SUBJECT : **REPORT ON El Niño ALERT**

Anent to the Memorandum of Eugene G. Cabrera, Chairperson, RDRRMC, Regional Director, OCD MIMAROPA regarding the above subject.

El Niño is a climate pattern that describes the unusual warming of surface waters in the eastern tropical Pacific Ocean. El Niño is the "warm phase" of a larger phenomenon called the El Niño-Southern Oscillation (ENSO). El Niño increases the likelihood of below-normal rainfall conditions, which could bring negative impacts (such as dry spells and droughts) in some areas of the country. However, over the western part of the country, above-normal rainfall conditions during the Southwest monsoon season (*Habagat*) may also be expected according to PAGASA.

Now, most parts of Oriental Mindoro are experiencing the heat. On the preparedness and measures, this office is taking its own initiatives in informing its personnel and staff on the adverse effect of El Niño not only on the environment but most especially on people. The undersigned have put information on notice boards on the effects of climate change and what is El Niño that is visible to everyone who enters and exits the buildings, including all clients as well as the staff and workers of this office. Reminding public employees to stay vigilant and place the greatest value on their health in order to serve their clients. Water pipelines and faucets were frequently inspected in all buildings and monitored for maintenance as well as water conservation. Hydration is crucial in situations like these, so the undersigned also urged everyone to drink plenty of water and take vitamins to support their stamina. Additionally, this office will spread information on El Niño in barangays with hot weather conditions.

In this regard, this office shall continue monitoring its respective jurisdiction in anticipation of the adverse effect of El Niño.
