Submitted is the report of CENRO Socorro on the conduct of activities related to the celebration of World Ocean's Day and Coral Triangle Day 2023.

Kindly be informed that a coastal clean-up was conducted in Barangay Sta. Theresa, Gloria, Oriental Mindoro on June 22, 2023. This was attended by 103 participants (57 male and 56 female) coming from Bantay Dagat, Cash for Work beneficiaries, Bantay Bakawan, 4Ps, and Sta. Theresa Fisherman Association and CENRO personnel.

Based on the report, a total of 24 sacks with an estimated weight of 100kilograms of solid wastes was collected in a 1.496km shoreline stretch. The collected wastes were turnedover to the Barangay Officials for the proper disposal.

2023

In observance of the celebration of World Oceans Day related to coastal and marine protection, conservation and management, this Office has organized and spearheaded the conduct of Coastal Clean-up in Barangay Sta. Theresa, Gloria, Oriental Mindoro on June 22, 2023. This is in coordination with the MENRO of Gloria, Barangay Officials, Bantay Dagat, Bantay Bakawan, and Sta. Theresa Fishermen Association and is proactive in different environmental activities.

The barangay chosen is one of the coastal barangays in the municipality that is previously affected by the oil spill. A two (2) hectare beach forest with Coconut palm, Narra, and Apatot trees may be found here. Additionally, this Barangay contains a 13.9-hectare fishery reserve that is a marine protected area. Due to the increasing population in the area and the litter' of improvised oil spill boom, extensive trash and litter have been observed to be one of the environmental problems the barangay has been facing.

Please be informed that the activity was participated by 28 personnel of DENR-CENRO Roxas, Bantay Dagat, Cash for Work Beneficiaries, Bantay Bakawan, 4P's, and Sta. Theresa Fisherman Association. It was composed of 56 female and 57 male participants. The activity immediately started the coastal clean-up. The undersigned expressed her gratitude to all who participated and received a positive response from the participants.

The cleanup lasted for two hours in approximately 1.496 kilometers of shoreline stretch. A total of 24 sacks with an estimated weight of 100 kilograms of waste/garbage such as plastics, food wrappers, old clothes, fishnets, and other non-biodegradable wastes were collected. Moreover, a high volume of woody debris/litter was also observed in the whole stretch of the area due to the southeast monsoon and waste of improvised oil spill booms. The collected wastes are turned over to the barangay for proper disposal while the woody debris/litter were planned to be removed through a payloader/dump truck initiated by the barangay.
