Minutes of the Meeting

**STAKEHOLDERS CONSULTATION ON THE
IDENTIFICATION OF COMMUNITY ENTERPRISE**
Organic Trading Post, Barangay Poblacion, Puerto Galera
April 24, 2023

One of the strategies in the Puerto Galera Master Plan of the Green Economy Model (GEM) is livelihood and enterprise development. A second workshop on Stakeholders Consultation on the Identification of Community Enterprise began at around 9:30 in the morning on April 24, 2023 at Organic Trading Post, Barangay Poblacion, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro.

The activity was headed by Land Management Officer III and GEM Focal Maria Alva Renelyn A. Culla-Umali, Section Chief of Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS) of CENRO-Socorro. The meeting was attended by different associations, registered and non-registered cooperatives, People's Organizations (POs), and representative from Municipal Local Government Unit of Puerto Galera.

Land Management Officer II Walter L. Tolentino facilitated the event and at the same time led the opening prayer. The National Anthem was played followed by DENR Hymn (Inang Kalikasan) and the LGU song of Puerto Galera, "The Amazing Puerto Galera." Each participant was requested to introduce themselves. A welcome remarks was rendered by MENR Officer Dr. Joan Margarette A. Yap in behalf of Mayor Rocky D. Ilagan. She mentioned that they were delighted in conducting the activity under the Green Economy Model (GEM) Program. According to her, the selected participants are only those who plays the biggest role in their association. These includes the mother of cooperatives, the president of all the president of fisherfolks associations, and the manager of all the managers. Similarly, Development Management V Alma E. Gibe, Chief of Technical Services Division of PENRO, Oriental Mindoro rendered an opening message.

Furthermore, LMO Culla-Umali cited the overview of the topics for discussion. The Scope and Coverage of Green Economy Model (GEM) to be tackled by LMO II Walter L. Tolentino and the rest of the topics such as Overview on the Accomplishment of Task Force Puerto Galera, and Transition to Green Economy Model Program, Discussion on DAO 2017-08 "Guidelines in Operationalizing the Transition of the DENR's Programs and Projects into Green Economy Models" and Discussion on Republic Act No. 10771 "Philippine Green Jobs Act of 2001" will be discussed by LMO Culla-Umali.

The accomplishment of Task Force Puerto Galera which was created in CY 2018 was the demarcation of easement, mapping and identification of easement boundaries, survey of business establishments and households within easement and timberland, serving of Notice to Vacate and Notice of Violation, continuous monitoring of water

quality in Sabang and other concerned areas and inventory of establishment in compliance with the environmental laws of the twelve (12) Barangays of Puerto Galera namely: Poblacion, Sabang, Aninuan, Balatero, Dulangan, Palangan, San Antonio, San Isidro, Sinandigan, Sto. Nino, Tabinay and Villaflor. The topic was tackled by LMO Tolentino.

In 2018, they inventoried within easement and timberland area in which three (3) structured barangays were included namely, Aninuan, San Isidro, and Sabang with 625 in total. Fifty-two (52) was issued with violation on Article 51, then forty-one (41) had a compliant with NTV. In addition, she stated the number of violations of commercial establishments on relevant environmental laws. They inspected 225 establishments in three (3) barangays namely, Aninuan, San Isidro, and Sabang that made violations on R.A. 9275 (141), R.A. 8749 (70), R.A. 6969 (129), and P.D. 1586 (21). Then in 2019, they inventoried within easement wherein the coverage of 100% inventory were the three (3) barangays namely, Poblacion, Balatero, Tabinay in which 106 commercial and household establishments were inventoried. The number of violations with legal easement were 22 in Poblacion, 25 in Tabinay, and 24 in Balatero. Also, the summary of the number of violations per barangay per nature of violations were stated in which Barangay Poblacion has the most violations. In 2021 the transition to GEM Project, they covered six (6) coastal barangays namely, Palangan, Sinandigan, Villaflor, Dulangan, Sto. Niño, and San Antonio. She also added that in 2023, they will conduct a survey of easement on the said barangays.

Republic Act No. 10771 also known as the Philippine Green Jobs of 2016 was followed and discussed by LMO Culla-Umali. She explained that green jobs are employment that contributes in the preservation and restoration of the quality of environment, be it in the agriculture, industry or services sector. It include jobs that help to protect ecosystems and biodiversity, decarbonize the economy and minimize or altogether avoid generation of all forms of waste and pollution. Agencies involved in contributing the implementation of creating green jobs are the following:

1. Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE)
2. Department of Finance (DOF)
3. Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)
4. Department of Education (DepED)
5. Commission on Higher Education (CHED)
6. Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)
7. National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA)
8. Department of Trade and Industry (DTI)
9. Professional Regulation Commission (PRC)
10. Department of Science and Technology (DOST)
11. Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC)
12. Department of Tourism (DOT)
13. Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)

DENR Administrative Order No. 2017-08 "*Guidelines in the Operationalizing the transition of the DENR's Programs and Projects into Green Economy Models*" was discussed by LMO Umali. There are three phases in the operationalizing the transition to GEM: conduct of a Community Enterprise on a Focus Group Discussion (FGD), creation

of a Community Enterprise and formation of a Community's Management Service Center (CMSC).

During the consultation proper, more community enterprises within Puerto Galera attended the workshop. In fact, there were twelve (12) organizations delightedly joined and presented the status of each organization. Name of the organization, when it was created, number of members, location of the organization, salient features and how the DENR can help in their organization was described by every organization. Result of the consultation showed the different status of the community enterprise. The New Galerian Businessman Multipurpose Cooperative is a registered cooperative with 569 members and offers multi-purpose services while Baclayan Food Security, a People's Organization with members from 20 now only 9 members are still establishing and requires the assistance of other agencies like the DENR. In summary, a chart was prepared to show the condition of each organization:

The consultation ended at around 4:30 in the afternoon.

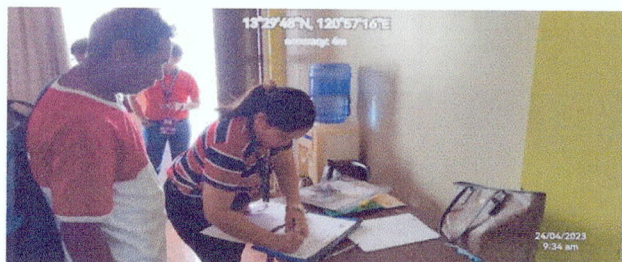
