Minutes of the Meeting
CEPA/IEC ON ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
(Republic Act No. 9003)
March 24, 2023

One of the strategic plans of Green Economy Model (GEM) in Puerto Galera is to conduct a CEPA/IEC on Ecological Solid Waste Management.

On March 24, 2023 at 9:30 in the morning at Muelle, Barangay Poblacion, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro, an Information, Education and Communication (IEC) on Republic Act 9003 also known as Ecological Solid Waste Management was conducted. The activity was headed by Land Management Officer III and GEM Focal Maria Alva Renelyn A. Culla-Umali, Section Chief of Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS) of CENRO-Socorro. The meeting was attended by Barangay Local Government Units and Municipal Local Government Unit of Puerto Galera, staff from Puerto Galera National High School and CENRO Socorro personnel.

Special Investigator Walter L. Tolentino facilitated the event and at the same time led the opening prayer. The National Anthem was played followed by DENR Hymn and the LGU song of Puerto Galera, "The Amazing Puerto Galera." Each participant was requested to introduce himself. A welcome remarks was rendered by Hon. Jomer Sandoval, Chairman of Committee on Environment. "Kung walang magandang kapaligiran, wala din tayo", he remarked.

CENR Officer Rodel M. Boyles delivered his message and gave emphasis of Puerto Galera as one of the GEM site in the country. "Why would you kill the goose that lays a golden egg", he said pertaining to Puerto Galera. "Solid waste is considered as one of the critical problems in the area because of influx of tourist means environmental destruction and GEM played an important role," he added.

LMO Umali cited the overview of the topics to be discussed. The Ecological Solid Waste Management Act (RA 9003) and Resource Recovery Program for Solid Waste Management in Puerto Galera and open forum.

The first part, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA No. 9003) was imparted by Ecosystems Management Specialist II Carlota Levinia Jugno from Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) MIMAROPA. According to EMS Jugno, RA 9003 was signed on January 26, 2001 with an objective of "Zero Basura". The waste generation in the Philippines is 40,000 tons/day. Before the implementation of RA 9003 or the traditional method, the waste generation was only 90 per cent while during the implementation of RA 9003, it is already 100 per cent. Puerto Galera has a low waste generation because it follows the Act and also compliance to Section 21- Segregation at Source, Section 33-Segregated Collection and Section 37-Recovery/Recycling Systems, Closure/Conversion of Open Dumps to CDF, Controlled Disposal Facilities, Final Disposal Systems.

Subsequently, Dr. Joan Margarette A. Yap discussed the Resource Recovery for Solid Waste in Puerto Galera. She admitted that their municipality has no sanitary land fill and will never have because 90 per cent of their land is forestland but they have created an alternative process. All their residual waste are delivered to Calapan City once a month. In CY 2016, seventeen (17) tons per month were brought to Calapan City and now it's only two (2) tons when they implemented the Republic Act 9003 and only two (2) junk shops were established before and now it already has seventeen (17) junkshops. Barangay Sabang is the only Barangay which adapted the ordinance regarding solid waste management and hoping that all Barangays in Puerto Galera will also implement this ordinance.


MENRO Yap presented a Smart Model for Local Government Solid Waste Management Program, the "*Basurang Likha, May Bagong Mukha*". *Basura* converted into *pasyalan* through this program. The program has five (5) components: (1) the use of Resource Recovery Technology, (2) Joint Venture Agreement/Public-Private Partnership, (3) Establishment of a cost Efficient and Environment Friendly Technology and (4) Development of a Community Managed Resource Recovery Park and (5) Institutionalization of Barangay ESWM Ordinance. Through this program, Puerto Galera will reduce climate change impact, conserve resources, build community, create local circular economy and create jobs. Last message of MENRO Yap in her presentation was "Let's do this now!" quoting Mayor Rocky D. Ilagan's word.

In behalf of Mayor of Puerto Galera, MENRO Yap was grateful for the presence of everyone who attended the meeting. The event adjourned at 12:00 noon.

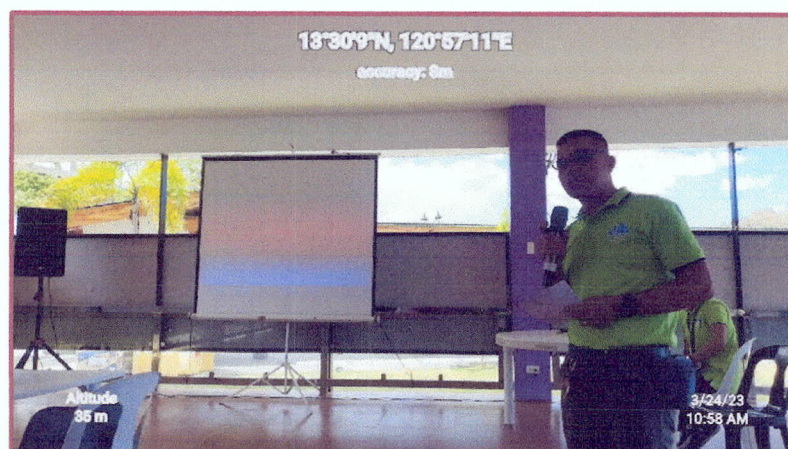

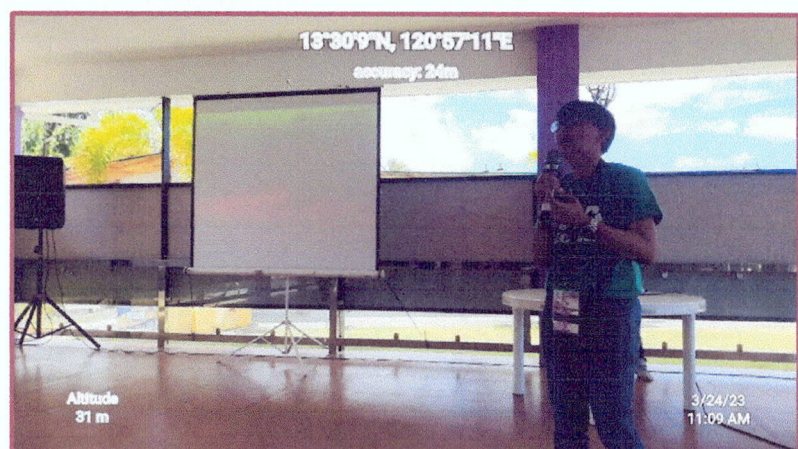
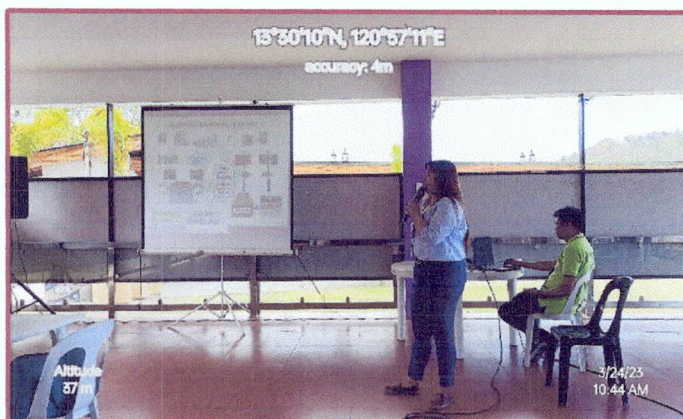
