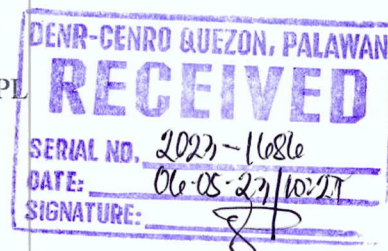

Please be informed that the undersigned staff of Mt. Mantalingahan Protected Landscape-Protected Area Management Office (MMPL-PAMO) has conducted Information, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) at Sitio Binikyat focusing livelihood and at Sitio Balen Balen Barangay Ransang, Rizal Palawan focusing the tourism activities on May 23 to 24, 2023.

Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape has been home to the indigenous Palawan's for thousands of years. With over half its original forest cover remaining, it provides an essential watershed for the 200,000 people who depend on it for agriculture, drinking water and livelihood. The project objective number 2.1, at least 8 communities/schools visited for caravan to implement CEPA activities come up by conducting Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) in the IP community of Sitio Binikyat focusing on livelihood and at Sitio Balen Balen, Barangay Ransang Rizal, Palawan focusing tourism activities in MMPL.

The participants in Sitio Binikyat were composed of 24 Male and 27 Female. CEPA Officer Michael John Cantuba showed the profile of Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape and a simple assessment by means of flipchart. The participant identified the three main livelihood in their community such as kaingin, collecting of non-timber forest product and handicrafts making. The participants divided into four groups for the activity, each group had the opportunity to discussed and share their knowledge and experienced.

Moreover, the following were discussed during the CEPA at Sitio Balen Balen, Barangay Ransang Rizal, Palawan focusing tourism activities:

1. Issues and Concern of porters and tour guides such as;
 - The payment of 500 pesos before to porters and now 700 pesos in accordance to LGU-Rizal tourism the code.
 - There were hikers that the load of baggage is over than the prescribed kilo, the ratio of 5 hike is to 1 porter is not followed.
 - Payment of 5 days hiked whether the hike is finish earlier than the expected date.


- Payment system should be centralized and collected by the porter and tour guide treasurer before the hike begins.
- The 5 copies of permit should be released by the PAMO to hikers to be distributed as personal copy, LGU Rizal Tourism Office copy, Barangay. Ransang copy, tour guides copy and PAMO copy.
- The payment to LGU Tourism Rizal, Palawan is 100 per pax per local and 200 per pax per foreign for entrance fee and environmental fee



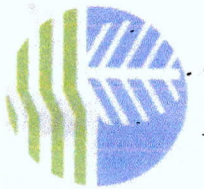

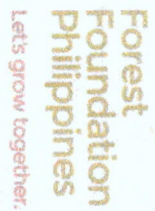
