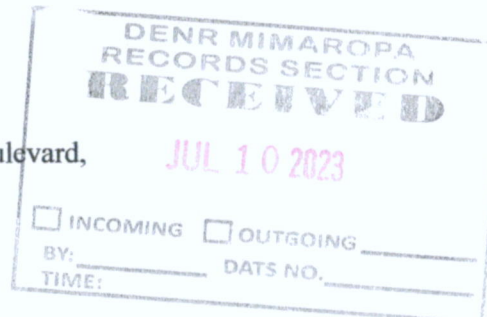

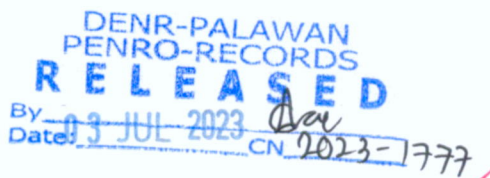

Respectfully submitted is the report of CMEMP Extension Officer of the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) - Palawan regarding on the conducted above-mentioned activity.

Please be informed that this year's theme, "**Sustainably Feed the Global Population**" with a message, "The science we need for the ocean we want" was celebrated for two (2) days on May 19-20, 2023.

On the first day (May 19, 2023), IEC campaign was held at the PENRO Training Hall, Bgy. Sta. Monica, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan with opening remarks given by the Technical Services Division Chief, Ronie B. Gandeza (Figure 1). Relative to this year's theme, a presentation focusing on **Fishery Food Security** was tackled by the invited resource speaker, Mr. Nerben B. Salazar of the Provincial Government of Palawan - Provincial Agriculture Office (Figure 2).

A total of (19) college student participants have attended the event. Ten (10) students of BS in Fisheries and BS in Aquatic Biology were from Western Philippines University (WPU) accompanied by their one (1) instructor and nine (9) students of BS in Marine Biology and BS in Environmental Sciences were from Palawan State University (PSU) (Figure 3).

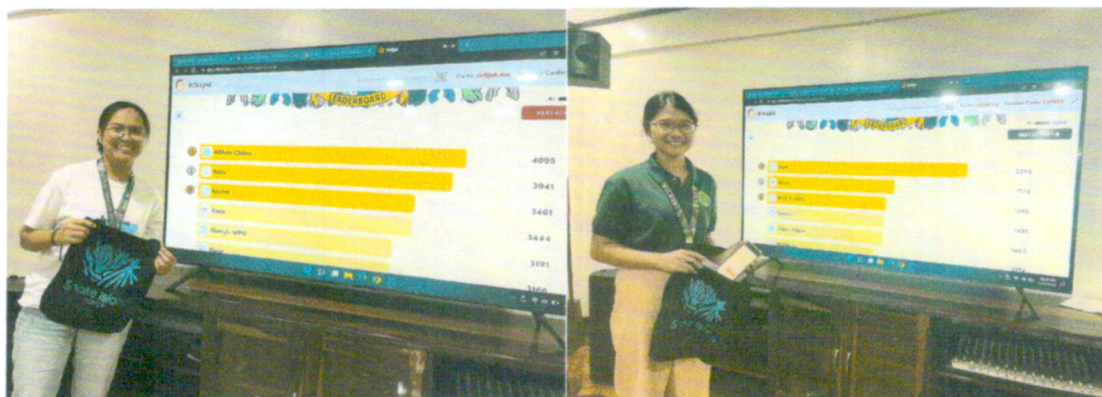
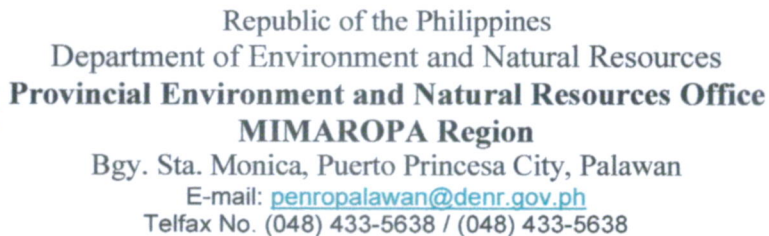


Figure 4. Some of the winners during fun trivia quiz with their prizes.

