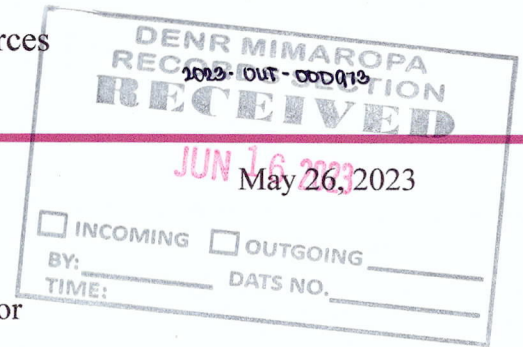

SUBJECT : **REPORT ON THE CELEBRATION OF MONTH OF THE OCEAN (MOO) CY 2023 IN PENRO MARINDUQUE**

Presidential Proclamation No. 57, issued in 1999 declared month of May as *“Month of the Ocean (MOO)”* with this year theme *“Sustainably Feed the Global Population”*. Relative to this PENRO, Marinduque conducted **Coastal Clean-up, Communication Education and Public Awareness (CEPA)** on May 18, 2023 in Barangay Banuyo, Gasan and **Mangrove Planting** in Barangay Sayao, Mogpog, Marinduque on May 19, 2023 in support to the said event.

Coastal Clean-up

Prior to the celebration of Month of the Ocean (MOO), the PENRO field personnel conducted site identification/ selection for the said event. Visited sites were the coastal areas of Brgys. Caigangan and Daykitin in municipality of Buenavista and Brgys. Antipolo, Banuyo and Pingan in Gasan municipality. Brgy. Banuyo in the municipality of Gasan was chosen as clean-up site and a venue for CEPA since this barangay cater the criteria for the two activities such as long shoreline to be cleaned up and a convenient hall for CEPA.

The coastal clean-up started at 6 oclock in the morning on May 18, 2023. It was participated with more than 110 individuals spearheaded by the DENR-PENRO Marinduque together with the Brgy. LGU officials, Representatives from the provincial and municipal LGU, PNP, BFP, Fraternity Group, Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries of barangay, and among others. Coastal area cleaned were estimated 1 km. in length. Trashes/wastes collected were separated from non-biodegradable and biodegradable. Non-biodegradable wastes like plastics and straws were put in the sacks handled by the municipal garbage collector for proper disposal. They have collected 21 sacks of non-biodegradable wastes while biodegradable waste such as leaves, paper, coconut husks and twigs were buried underground.



Communication Education and Public Awareness

A follow through activity Communication Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) was conducted in the barangay hall with the same group and participants. This activity seeks to educate public and private stakeholders on the different environmental laws which will allow individuals to be aware, responsible and cautious with their actions towards environment. After the messages from the head of offices and representatives, series of lectures were delivered by the resource persons from the DENR PENRO Marinduque. These topics includes Climate Change Act of 2009 (R.A 9729) which was delivered by Ms. Nannette M. Joven_Forester III and In-Charge Monitoring and Enforcement Section which she emphasized global warming as resulted by the greenhouse gases trapped into the atmosphere, She also discussed climate change adaptation measures and some precautions that an individual could contribute to lessen the emission of greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. She'd also shown some examples of the effect/ impact of climate change not only to human being but also to coastal and marine environment.

Another topic discussed was the “Impact of Human Activities in Coastal and Marine Environment”. This lecture was facilitated by Mr. Joybert F. Mijares_Senior Forest Management Specialist of PENRO Marinduque which he highlighted different harmful human activities such as mining, coastal development, sea bed dredging, deforestation illegal fishing practices, pollution etc. In addition, He emphasized that *“In every development, there is always destruction of the environment”* which was the truth and witnessed all over the world.

Ecological Solid Wastes Management Act of 2000 (R.A 9003)” was discussed by Mr. Jonathan M. Motol_SWEET-ENMO from EMB. He shown different local dumpsites that do not follow the regulations on proper operation and their action taken for improvement. He also explained proper wastes segregation including prohibitions of the said Act. Likewise, questions and clarifications were immediately addressed during the session. Attendees were observed interested during discussion.

Mangrove Planting

In line with the observance of MOO with the theme “Sustainably Feed the Global Population”, the DENR PENRO Marinduque and partners from LGU conducted mangrove planting in Sitio Dinahunan, Sayao, Mogpog, Marinduque on May 19, 2023. A total of 200 propagules of Bakawang lalake were planted. Said planted propagules were provided with stakes to keep erected while on growing. LGU Sayao was tasked to monitor and maintain the newly planted mangrove. The said event was participated by the selected DENR-PENRO personnel, PNP, and Sangguniang barangay of Sayao, Mogpog and its local community members. A total of 90 participants with 41 males and 49 females.



Issues and Challenges

As reported earlier, 21 sacks of non-biodegradable wastes/trashes were collected along 1km. shoreline. Approximately, in every single pace in shore area, there are plastics. Since, Marinduque is an island province having 186.33 km coastline, it is more likely to have more wastes within its coasts, given that in every kilometer coastline, there are about 21 sacks of plastics to be collected during coastal clean-up in a particular season (*excluding those in esteros, canal, rivers, sea bottom etc.*). Approximately there are almost 4,000 sacks of assorted plastic wastes that will be collected within the coastal area of the province alone. In addition, macro plastics are another silent issue in the province especially in coastal area since these wastes were noticed and recorded during coastal clean-up. Studies of *Critchell, Kay, et al., (2019)* said that macro plastics have induced alarm among scientific and management bodies as an emerging marine and coastal contaminant. Recent studies suggest that these small plastic particles are ubiquitous in the marine system, as they have been recorded in every coastal and marine habitat around the world. The presence of microplastics in the environment has been shown to have negative consequences for many marine wildlife species, such as marine birds, turtles, and fish.

