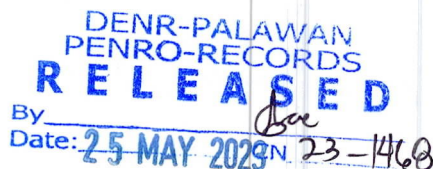
Forwarded is the memorandum dated May 5, 2023 from the OIC-CENRO of Coron, Palawan along with the memorandum report of Forest Technician I Nikki E. Ripalda and ECOMS II Mark Glenn T. Managdag dated May 4, 2023 regarding the above subject.

As per report submitted a dredged vessel in Balinsasayaw Coral Reef took last May 3, 2023 at around 4:30 in the afternoon. DENR representative immediately coordinated with LGU Coron on the matter before they proceeded in the area. Spill boom was already put in place by the LGU and PCG as well pumping out of diesel from the fuel tank was being undertaken to secure and prevent oil spill or leakage. A multi agencies was in the area after the incident was reported. With that they are recommending to conduct damage assessment once the boat is removed in the area.

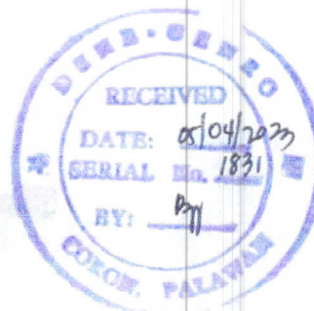

SUBJECT : **REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED JOINT INSPECTION AND VERIFICATION ON DREDGED VESSEL AT BALINSASAYAW CORAL REEF IN BRGY. LAJALA, CORON, PALAWAN**



This refers to the verbal instruction of OIC CENRO Rodney G. Verian on May 3, 2023 about 4:30 in the afternoon regarding the dredged vessel in Balinsasayaw Coral Reef located at Brgy. Lajala, Coron, Palawan early in the morning the same day.

Please be informed that the team immediately coordinated with LGU Coron and proceeded to the area. Upon arrival, the PCG together with LGU personnel had already put spill boom and pumping out diesel from the fuel tank to secure and prevent the oil spill. The team have tried to float the vessel by putting drums at the bottom of hull however, the vessel wasn't able to float due to heavy weight materials of boat.

Personnel from LGU MAO, MDRRMO, Philippine Coast Guard, PCSDS and BLGU of Lajala were also present in the area.

The team have agreed to abolish the activity around 8:00 in the evening and resume the next day. It is recommended further to conduct damage assessment on coral reef when the vessel is removed.
