Forwarded is the monitoring report from the CENRO Roxas regarding the abovementioned subject. This refers to the 11 existing wildlife species currently under rehabilitation and monitoring at DENR-CENRO Roxas Wildlife Rescue Center in Brgy. San Roque, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.

Currently, a total of five (5) species remain under the care of the Wildlife Rescue Center. These include: (1) Philippine Long-Tailed Macaque (*Macaca fascicularis philippinensis*); (2) Brahminy Kite (*Haliastur indus*); (3) common Buzzard (*Buteo buteo*); (4) White-eared Brown Dove or Limokon (*Phapitreron leucotis*); and (5) Philippine Collared Dove or Bato bato (*Streptopelia bitorquata*).

Additional activities for the said monitoring of species include inventory of existing wildlife species in the facility and transfer of turn-over species. Preparation of bill of materials and job request for the construction of additional two (2) cages are also being processed to improve the maintenance of the facilities.

Attached are the photo-documentations, job request, bill of materials and proposed cage design for approval and inventory of the said activity.


