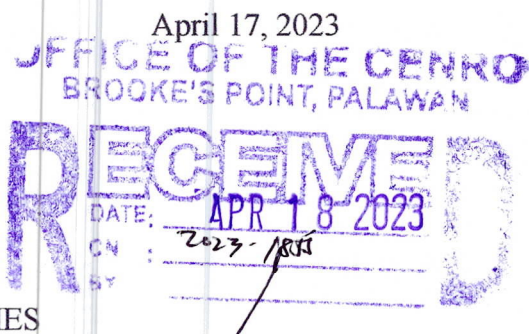

Background

Every day, we keep hearing about the call to save our remaining forest. As forest is our defence against natural calamities and mitigate the impacts of climate change. We are also aware that Philippines Biodiversity is considered one of the richest in the world. In spite of this, destruction of our forest is continues and situation is at risk, due to illegal logging, timber smuggling, slash and burn, charcoal making and other forestry related illegal activities. To address this problem and protect the remaining forest, enforcement of environmental and natural resources laws, rules and regulation must be strictly implemented.

As per DENR Administrative Order No. 2019-01 "*Functions of Regional Offices under the Rationalized Organizational Structure of DENR*", the Enforcement and Monitoring Section shall be responsible for the enforcement of DENR laws, rules and regulation including but not limited to the conduct of patrol of forest land including protected areas as well as DENR Enforcement officers and coordination with all law enforcement arm of the government (i.e. PNP, AFP, NBI etc.) and various taskforce/ council such as but not limited to POGI, DEM and other units of Regional Office and other law enforcement agencies. This section shall be responsible for the implementation of DAO 2018-18, including monitoring and compliance of all permits, leases and tenure holders of the Department. It shall perform other function that may be assigned by the higher authority.

CENRO Brooke's Point Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) is composed of twenty nine (29) personnel (25 regular and 4 contract of service) led by Deputy CENRO Joselito A. Eyala as Chief, MES. They are assigned to man the DENR Forest Products Motoring Station in Brgy. Abo-abo, Sofronio Espanola led by Team leader FR Leandro L. Lapangan manned within Municipality of Sofronio Española, two (2) Patrol Base Stations located in Brgy. Lada, Brooke's Point led by Team Leader FTII Abraham B. Vicente manned within municipality of Brooke's Point, Palawan and in Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza led by FTII Kennit Francis V. Valdestamon manned within municipality of Bataraza, Palawan and DENR Sub-Office in the municipality of Balabac led by FTI RJ Kieth Immanuel I. Idlana that constantly conducted LAWIN Foot patrolling, monitoring of forest cover, surveillance, patrolling and operating check to monitor possible illegal activities and transport of forest products and perform other forestry and environmental related activities within their respective areas. Further CENRO Special Order No. 033-2020 series of 2020 the creation of CENRO Quick Response Team which shall immediately act and respond to all reported illegal forest activities and other environmental issues and concerns. In addition to this, there are three (3) embedded personnel from EMB and MGB that were assisted to conduct investigation and monitoring on ECC compliance and mining related activities in line with DAO 2018-18.

2. Sustainable Implementation of the LAWIN Forest and Biodiversity Protection System

The DENR has LAWIN System patrol. LAWIN is a forest and Biodiversity protection system. It is used to enhance monitoring of the remaining forest cover, to track conducted patrol, route document forest situation and recorded illegal activities and or forest threats encountered in Forest Lands and Conservation Areas including graduated NGP project sites.

MES Patrollers constantly conduct LAWIN Patrolling activities and seaborne patrolling including responding to threats within the timberland, conservation areas and graduated NGP project site in their patrol sectors in the municipalities of Sofronio Española, Brooke’s Point, Bataraza and Balabac, Palawan in accordance with the quarterly patrol plan and accomplished the monthly target patrol distance of 12.5 kilometers based on the work and financial plan CY 2023. Based on the report of LAWIN Data Manager. The Patrollers patrolled a total distance of 170.742 kilometres this first quarter CY 2023.



3. MULTI- SECTORAL FOREST PROTECTION COMMITTEE (MFPC)

ACTION PLAN TO MINIMIZE ILLEGAL LOGGING IN IDENTIFIED HOTSPOT AREA WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF CENRO BROOKE’S POINT

3.1 MULTI- SECTORAL FOREST PROTECTION COMMITTEE (MFPC) OF BATARAZA, PALAWAN.

Based on the previous information, CENRO Brooke’s Point is one of the identified illegal logging hotspots areas in MIMAROPA Region due to high incidence of apprehensions of undocumented forest products within its jurisdiction particularly in the Municipality of Bataraza.

To address/ minimize and neutralized the issues on illegal logging, charcoal making and other illegal forest related activities in the municipality This office thru MES had prepared a 6 months action plan to be conducted through capacitation, strengthening of linkages and coordination with the different agencies and stakeholders in the municipality of Bataraza, Palawan.


On September 02-04, 2020 coordination with the DILG/ MLGOO personnel and MENRO of LGU Bataraza re: MFPC creation/ reactivation was also conducted to discuss the proposed action plan and activities to address the issues on illegal logging, charcoal making and other illegal forest related activities in the municipality.

Thus MFPC Bataraza is hereby organized/ created On October, 2020, the Local Chief Executive of Bataraza, Mayor Abraham M. Ibba issued an Executive Order No. 17 “An Order Creating the Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (MFPC) in municipality of Bataraza.

On May 04, 2023 Bataraza MFPC Members adopted and approved the MFPC Resolution No. 2022-001 entitled “A Resolution requesting for the Sangguniang Bayan to issue a Resolution for the Delisting of the Municipality of Bataraza from the list of identified illegal logging hotspot areas in DENR MIMAROPA Region” .

On February 23, 2023 Bataraza Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (BMFPC) meeting held at RTN Clubhouse, Barangay Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan. The meeting was attended by seven (7) out of the regular 13 members/representatives of the created Municipal MFPC of Bataraza, Palawan. Representatives from the Municipal Agriculture Office, Coral Bay Nickel Corporation as well as the newly deputized ENROs from Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation likewise attended the meeting. MENRO Reynaldo C. Rivera, *EnP* is the Acting Presiding Officer and the following matters were discussed:

1. Status of Implementation of MLGU Forward Action Plan
 - ECOMS II Rachel H. Appie briefly presented and discussed about the accomplished activities for CY 2022 of DENR CENRO Brooke's Point in coordination with the Municipal LGU in line with the forward action plan to sustain the drive/initiatives against illegal logging within the AOJ of Bataraza in support of the request for its exclusion/delisting in the list of illegal logging hotspot areas in MIMAROPA region.
2. Planned/Proposed activities of DENR to support MLGU initiatives to sustain neutralizing illegal logging activities in the municipality
3. Schedules of activities for CY 2023
 - In support of the detailed activities on the MLGU Forward Action Plan adopted by the Municipal MFPC of Bataraza, the following proposed activities have been discussed including its tentative schedules
 - a. Inventory of occupants/claimants within the mangrove area
 - b. Meeting with Barangay Officials and IEC Caravan
 - To be facilitated by MFPC members
 - Regular radio campaign with emphasis to permitting
 - Finalized schedule of IEC caravan
 - c. WHEREAS, the Bataraza MFPC is intended to provide forum where sectors from the community and government agencies within the Municipality of Bataraza, Palawan convene to take action together on law enforcement and forest protection issues, make recommendations and support the DENR in its forest protection programs;

WHEREAS, the parties are committed to work hand in hand for the protection, management and conservation of our environment and natural resources with strong participation of stakeholders;

WHEREAS, the involvement of each member agency/organization in the discussion of illegal forestry and other environmental activities and in the formulation of an effective law enforcement and forest protection scheme/strategies is highly crucial;

WHEREAS, in line with the initiatives of the Municipality of Bataraza to sustain neutralizing illegal logging activities in the municipality specified in its submitted MLGU Forward Action Plan which was then adopted and endorsed by the Bataraza MFPC through Resolution No. 2022-002 entitled "A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND ENDORSING THE PLAN ACTIVITIES/FORWARD ACTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BATARAZA TO NEUTRALIZE ILLEGAL LOGGING AND ILLEGAL CHARCOAL MAKING ACTIVITIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY TO FURTHER SUPPORT THE REQUEST FOR ITS' DELISTING FROM THE LIST OF IDENTIFIED ILLEGAL LOGGING HOTSPOT AREAS IN DENR MIMAROPA REGION" dated August 31, 2022, it is necessary to create a Quick Response Team who will immediately act and respond to all reported (illegal) forest activities and other environmental issues and concerns and conduct surveillance operations and apprehend illegally source lumber/timber and other forest products including conveyances, implements and tools and equipment used therein, gather evidences and other vital information for the filing of case in court against the perpetrators and/or violators within the municipality of Bataraza, Palawan in accordance with a Standard Intelligence and Response Protocol/Process;

WHEREAS, upon motion of Forester Leonard T. Caluya, CENR Officer, Brooke's Point, Palawan, all members of the Committee unanimously agreed and signify to the passage of a Resolution formally creating a Quick Response Team and an Intelligence and Response Protocol/Process;





4. IDENTIFICATION OF FIRE PRONE AREAS AND FIRE LINE ESTABLISHMENT

On March 30, 2023 the MES personnel submitted report on the conducted Identification Of Fire Prone Areas And Fire Line Establishment which endorsed by the office dated March 31, 2023. The identified fire prone area with a total of 25.55 hectares located at So. Babanga Barangay Malis Brooke’s Point Palawan falls within the graduated NGP site of this office established on CY 2017. The established fire line is 580 meters in length and 5 meters width with an area of 2,900 square meters or 0.29 hectare. The fire break/ line main objective is to prevent and control the fire if happened for the protection of trees present in the area as well as the crops planted by the IP community.

Said area is characterized by the presence of shrubs and grasses including perennial crops which makes it highly susceptible to fire occurrence particularly during summer/ dry season. Likewise, as disclosed by the adjacent community the same area is prone to always being accidentally burned due to traditional kaingin practices. Prior to the establishment of fire line, a meeting with the community leaders and contractor was facilitated to raise awareness concerning forest fire. There was existing Fire Brigade in the area which was organized in CY 2022.

5. Apprehension of Undocumented Forest Products including NTFP, vehicles and equipment's.

5.1 Apprehension


Based on the record, there are four (4) apprehensions of undocumented forest products recorded having a total of Seventy one (71) pieces (757.07 bd.ft) of assorted lumbers and Two hundred forty six (246) pieces (19.577m³) of assorted timber in the municipalities of Bataraza, Brooke's Point and Balabac, Palawan. The apprehended forest products were deposited at DENR CENRO Brooke's Point Compound, Patrol Base III Rio Tuba Monitoring Station, and Balabc Sub-office for safekeeping.

Moreover, this section conduct necessary administrative proceeding over the apprehended items and submit all necessary documents pursuant to DAO 97-32 with categorical comments and recommendations to serve as basis for the preparation of confiscation order by the DENR higher authorities and on- going preparation of needed legal documents for filling of criminal case against the forest violators/ perpetrators of environmental laws particularly PD 705.
