

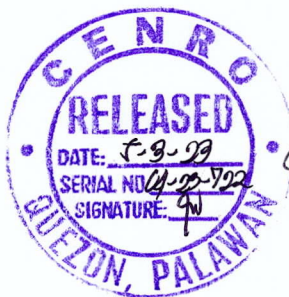

Please be informed that the PAMO-RIWS staff continuously conducting Fauna Monitoring activity within the two (2) hectares Permanent Biodiversity Monitoring Area (PBMA) in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary. The presences of faunal species was heard and observed during the said activity. The team was guided using the prescribed methods indicated in the BMB Technical Bulletin No's. 2016-05 and 2017-09. The team counted from 20-68 individuals of Katala from April 11- April 19, 2023.

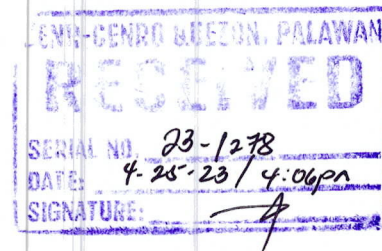

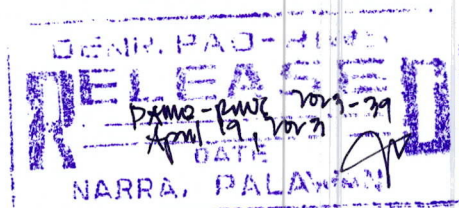

Respectfully submitted is the progress report on Fauna Monitoring conducted within the 2-has PBMA under the Biodiversity Assessment and Monitoring System for the month of April 2023.


Please be informed that the undersigned together with the Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary's Protected Area personnel are continuously conducting Fauna Monitoring activity within the two (2) hectares Permanent Biodiversity Monitoring Area (PBMA) in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary. The activity was conducted using the prescribed methods of BMB Technical Bulletin No's. 2016-05 and 2017 - 09.

The faunal species heard and observed during the monitoring activity were the ff: Large flying fox (*Pteropus vampyrus*), Gecko (*Gecko gecko*), Skink (*Mabuya multifasciata*), Monitor lizard (*Varanus salvator*), Philippine Cockatoo (*Cacatua haematuropygia*), Philippine Megapode or Tabon Scrubfowl (*Megapodius cumingii*), Grey Imperial Pigeon (*Ducula pickeringii*), Green Imperial Pigeon (*Ducula aenea*), Blue Paradise Flycatcher (*Tersiphone cyanescens*), Rufous-tailed tailorbird (*Orthotomus sericeus*), Red-headed Flameback (*Chrysocolaptes erythrocephalus*), Coomon Koel (*Eudynamys scolopacea*), Olive-backed sunbird (*Nectarinia jugularis*), Copper-throated sunbird (*Nectarinia calcostetha*) and Slender-billed crow (*Corvus enca*). Likewise, one (1) butterfly and one (1) spider species under arthropods were also observed.

Continuous monitoring of birds, arthropods, herpetofauna, and mammals is conducted. The final report including data analysis and photo documentation will be submitted on or before the 20<sup>th</sup> of September 2023.
