Respectfully forwarded/endorsed herewith are copies of reports/updates on summary of Lawin Patrolling conducted within the area of jurisdiction of CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan with patrol data submitted from April 21 to May 15, 2023.

Based on the said summary, a total of 56.283 kilometers of foot and sea-borne patrolling activities within the conservation area was accomplished, equivalent to 112.57% of the 50 kilometers monthly target of this Office computed based on the 600 kilometers annual target indicated in the Work and Financial Plan for CY 2023. However, this figure includes patrol data with GPS error/s reported to the Lawin Help Desk for assessment and updating of FMB Lawin Unit. Consequently, the total accomplished patrol distance may still be further reduce/decrease.

Moreover, patrol observation records show that the forest conditions in the areas patrolled varies from open cultivated to advanced secondary forests. In addition, relatively high observations of moderate regeneration is likewise recorded which may indicate forest cover recovery.

Further, for this period, there was no environmental threat observed and recorded during patrolling/monitoring activities.


