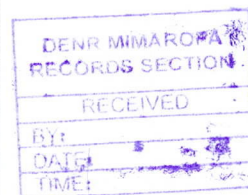


Respectfully forwarded is the email spot report from CENRO Coron, Palawan dated April 12, 2023 relative to the above subject.

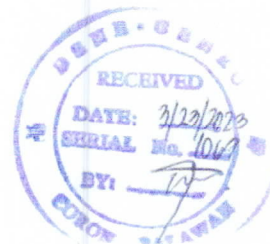

SUBJECT : **SPOT REPORT RE: APPREHEND OF REPORTED STOCKPILE OF MANGROVE TIMBER AT SITIO MARICABAN BRGY. SAN JOSE CORON, PALAWAN**



1. WHAT: Apprehended 13 pieces of mangrove timber
2. WHO: The undersigned personnel
3. WHEN: March 22, 2023 at around 2:49 in the afternoon
4. WHERE: Sitio Maricaban, Brgy. San Jose, Coron, Palawan
5. HOW: Please be informed that on March 22, 2023, the undersigned received a call from the concerned citizen that there was stock pile of mangrove timber in Sitio Maricaban Bgy. San Jose Coron Palawan.

The undersigned first coordinated in the barangay concerned. The team together with Kgd. Rodel Villoga and Fish Warden Jayson Livesto proceeded to the area and when we arrived, we observed the 13 pieces of mangrove timber hide under the sawali mat inside the property claimed by Green Night Global Company. The dimension of the said timber was 6 cm. diameter and 2.4 meter length each. The team asked Mr. Remond Gardoke - a caretaker of the said company, he narrated that he acquired those to Mr. Raffy Villacorta and then delivered to him for the fence post purposes.

He also admitted that cutting and possessing of undocumented forest products specifically mangrove trees are illegal based on the provision of PD 705, RA 8550 also known as Fisheries code of the Philippines, as well as Proc. No. 2152. Thus, he agreed that the mangrove timbers be voluntarily surrendered to the undersigned. The said mangrove timber was apprehended and delivered to the Brgy. hall of Brgy. San Jose for temporary custody.


The undersigned recommended that the following individuals be invited for a dialogue.
