This pertains to the Monitoring of corals, mangroves and seagrass activity under Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Management Program (CMEMP) for FY 2023.

Please be informed that the undersigned together with the Staff of PAMO RIWS were continuously conducting monitoring of seagrass, mangroves and corals in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary (RIWS). The methods used in the conduct of habitat monitoring activity was in accordance with the prescribe BMB Technical Bulletins No. 2017-05 and 2019-04.

Monitoring of seagrass in RIWS was conducted through a fixed/permanent transect site. For the monitoring of mangroves, fruiting, flowering, and or any disturbances was also noted within the two (2) kilometres permanent monitoring station. In addition, the monitoring of state of corals reefs was assessed and monitored using the photo transect method within the three (3) permanent monitoring stations in RIWS. Further, monitoring of mangroves, corals, and seagrass were continuously conducted.

2nd Quarter report will be submitted on or before June 20, 2023. Furthermore, the final report including data analysis, maps and photo documentations will be submitted on or before the 20th of September 2023.


