This pertains to the monitoring/assessment/evaluation conducted on April 27, 2023 of Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) area awarded to Barangay Baldat Agricultural Fisherfolks Organization (BAFISO) located at Brgy. Baldat, Culion, Palawan.

Please be informed of the following to wit:

1. On December 29, 2003, the Barangay Baldat Agricultural Fisherfolks Organization (BAFISO) was awarded Community Based Forest Management Agreement with CBFM No. R-IV-PAL03-38 and will expire on December 30, 2028. The CBFM area has a total of 99 hectares and falls within Unclassified Public Forest land.
2. The CBFM People's Organization was registered in the Securities Exchange Commission (SEC) on September 1, 2004.
3. On CY 2018, the Peoples's Organization (PO) was granted a livelihood project entitled Enrichment of Mangrove (Bakauan) with a total of 50 hectares and Culture of Mud Crab/fattening (Portunidas) in pen and cages.
4. The PO has a total of 21 members (13 males and 8 female members).

Be informed further that the Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and Five (5) Year Work Plan is currently completing the lacking requirements for the approval and affirmation.


The said PO with the assistance of personnel of this office assigned in Culion is continuously monitoring the CBFM-CARP project particularly the established plantation of Mangrove. No cutting/destruction or illegal activities was observed during the conduct of monitoring

Issues and Concern

Most of the members are inactive due to insufficient income generated from the project. Members are encouraged to participate the organization projects and programs.

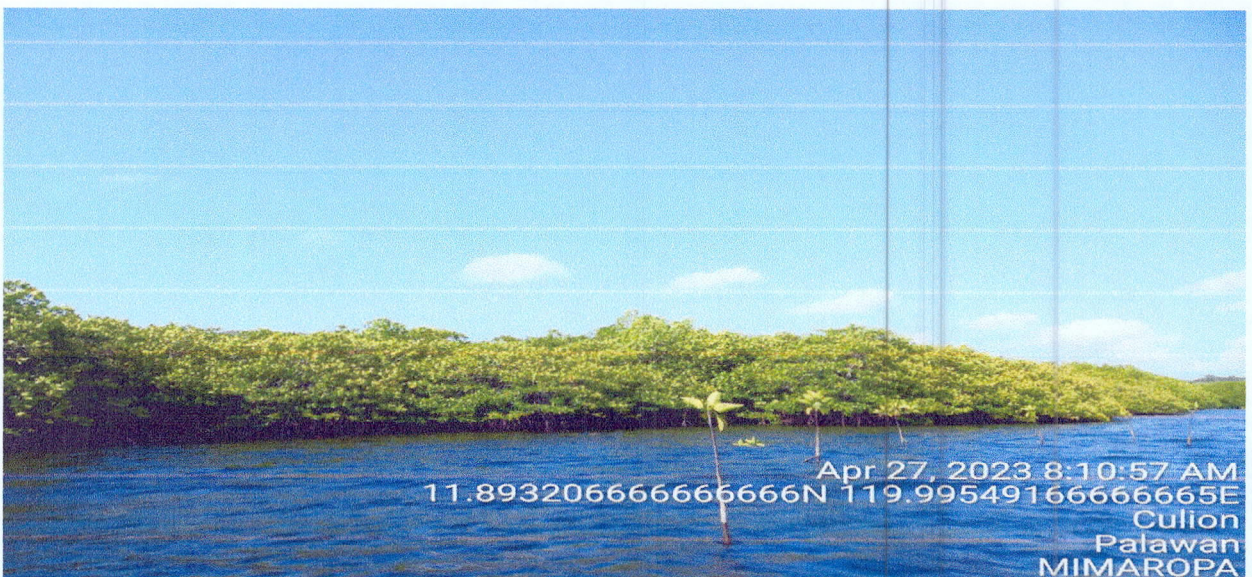




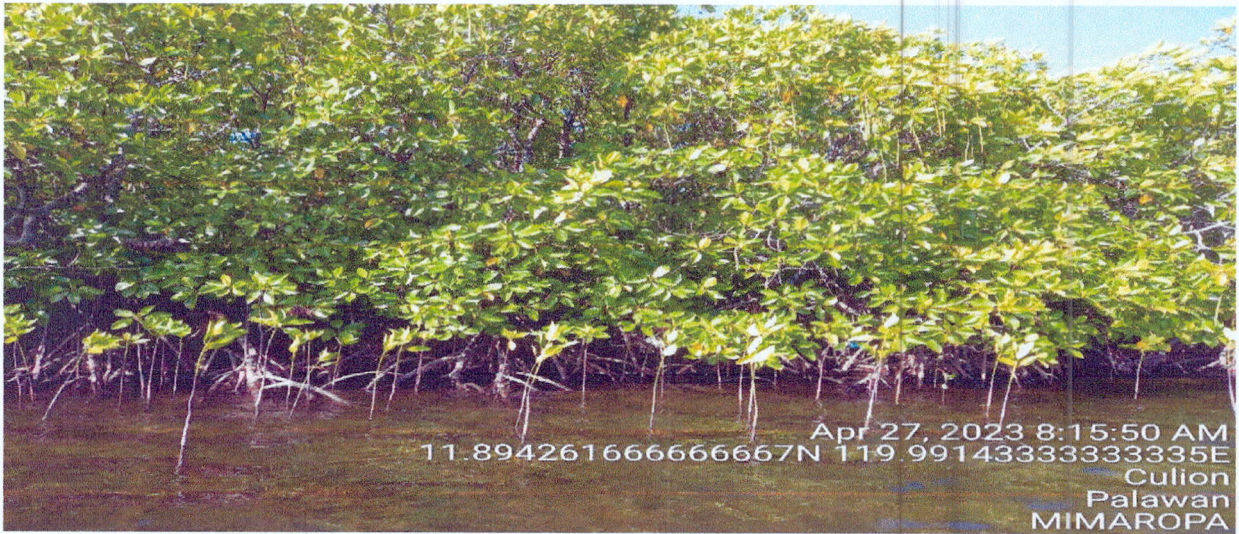
