Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum report dated April 24, 2023 regarding on the above subject.

Please be informed that on April 17, 2023 this office, together with the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) in coordination with the El Nido Marine Turtle Conservation Network (ENMTCN), responded to the marine turtle hatchlings. As reported by Ms. Shaine Olivo, Manager of Mecurio Palawan, a total of ninety-five (95) olive ridley sea turtle (*Lepidochelys olivacea*) hatchlings were released. However, forty-two (42) hatchlings went back to the shore caused by the light reflection from the town and were eaten by dogs. The team decided to transfer the hatchlings in the vicinities of Cadlao Island, Bgy. Buena Suerte, El Nido, Palawan.

Thus, this office concurs with the recommendation of the team to strengthen Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) on the importance of marine turtles and their habitats.

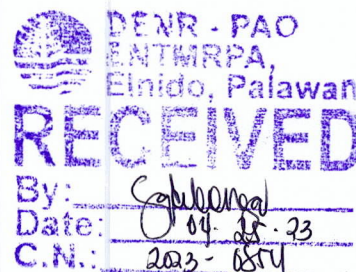

SUBJECT : REPORT ON RELEASED OF MARINE TURTLE HATCHLINGS



As per instructed by the Protected Area Superintendent of El Nido Managed Resource Protected Area (ENMRPA) on April 17, 2023, the undersigned together with Information Officer Aljen Becera, Park Ranger Ryan Cacacha, Admin Aide IV Lory Jane Delfin and Forest Ranger Herson Y. Caliao responded on the released of marine turtle hatchlings at El Nido beach, Bgy. Buena Suerte, El Nido, Palawan.

According to Ms. Shaine Olivo, Manager of Mercurio Palawan, they found the hatchlings under their establishment approximately 7:58 in the evening. The staff of the said establishment immediately released ninety-five (95) hatchlings and reported the incident to PAMO. However, the said species went back to the shore because of the light reflection from the town. It was found that some of the hatchlings was eaten by the dogs before the same was spotted and rescued by the locals in the shore. In totality, 42 hatchlings were turned over by the locals to PAMO personnel. In coordination with El Nido Marine Turtle Conservation Network (ENMTCN), along with the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), the team transferred the hatchlings in the vicinities of Cadlao Island, Barangay Buerte, El Nido, Palawan.

The team recommends to strengthen the Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) on the importance of marine turtle and their habitats.

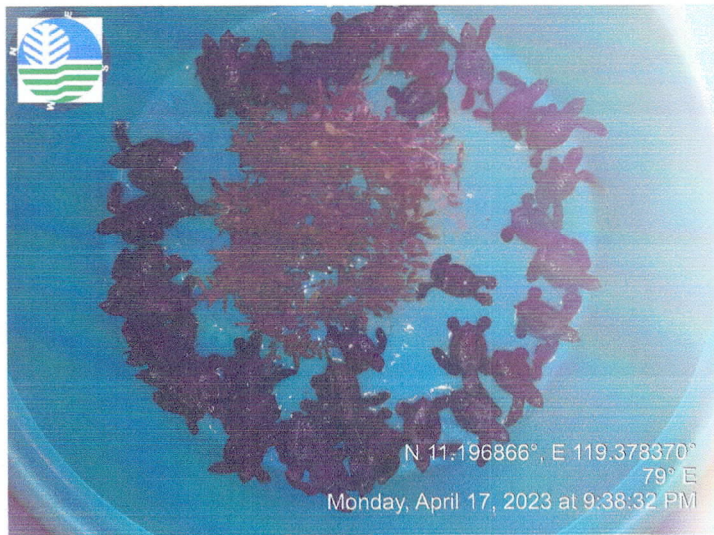
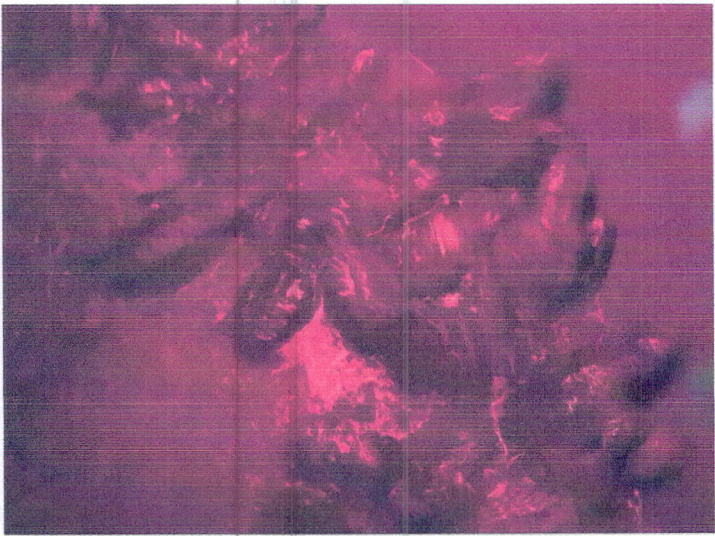
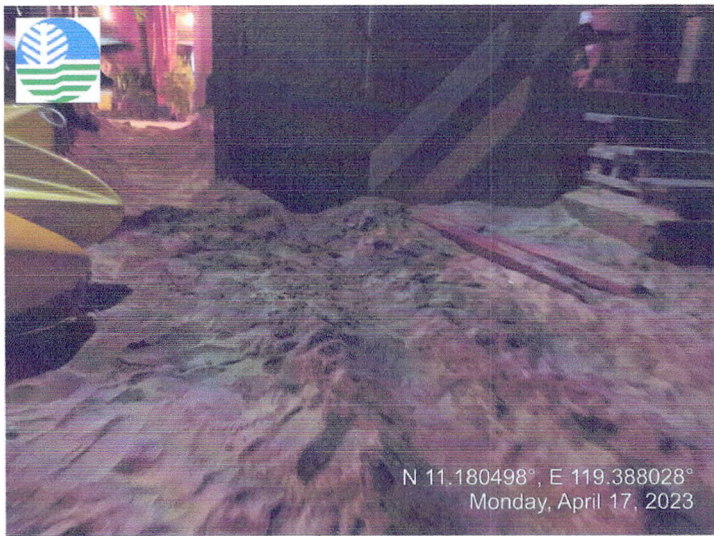