Recommendation

Communication Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) deals with the processes that attract, motivate and mobilize individual and collective action for biodiversity management and protection. Unfortunately it is not sufficient to simply tell people about coastal and marine ecosystem/ biodiversity importance and what is happening so that they can act accordingly. The changes required from people will not come through rational individual choice alone. Practitioners need to think differently on using communication, education and public awareness rather than just as a way to make scientific information available to the public *Hesselink, Frits, et al. (2007)*. Likewise, CEPA, Coastal Clean-up, Mangrove planting and other related environmental activities that requires stakeholder's participation should be done on regular basis and simultaneously.

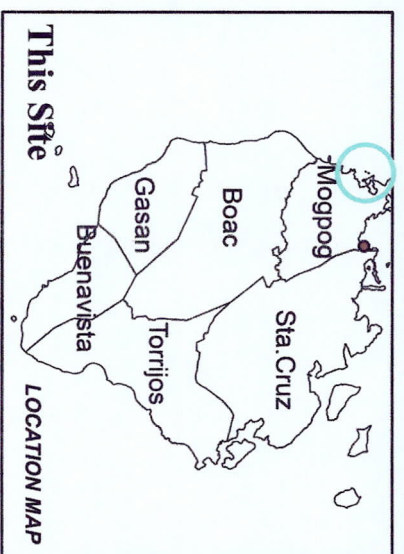

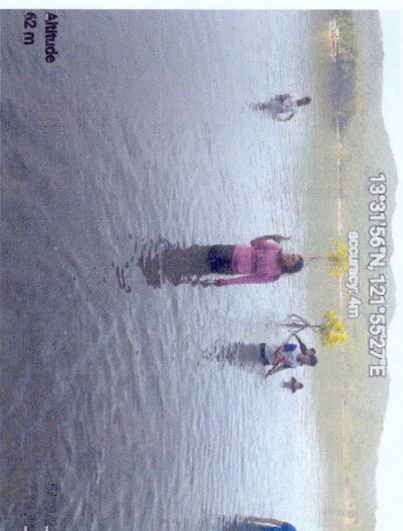
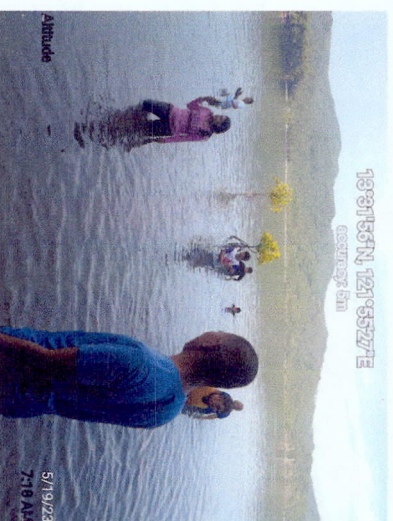
MANGROVE TREE PLANTING SITE LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAYAO

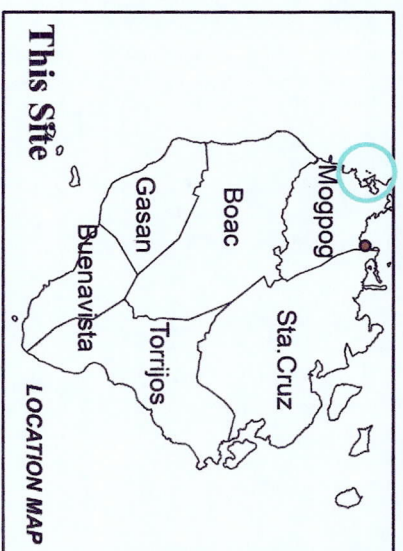

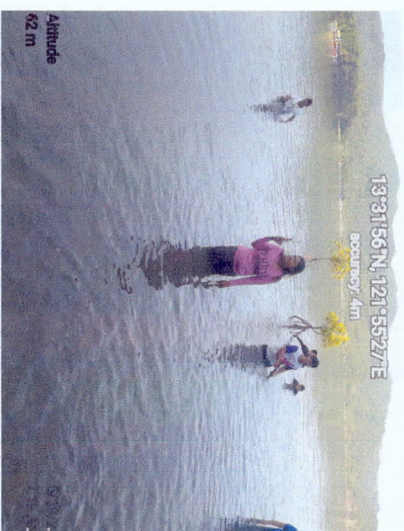
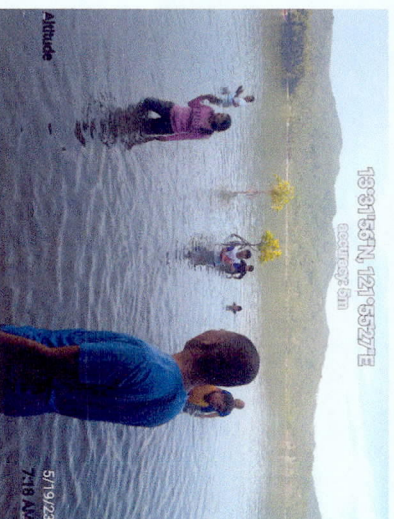
MANGROVE TREE PLANTING SITE LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAYAO
