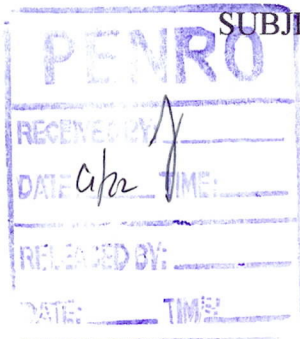

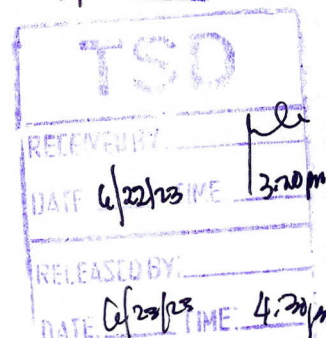

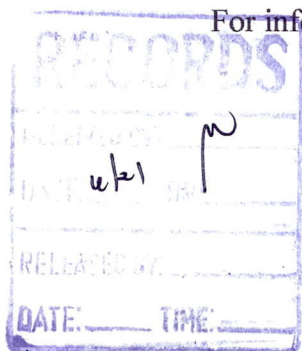

LEARNING EVENT FOR PAMB MEMBERS AND PAMO STAFF ON REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11038 ALSO KNOWN AS EXPANDED NATIONAL INTEGRATED PROTECTED AREAS SYSTEM (ENIPAS) ACT OF 2018 AS AMENDED AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

In year 2022, a 10-Year Capacity Building Plan for Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) members and Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) staff of Mt. Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary (MCWS) was crafted. This plan was created with the aim of enhancing the PAMB members and PAMO staff's knowledge, skills, and abilities in effectively managing and protecting the protected area. It is a plan with the goals of providing long-term support and continuous professional development opportunities to ensure the successful implementation of conservation strategies and the achievement of conservation goals.

As part of the MCWS 10-Year Capacity Building Plan, the MCWS-PAMO conducted a capacity-building activity titled "Learning Event for PAMB members and PAMO staff on Republic Act No. 11038 also known as Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System (ENIPAS) Act of 2018 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations." This learning event took place from June 14 to 16, 2023, at Apartelle de Francesca in Brgy. San Isidro, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro. The event aimed to enhance the knowledge and understanding of the PAMB members, and MCWS-PAMO staff on the legislation governing the protected areas particularly on the ENIPAS Act of 2018 (RA11038). More so, the activity was geared to achieve the following objectives:

- Know the salient provisions of the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) Act of 1992 (RA 7586) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) under DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2008-26, as amended by Expanded NIPAS Act of 2018 (RA 11038) and its IRR under DAO No. 2019-05, necessary for the effective and efficient management of protected area;
- State the functions and responsibilities of PAMB members and level off and appreciate the roles and responsibilities of PASu's, as resource managers of protected area;
- Define the guiding principles as conditions in carrying out their official duties and responsibilities and be more aware of their important role as manager, administrator and implementer of plans and programs of PA; and
- Be more committed as PAMB members and PAMO Staff in the protection, conservation and sustainable management of the protected areas.

This capacity-building initiative was specifically designed for the stakeholders involved in the management of Mt. Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary (MCWS). The event brought together members of the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) and their representatives,

who played a crucial role in the decision-making processes concerning the management of MCWS. Representatives from PENRO Occidental Mindoro and CENRO Sablayan, and the staff from the MCWS-Protected Area Management Office, who work tirelessly to ensure the smooth implementation of conservation efforts within the sanctuary.

The event commenced with the welcome remarks by Mr. Isaias M. Guimod, the Deputy CENR Officer of CENRO Sablayan, followed by an introduction and overview of the activity by Ms. Josie R. Corpuz, the MCWS Officer In charge. Forester Rodel Boyles, the CENR Officer of CENRO Socorro, also delivered a message during the opening ceremony.

The learning event successfully accomplished its goals and objectives owing to the presence of Ms. Michaela Tuyan Rongavilla as the resource speaker. Ms. Rongavilla, who serves as the Chief of the Protected Area Management and Biodiversity Conservation Section of DENR MIMAROPA Region, brought her vast expertise and practical experience in the field of protected area management and biodiversity conservation. Her wealth of knowledge and guidance greatly contributed to the event's success.

The activity encompassed a diverse range of activities and discussions designed to enhance the participants' understanding of the ENIPAS Act. On the first day, before Ms. Rongavilla started the discussion a pre-test was provided to test the existing knowledge of the participants regarding MCWS. Later then, she presented the salient features of the ENIPAS Act as amended and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). During the discussion overview of the protected area and its nationwide status were discussed. Additionally, she provided background information on the NIPAS Act of 1992 and the ENIPAS Act of 2018. Ms. Rongavilla highlighted that during the amendment from the NIPAS Act to the ENIPAS Act, four provisions were retained, 16 provisions were amended, and 13 new provisions were added.

The second day focused on the administration and management of protected areas. Ms. Rongavilla emphasized seven sections under the ENIPAS Act, specifically Sections 10, 18, 11, 11-A, 11-B, 26, and 9. These sections covered topics such as the Administration and Management of the Protected Area System, Field Officers, the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB), Powers and Functions of the PAMB, the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO), Local Government Units, and the Management Plan. She also presented an MCWS situationer, highlighting the issues and concerns and providing reminders for MCWS. Throughout the discussions, MCWS PAMB members and PAMO staff actively participated by asking questions to clarify and relate the topics to the current state of MCWS.

The event proceeded to the third and final topic, which focused on prohibited acts and penalties. Ms. Rongavilla compared the prohibited acts and their corresponding fines and penalties listed in the NIPAS Act (RA 7586) and the ENIPAS Act (RA 11038). The ENIPAS

Act introduced 22 prohibited acts, an increase from the nine acts specified in the NIPAS Act. Furthermore, the fines and penalties outlined in the ENIPAS Act were more substantial than those in the previous legislation. After the discussion, a visualization exercise, pledge for MCWS and a post-test were conducted.

On the last day of the learning event, a short closing ceremony was held to express gratitude to the participants, especially the resource speaker, Ms. Rongavilla. Councilor Elorde Marasigan, representative of Hon. Michael O. Diaz, Municipal Mayor of Paluan gave a closing remark to formally end the learning event. Following the ceremony, all participants were invited to visit the Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Center (MBCC) operated by the Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. (MBCFI). There, Architect Rainer Magcale MBCFI's onsite supervisor, presented the whole plan for the MBCC for the following years and then participants were given a tour of the center.

The Learning Event on the ENIPAS Act proved to be an enlightening and empowering experience for the participants. It provided an invaluable opportunity for MCWS PAMB members, government representatives, and MCWS staff to enhance their understanding of the ENIPAS Act. The event facilitated fun and energizing mini-games, meaningful discussions and allowed participants to address their questions and concerns regarding the implementation of the ENIPAS Act. By equipping them with a comprehensive understanding of the legislation and its implementing rules and regulations, the event has bolstered their capacity to effectively manage and protect the unique biodiversity within Mt. Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary. The knowledge gained during the event will undoubtedly contribute to the continued success of conservation efforts within the protected area, ensuring its long-term sustainability and preservation for future generations. The commitment and dedication demonstrated by the participants further underscored their shared vision of preserving the natural beauty and ecological importance of the Mt. Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary.





