

PUBLIC HEARING OF SNAKE ISLAND OPERATIONAL PLAN CY 2023-2028

Aziza Paradise Hotel, Puerto Princesa City 27 June 2023

The declaration of Snake Island as the DENR National Coastal and Marine Center for Research was made thru DENR Administrative Order 2011-12 with the following functions: (1) to serve as field station for applied research for the marine and coastal environment, ecotourism as well as terrestrial biodiversity; (2) serve as a field laboratory for the implementation of the Integrated Coastal Marine Program pursuant to Executive Order 533 and (3) serve as a model for sustainable coastal and marine management as well as the proper implementation of the principles of ecotourism.

In connection to this, the BMB, ERDB, MIMAROPA Region, CENRO Puerto Princesa and PENRO Palawan along with the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) were tasked to formulate its Operational Plan as the research center. In addition, through series of meetings and consultations conducted, this Public Hearing of Snake Island Operational Plan was conducted to finalize the said plan.

A total of forty-seven (47) individuals participated in the said activity that includes DENR BMB, ERDB, MIMAROPA Region, CENRO Puerto Princesa, Provincial Environment Management Unit (PEMU), PCSDS, PNP Maritime, DA-BFAR, City Planning and Development Office, Academe: Palawan State University and Western Philippines University, City Agriculture Office, City Tourism Office, City ENRO, Provincial Agriculture, Provincial ENRO, HOBBAI, LGU Barangay Manalo, Salvacion, Sta. Cruz, Bacungan, Sta. Lourdes and Tagburos.

After the review of the Snake Island Operational Plan, the following ways forward are expected:

- 1. Memo/coordinate to TWG the necessary updates to the SIOP as result of the consultation: ERDB, BMB, PCSD revision of the document by July 15, 2023;
- 2. Dissemination of the revised to the concerned stakeholders on July 24, 2023;
- 3. Presentation of the revised final draft to the DENR Executive Committee for comments/approval on August 2023; and
- 4. Proof read layout editing and printing and distribution on September 2023.

Attached are the highlights of the comments and suggestions of the stakeholders regarding the presented Operational Plan.
