Respectfully forwarded/endorsed herewith are copies of reports/updates on summary of Lawin Patrolling conducted within the area of jurisdiction of CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan with patrol data submitted from March 22 to April 20, 2023.

Based on the said summary, a total of 66.926 kilometers of foot and sea-borne patrolling activities within the conservation area was accomplished, equivalent to 133.85% of the 50 kilometers monthly target of this Office computed based on the 600 kilometers annual target indicated in the Work and Financial Plan for CY 2023. However, this figure includes patrol data with GPS error/s reported to the Lawin Help Desk for assessment and updating of FMB Lawin Unit. Consequently, the total accomplished patrol distance may still be further reduce/decrease.

Moreover, Patrol observation records show that the forest conditions in the areas patrolled varies from early to advanced secondary forests. Meanwhile, open areas both cultivated and uncultivated are also recorded. On the other hand, relatively high observations of moderate regeneration is likewise recorded which may indicate forest cover recovery.

Further, for this period, one (1) typhoon related threat and one (1) incidence of landslide and mudslide were recorded during patrolling activities at Barangay Malis, Brooke's Point, Palawan on March 22, 2023; meanwhile one (1) incidence of cutting of Bakir tree species was discovered at Barangay Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan on March 23, 2023. In response, pursuant to Book I, Chapter 1, Sec. 3 (i) of Republic Act (RA) 7160 or the Local Government Code, the patrol teams coordinated with the concerned Barangay LGUs to notify them concerning the observed threats and inform and request for their assistance in strengthening the monitoring activities within their respective areas of jurisdiction and to immediately report to the Office of DENR CENRO any occurrence of illegal activities therein.

Respectfully submitted herewith is the LAWIN Report/Update for the month of April 2023. This report provides summary of patrols conducted by this Office with patrol data submitted from March 22, 2023 to April 20, 2023. The patrol distance covered by each patroller for the specified dates and patrol IDs are likewise included.

Moreover, for this period, one (1) typhoon related threat and one (1) incidence of landslide and mudslide were recorded during patrolling conducted by Patrol Team 2 at Barangay Malis, Brooke's Point, Palawan on March 22, 2023; meanwhile one (1) incidence of cutting of Bakir tree species was discovered during patrolling activities of Patrol Team 3 at Barangay Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan on March 23, 2023. In response, the patrol teams coordinated with the concerned Barangay LGUs to notify them concerning the observed threats and inform and request for their assistance in strengthening the monitoring activities within their areas of jurisdiction and immediately report to the Office of DENR CENRO any occurrence of illegal activities.




