Please be informed that the Lawin Patrollers of CENRO Coron were able to conduct fifiteen (15) patrol works covering a total distance of Eighty point seventy six (80.76) kilometers within the conservation areas of Barangays 6, San Nicolas, Borac, Turda, Guadalupe and Decalachao of Coron Municipality; Sto, Nino, Concepcion, Bogtong, Old Busuanga, New Busuanga and Buluang in the municipality Of Busuanga; while Barangay Galoc and Luac in the municipality of Culion. Patrollers meant to monitor existing watersheds/water source.

Please be informed further that there are two (2) cutting of trees and one (1) grass fire recorded/observed with two (2) apprehensions during patrolling. Same incidents were reported to Barangay concern/s for information and monitoring assistance thereof especially on remaining and critical watersheds/water source.







This reports presents trends in observations of forest condition, regeneration, threats and indicator species. The combined presentation allows for an evaluation if protection efforts are effective, conservation targets are met and the forest achieves the desired future forest condition. Protection efforts are effective, when records of forest condition, regeneration and indicator species show an upward trend towards more observations more and denser regeneration, particularly in degraded forest areas. Increasing trends in indicator species suggest that the improved forest condition is providing a better habitat for forest dependent species. All trends presented are put in relation to the patrol effort to provide comparability. Forest cover data were derived from 2003 and 2010 NAMRIA land cover maps.
