

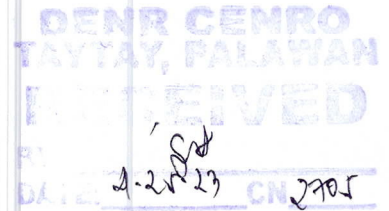

Please be informed that LAWIN Patrollers of this Office accomplished a total of 19 kilometres travelled distance.

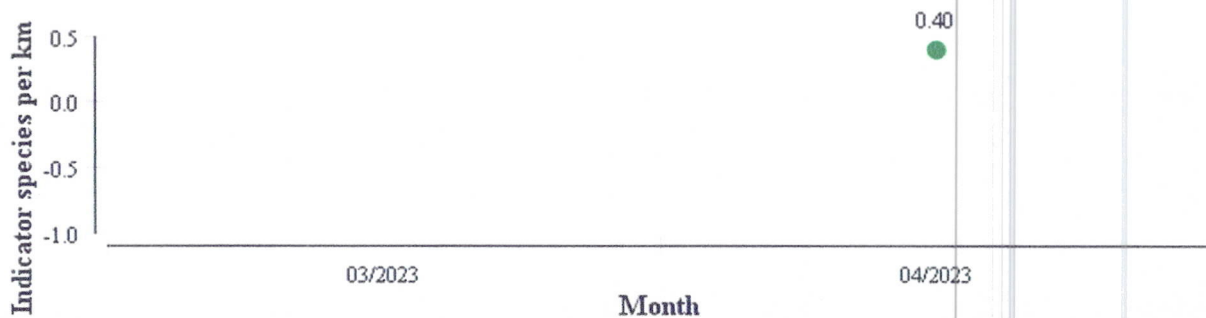

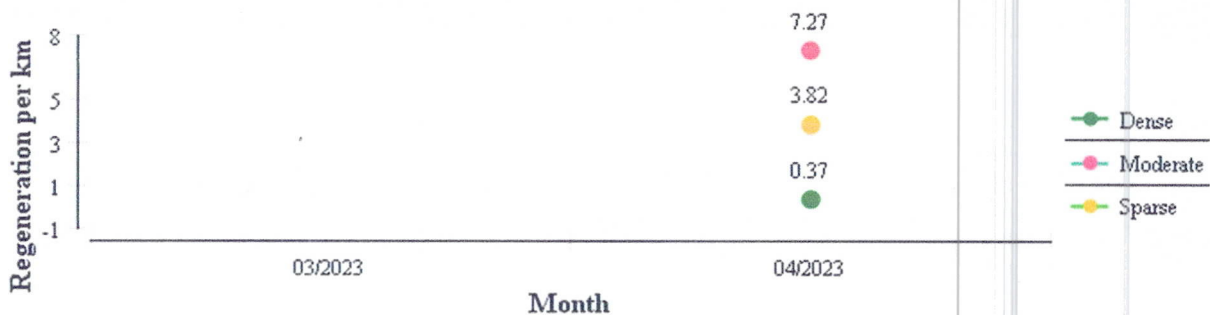
Trends of Observations per Patrol Kilometer in the Forest Conservation Area
