Respectfully submitted is the attached Memorandum dated March 27, 2023 from CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro regarding the above cited subject.

The forest in Mindoro is vulnerable to severe damaged caused by forest fires and in order to protect the reforestation projects like the National Greening Program, establishing a 10 hectares (10 meters width and 10 kilometers length) fireline within the identified area in Brgy. Rosacara, Bansud, Oriental Mindoro was undertaken to prevent the spread of fire to forest plantations. The said establishment was done by the indigenous people (IP) with constant monitoring of concerned staff from CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro.

The NGP operation of MIMAROPA Region mainly focused on its plantation establishment for FY 2022 implementation and plantation maintenance and protection of the NGP sites planted in CY 2020 and 2021.

In line with this, be informed that plantation establishment for CY 2022 accomplished 100% with an area of 538 hectares. On the other hand the maintenance and protection for second year effectively maintained 89.29% of the targeted areas, while the third year maintenance and protection effectively maintained 89% of 141 hectares.

Please be informed that with respect to your directive to implement the O.P. Decision dated September 05, 2005, this Office previously instructed the PENRO Palawan to implement the O.P. Decision. However, then Land Management Officer (LMO) III Florante A. Candido raised several concerns regarding the reinstatement of MSA V-7829 of Manuel Ita, now Itaralde.

We are attaching copies of our Memorandum dated November 19, 2020 issued by then Regional Executive Director Maria Lourdes G. Ferrer for the Undersecretary for Field Operations and Environment, and Memorandum dated September 19, 2016 issued by then Regional Director Oscar C. Dominiguez for the Undersecretary for Legal Services and Attached Agencies.<sup>1</sup>

The request of Ms. Briones et al. for survey authority over portions of Lot 67 is held in abeyance pending further instruction regarding the concerns raised by then LMO III Candido.

Be informed that NGP projects within identified Barangays under NTF-ELCAC have an aggregate total area for development of 783.14 hectares located in seven (7) ELCAC Barangays, in Cabacao, Naibuan, Batasan in Occidental Mindoro, Milagrosa, San Isidro in Oriental Mindoro, Salogon, and Samariniana in Palawan with 337 engaged families.

Relative thereto, a total area of 783.14 hectares with 402,860 seedlings is being maintained under the jurisdiction of PENRO Oriental Mindoro, Occidental Mindoro and PENRO Palawan for 3rd year maintenance and protection activities.

As to the financial status, a total of Php 1,076,600.00 of contracted amount was disbursed by PENRO Occidental Mindoro.



Submitted is the physical accomplishment report on the Enhanced National Greening Program (ENGP) CY 2021 3<sup>rd</sup> year maintenance and protection for the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of February 2023.

The aforementioned report indicates that CENRO Roxas has an average survival rate of 85.79% consisting of 6 PO partners and CENRO Soccoro has an average rate of 88.28% which is represented by 4 PO partners. These data are based on the result of the assessment of Inspection and Acceptance Committee (IAC) for the 2<sup>nd</sup> billing in the second semester of CY 2022.

Contracts for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year maintenance and protection at present is not yet awarded. PENRO is still awaiting for the guidelines on the increase of funds for 3<sup>rd</sup> year maintenance and protection from your office.

Continuous regular monitoring is being conducted by NGP concerned personnel of the CENRO together with our partner PO\$\$.
