Further, the Bawal Bastos Law emphasized the importance of women in which the gender equality should be prioritized though it may be sound unfair to the men, however it is helpful to other women who are suffering from physical and emotional abuses.

The facilitators managed to engage the participants through having a post and pre-test to ensure that we are gaining knowledge as well as answering questions during open forum.

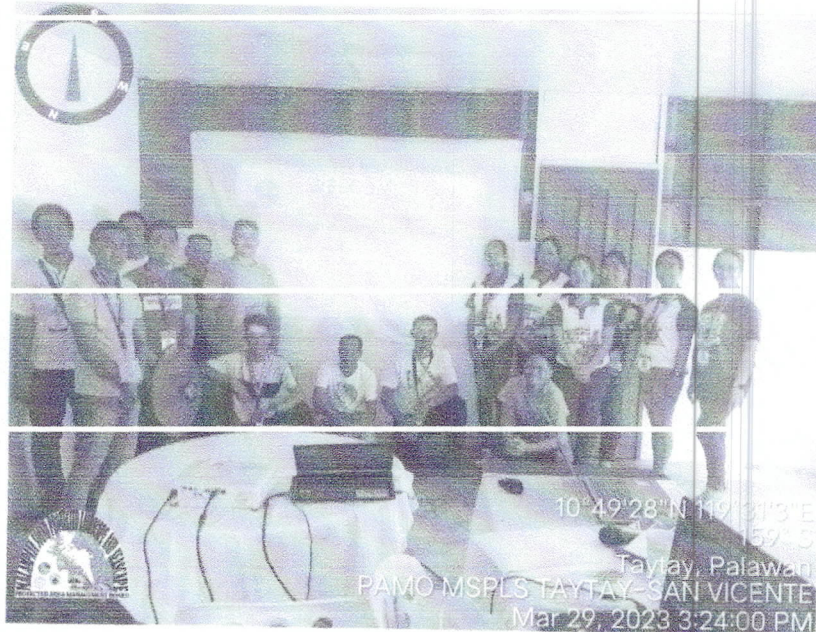