Further, after the presentation by the resource speaker, an interactive activity in form of a fun trivia quiz was facilitated by the CMEMP EO for the participants with corresponding prizes for every winner being the fastest to answer each of the questions via online quiz application (<https://app.rolljak.com>) (Figure 4). To boost engagement and gather additional input from participants, an Event Reflection was also prepared with some questions and their answers will then be flashed at the screen via online platform (www.mentimeter.com) (Figure 5).

Lastly, the awarding of certificates of appreciation and participation was given to the resource speaker and the student participants, respectively (Figure 6). The half day event for the first day of the Month of the Ocean 2023 celebration was closed by the assigned Marine Biologist of the Snake Island National Coastal and Marine Center for Research.

On the second day (May 20, 2023), Coastal Clean-up drive was conducted at Snake Island National Coastal and Marine Center for Research with a total of thirty-six (36) participants from PENRO together with representatives from CENRO Puerto Princesa (Figure 7).

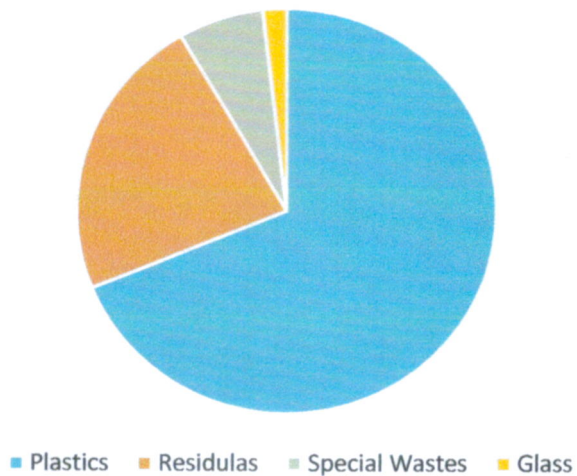


Figure 8. Coastal Clean-up drive, sorting and the composition of marine debris collected.

There were two sites for the clean-up, therefore, the participants were divided into two (2) groups for the northern and southern part of the island. Each group has sorted their collected marine debris and categorized to be able to record the types of debris and its quantity before being properly disposed at the mainland (Figure 8).

The coastal clean-up activity was successfully conducted during high tide and was facilitated by the assigned CMEMP EO and Snake Island personnel for the second day of the celebration of Month of the Ocean 2023.

**SUBJECT : AUTHORIZING THE OBSERVANCE OF THE MONTH
OF THE OCEAN (MOO) 2023**

In the interest of the service and pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 57, Series of 1998 declaring the May of each year as the "Month of the Ocean" in the Philippines, the observance and activities hereto is hereby authorized. In continuation to the adherence to the United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development (2021-2030) with the message, "The Science We Need for The Ocean We Want", the DENR will adopt the UNESCO Ocean Decade Challenge 3 "Sustainably Feed the Global Population" and will be this year's MOO theme.

Attached are the corresponding official MOO logo and banner design to be used as campaign materials for the event. Do not alter or edit the UN logo in any way such as changing the color scheme, or rearranging and omitting words or information. All regional offices and partners shall use the MOO logo in the production of all collaterals to be used in the conduct of MOO activities.


All Regions are therefore directed to coordinate with other concerned agencies, academe, NGOs, POs, and other partners for the promotion and awareness raising of this year's MOO theme. Regional Executive Directors are authorized to issue Regional Special Orders relevant to this celebration of the MOO 2023 within their respective areas of jurisdiction.

Expenses to be incurred in relation to the activities shall be charged against regional/field offices' funds respectively subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The BMB Director is authorized to change the date and time of activities, as necessary, and conflict of schedule with other priority programs of the DENR, among others. The BMB shall notify Human Resource Development Service of any changes in the activities.

The BMB shall submit a consolidated report to the undersigned through the link bit.ly/LNDportal within 15 days after the completion of the activities of the celebration.

This Order shall take effect on the dates herein specified.
