compensate for inflation and to maintain the deterrent functions of fines. The Secretary may order the closure, suspension of development or construction or cessation of operation or disconnection of water supply, until such time that proper environmental safeguards are put in place and/or compliance with the act are undertaken.

She also mentioned that failure to undertake clean-up operations, willfully, or through gross negligence, shall be punished by imprisonment of not less than two (2) years to four (4) years and a fine not less than 50,000.00 to 100,000.00 per day each day of violation. Such failure or refusal which results in serious injury or loss of life and irreversible water contamination of surface, ground, coastal and marine water shall be punished with imprisonment of not less than six (6) years and one (1) day and not more than twelve (12) years and fine of 500,000.00 per day for each day during which the omission and/or contamination continues.

c. Discussion of the draft Resolution No. 2023-01: *Conduct of joint checkpoints*

Legal Researcher Atty. Sherlyn A. Layesa facilitated the review and signing of the Resolution. It was agreed and approved that the joint checkpoints shall be conducted per municipality on the quarterly bases or as need arises by the team of DENR personnel, MENRO, ABC president staff and other Task Force members headed by the concerned PNP. The resolution was approved by the 16 Oriental Mindoro Sagip Kalikasan (SAKAL) Task force members who are present during the meeting.

d. Way forward

First joint checkpoint operation was scheduled on the 3rd week of June, 2023 with 1st PMFC, 2nd platoon along Nautical Highway of Brgy. Batong Dalig, Socorro, Oriental Mindoro. The next joint checkpoint is to be determined by CENRO-MES personnel.

VII. OPEN FORUM



The meeting ended at around 12:30 PM.



WHEREAS, SAKAL TASK FORCE had its meeting on **01 JUNE 2023** at DENR-CENRO Socorro, Barangay Pasi II, Socorro, Oriental Mindoro with the presence of the above-mentioned and/or their duly authorized representatives;

WHEREAS, the SAKAL TASK FORCE was created to serve as front liner in the implementation of forest protection activities and to enforce anti-illegal logging laws, rules, and regulations particularly Presidential Decree 705, as amended, otherwise known as "**Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines**" and Republic Act No. 9175, otherwise known as "**The Chainsaw Act of 2002**";

WHEREAS, the conduct of checkpoints per city/municipality within the First District of Oriental Mindoro is an efficient measure to achieve the foregoing however not all members of the **SAKAL TASK FORCE** have the authority to establish checkpoints;


WHEREAS, the "Revised Philippine National Police Operational Procedures" provides that, "the (Checkpoint) Team should encourage the participation of, but not limited to, the Local Government Units (LGUs), Civil Society Groups, Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), business organizations, other civic groups, media and other stakeholders during the conduct of Police Checkpoint operations";

WHEREAS, participation of all members of the SAKAL TASK FORCE in the conduct of checkpoints is vital as it gives police additional eyes, promotes transparency of activities, and establishes presence of the task force;

WHEREAS, upon thorough discussion and proper deliberation it was unanimously agreed and approved that joint checkpoints shall be conducted per city/municipality quarterly and as need arises by the SAKAL TASK FORCE to be headed by the concerned officers of the Philippine National Police and in compliance with the appropriate operational procedure.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that joint checkpoints in the respective city/municipalities within the jurisdiction of the **SAKAL TASK FORCE**, i.e., First District of Oriental Mindoro, shall be conducted quarterly and as need arises.
