





MONITORING OF THE CANTUROY COMMUNITY-BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT (CBFM) ASSOCIATION INC.

In connection to the P/A/P monitoring and validation of programs/projects, monitoring of the Canturoy CBFM Association Inc. was conducted last May 28, 2023. The Canturoy CBFM Association Inc. (CBFMA Registration No. RIV-OCCMIN-CBFMA-2000-09) is located in Brgy. Manoot, Rizal, Occcidental Mindoro and covers an area of 401.65 hectares. Several projects were awarded to them:1) NGP (2011 and 2012) and 2) CBFM CARP (2011 and 2017), and all were already graduated. Their Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) with 5-year Work Plan was recently approved last 2022.

Specifically, monitoring of the compliance to its CBFM agreement, approved CRMF with 5-year Work Plan and ENR policies and regulations were done together with the personnel from the Conservation and Development Section – CBFM Desk (CDS-CBFM) and Enforcement and Monitoring Section (EMS). 






