AUTHORIZING HONORABLE V. DENNIS SOCRATES, GOVERNOR. PROVINCE OF PALAWAN, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN MEMORANDUM OF **UNDERSTANDING** (MOU), WITH VARIOUS GOVERNMENT **AGENCIES** AND INSTITUTIONS **INVOLVING** THE REGIONAL INCLUSIVE INNOVATION IN MIMAROPA (RIIM) FOR INNOVATION AND STRENGTHEN PARTNERSHIPS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, AND INNOVATION (RDI) ACTIVITIES IN THE REGION

WHEREAS, according to the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028, the critical challenges affecting the research development, technology, and innovation sector are (1) underdeveloped research culture and productivity, (2) Insufficient spending on R&D, (3) the need for a more vigorous intellectual property (IP) culture, (4) barriers to building innovative and entrepreneurial culture, (5) underdeveloped linkages among stakeholders in the R&D, technology, innovation system, and (6) lack of focus on information about markets or users and market system requirements;

WHEREAS, the Regional Inclusive Innovation in MIMAROPA or RIIM aims to institutionalize efforts In engaging the academe, industry, regional line agencies, and other relevant stakeholders and collaborate towards the development of market-oriented research and the development of outputs that lead to commercialization and increased regional competitiveness;

WHEREAS, through the Regional Inclusive Innovation in MIMAROPA or RIIM, the following actions will take place, to wit: (1) banner enterprise will be identified, (2) key Innovation actors, initiatives, and efforts will be mapped, (3) innovation players In Government, Academe, and Industry will be linked through strategic dialogue, and (4) key programs and services towards industry needs will be aligned;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a Province, as a Local Government Unit, shall exercise powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to the efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the Local Government Code provides that every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the power to enter into contracts, as well as to exercise other powers as granted to corporations, subject to the limitations provided by the Local Government Code and other laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Honorable Ryan D. Mainta duly seconded, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize Honorable V. Dennis Socrates, Governor, Province of Palawan, to enter into and sign Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with various Government Agencies and Institutions involving the Regional Inclusive Innovation in MIMAROPA (RIIM), for the innovation and strengthen partnerships for the implementation of Research, Development and Innovation (RDI) activities in the Region;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Provincial Government of Palawan will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Science and Technology (DOST)-MIMAROPA; the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI)-MIMAROPA; the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA)-MIMAROPA; the Commission on Higher Education (CHED)-MIMAROPA; the Department of Agriculture (DAR)-MIMAROPA; the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)-MIMAROPA; the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)-MIMAROPA; the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR)-MIMAROPA; the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro; the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro; the Provincial Government of Romblon; the Occidental Mindoro State College; the Mindoro State University; the Marinduque State College; the Romblon State University; the Palawan State University; the Western Philippines University; the City Government of Calapan; and the City Government of Puerto Princesa;
