



Annually, World Oceans Day (WOD) and Coral Triangle Day are celebrated every 8th and 9th of June, respectively, to shed light on ocean conservation and the numerous ways to protect and conserve our coastal and marine resources. This year, the WOD adopts the theme ***“Planet Ocean: Tides are Changing”*** which highlights the vastness of the ocean that covers the majority of our planet. Likewise, the Coral Triangle Day for this year’s theme ***“Ocean Need Actions”***. It highlights the need for concrete actions and emphasizes the urgency to move beyond plans.

On June 9, 2023, in line with the celebration of World Oceans Day and Coral Triangle Day, the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) – Marinduque in cooperation with the Philippine National Police (PNP), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Marinduque State College (MSC), and Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) of Ino, Mogpog, Marinduque successfully conducted simultaneous Coastal Clean-Up and Mangrove Planting activity at Brgy. Ino, Mogpog, Marinduque.

The simultaneous Coastal Clean-Up and Mangrove Planting Activity were participated by a total of one hundred two (102) participants composed of sixty-two (62) males and forty (40) females. Moreover, there were eight (8) sacks of wastes collected along the coastal area within the said Barangay during the Coastal Clean-Up.


