# INTRODUCTION

The monitoring and evaluation team headed by ECOMS II Mark Glenn T. Managdag (Chief of Compliance and Monitoring Unit) conducted ground validation on the issued FLAg-OLP to Ecofarm System and Resources, Inc. (Parcel I) on June 20, 2023.

### FINDINGS/OBSERVATION

The nature of business of the company is pearl aquaculture. They are producing market quality pearls that reached the international market. The team conducted a short briefing before inspecting the surrounding facilities, as well as checking of permit and clearances as part of the monitoring process. Ms. Lucia Masendo, Farm Manager in San Isidro, accompanied the team during the conduct of the activity.

Two (2) Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs) are present within the vicinity. The company's wastes including used oils are segregated and contained properly before transporting to Manila once a month for disposal. The company also provided social services and assistance to selected communities by donating 15 plastic drums and 40 metal drums for floral gardening project by LGU Busuanga and garbage cans, participating in conduct of coastal clean-up and mangrove planting activities, and donating sacks of rice through the assistance of PNP Busuanga. The company also implementing active backyard gardening for their consumption.

The proponent is consistently submitting their annual report and religiously paying their annual government share (advance) amounting Php 8, 347.50 with O.R. No. 6879718 Y dated December 16, 2022 for C.Y. 2023.


