ACTIVITY REPORT

CONSULTATION MEETING WITH INDIGENOUS PEOPLE (IP) COMMUNITIES WITHIN MT. CALAVITE WILDLIFE SANCTUARY (MCWS)

This report summarizes the consultations conducted with the Indigenous People (IP) communities within Mt. Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary (MCWS) regarding the delineation of management zones (multiple-use zone and strict protection zone) of the protected area. The consultations aimed to gather their perspectives on the proposed management zoning, which will have a significant impact on their livelihoods and the conservation of the sanctuary. These series of community consultations with the IP communities were done to introduce the zoning plan, explain its objectives and create a discussion with community members, to gather their views and concerns regarding the activity.

A total of five (5) consultations were conducted and were attended by 204 individuals (38 = So. Ulasan; 37 = So. Hinugasan; 14 = Pamutusin; 57: So. Calansan; 58 = So. Pinagbayanan) from different communities inside MCWS. The first meeting was held on April 25, 2023 in So. Ulasan, which was attended by the IP communities of So. Ulasan, Agdilaw, San Pablo, and the *Punong Balayans* of So. Calansan and Agbalete (see Annex A.1; Annex B.1). This was followed by two more consultations on April 26 and 27, 2023 in So. Hinugasan and Pamutusin, respectively, which were attended by members of the aforementioned communities (see Annex A.2-A.3; Annex B.2-B.3). The fourth consultation was held on May 03, 2023, with the combined community of So. Calansan and Agbalete, and was conducted in the *bahay pulungan* of So. Calansan (see Annex A.4; Annex B.4). On May 04, 2023, the fifth consultation took place in So. Pinagbayanan with the community members (see Annex A.5; Annex B.5).

The consultations that were conducted with the IP communities received different reactions from the members of each community. As the sanctuary serves as their ancestral land, it was understandable that some were cautious and apprehensive about the proposed delineation of management zones. Nonetheless, the Protected Area Superintendent, Forester Arlene V. Francisco, was able to provide a comprehensive explanation that addressed the questions and concerns of the community members, and this helped alleviate some of their fears and doubts. Despite the initial hesitancy, the consultations yielded some significant findings that are worth noting. These findings may provide insights that can guide on developing improvements in the delineation of management zones in a way that is aligned with the needs and priorities of the IP communities with no disregard to the aim of conserving and protecting the area. The following were the significant findings from the consultations:

- Consultation at So. Ulasan

- Before agreeing to the proposed zoning plan, members of IP communities from So. Ulasan wanted a copy of the agreement made between the MCWS-PAMO and their community dated --- regarding the allowed activities they can do within the protected area.
 - The IP community members in So. Ulasan expressed their worry regarding the presence of carabaos and cows owned by Mr. Rick Bandiola, Mr. Leo Tinaliga, and Mr. Ricky Tinaliga, which are being grazed within the Protected Area (PA) without informing them or the MCWS-PAMO beforehand.
 - *Punong balayan* of So. Agdilaw pointed out that the location of their community on the presented map wasn't accurate and was clarified with the PASu where it is situated on the map
 - Consultation at So. Hinugasan
 - The members of the IP community have agreed to the proposed zoning plan, but their main request is to ensure that all of their *kaingin* areas were precisely mapped out and included in the designated multiple use zones outlined in the plan.
 - Consultation at So. Pamutusin
 - Members of the community of So. Pamutusin raised their concern regarding their ISF certificates that were collected by then PASu Orlando R. Ramos. They ask if there were any updates regarding how they will renew their ISF certificate and why the certificates are collected from them.
 - Since, fishing is one of the primary sources of livelihood in the community there are concerns about their needs of wood for boat construction and repair. The community members are uncertain whether they will still have access to wood from the Protected Area (PA) once the management zones delineation is finalized.
 - The local government unit (LGU) of the barangay expressed their longstanding intention to construct a restroom near Agbokbok Falls for tourists. Brgy. Captain Toriana stated that funds have already been allocated for this purpose. However, the construction of the planned restroom did not proceed as they were informed that building within the Protected Area (PA) is not permitted.
 - Individuals who claim ownership of farmlands located within the Protected Area (PA), including the purported owner of Igmanukan Lake, are being asked to provide proof of their land titles.
 - Consultation at So. Calansan
 - IP community members from So. Calansan and So. Agbalete conveyed their dissatisfaction with the assigned area for multiple use zones, stating that the allocated space was insufficient.
 - Community members also pointed out that certain portions of their *kaingin* (swidden farming) areas were already located within areas designated as strict protection zones, as shown on the presented map.
 - Consultation at So. Pinagbayanan

- Members of the Indigenous Peoples (IP) community from So. Pinagbayanan expressed their discontent with the designated area for multiple use zones, citing that the allocated space was inadequate.
 - There were worries raised regarding individuals who are not part of the IP community, that were establishing *kaingin* areas within the protected area adjacent to their location.

Based on the findings from the consultations, the following are recommended management actions to address the concerns of the IP communities:

- Consultation at So. Ulasan
 - Immediately provide a copy of the agreement between MCWS-PAMO and the members of IP community of So. Ulasan.
 - Write a letter to Mr. Rick Bandiola, Mr. Leo Tinaliga, and Mr. Ricky Tinaliga regarding their illicit activity within the PA.
 - Conduct a site visitation on the area of So. Agdilaw to determine the accurate location of the sitio.
- Consultation at So. Hinugasan
 - Conduct a site assessment on the *kaingin* areas of the members of IP communities at So. Hinugasan to accurately map its locations on the zoning plan.
- Consultation at So. Pamutusin
 - Request information from former PASu Orlando R. Ramos regarding the ISF certificates of the residents from So. Pamutusin.
 - Advise the community members that it is permissible to gather wood only for their own boat repair needs, while also encouraging them to plant trees that can be utilized for future needs.
 - The Barangay Harrison will create a presentation outlining the proposed construction plan for restrooms and deliver it during the upcoming PAMB meeting.
 - Submit the land claimants' title documents to the PAMO to ensure official recognition and registration of their land ownership.
- Consultation at So. Calansan
 - Conduct a site assessment on the *kaingin* areas of the members of IP communities of So. Calansan and Agbaleta to accurately map its locations on the zoning plan.
- Consultation at So. Pinagbayanan
 - Conduct a site assessment on the *kaingin* areas of the members of IP communities of So. Pinagbayanan to accurately map its locations on the zoning plan.
 - Contact the concerned individuals and ask to present their legal documents regarding the lands they were turning into *kaingin* areas.

The consultations with the IP communities in the Mt. Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary provided valuable insights into their perspectives and concerns regarding the establishment of multiple-use and strict protection zones. The consultations highlighted the importance of ensuring the
