



This refers to the letter sent via electronic mail of Mrs. Alicia Ibarra regarding a land with an area of 20 hectares (in the name of Petra Cruz; part of it is at "Public Land Subdivision Project [PLS-21]; Lot 2 Pls-21 14.6359 under SA (III-11) 219 — validated by the PENRO in 1989 still under the name of Petra Cruz") located in Pulong Bagto, Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro. She alleged that she "went to Mindoro xxx and Geodetic Engineer Mastaguhan(sic) said that there is still 4 hectares left and I applied for it. However, Mr. Cesar Quebec reacted and asked me in an uncourteous way. I have fought for this land since 1989, 2005, 2021, and until now 2023. And I am still hoping that I can claim a portion of my father's property."

For the alleged 4 hectares, the CENRO Sablayan is directed to issue a Memorandum to Investigate to a designated Land Investigation Officer (LIO) to ascertain the actual condition of the lot/s, the improvements existing thereon, the occupants thereof and such other matters relevant to the investigation pursuant to Section 3.

On the other hand, for the other portions of the claimed 20-hectare land which appear to be covered by Original Certificates of Title (OCTs) and Transfer Certificates of Title (TCTs), Mrs. Ibarra should file a separate verified Petition under Section 30 of DAO 2016-31.

We are attaching a copy of our letter addressed to Mrs. Ibarra regarding her complaint.

Submit a report on action taken within ten (10) days upon receipt hereof.





COMPLAINT OVER A LAND LOCATED IN PULONG BAGTO, MAMBURAO, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

Madam,

Isang makakalikasang araw!

This refers to your letter sent via electronic mail regarding a land with an area of 20 hectares (in the name of Petra Cruz; part of it is at "Public Land Subdivision Project [PLS-21]; Lot 2 Pls-21 14.6359 under SA (III-11) 219 — validated by the PENRO in 1989 still under the name of Petra Cruz") located in Pulong Bagto, Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro. You alleged that you "went to Mindoro xxx and Geodetic Engineer Mastaguhan(sic) said that there is still 4 hectares left and I applied for it. However, Mr. Cesar Quebec reacted and asked me in an uncourteous way. I have fought for this land since 1989, 2005, 2021, and until now 2023. And I am still hoping that I can claim a portion of my father's property."

Further, you also stated that an investigation was conducted by Ms. Lyn Agaho(sic) from the Enforcement Division in January 2022, but you were not given a copy of the investigation report.

Please be informed that an investigation report is considered an "information, documents or records known by reason of official capacity and are deemed as confidential, xxx inquiries or investigation conducted by them in the exercise of their administrative xxx power". Thus, it is exempt under Item No. 5 of Memorandum Circular No. 15¹.

Pursuant to DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2016-312, there are two kinds of Office-Initiated Investigations to resolve land claims and conflicts cases:

- 1. Unpatented or Unregistered Land (Section 3)
- 2. Registered Patents (Section 27)

Here, with respect to the alleged remaining four hectares, the CENRO shall issue a Memorandum to Investigate to a designated Land Investigation Officer (LIO) to ascertain the actual condition of the lot/s, the improvements existing thereon, the occupants thereof and such other matters relevant to the investigation pursuant to Section 3.

On the other hand, the other portions of the claimed 20-hectare land appears to be covered by Original Certificates of Title (OCTs) and Transfer Certificates of Title (TCTs) and you are claiming that said land is part of your father's (Rodrigo) lot, that you have a declaration of the property, and that you are questioning the transfer of the lot to Petra without a Deed of Sale. These allegations are tantamount to item No. 11 of Section 28 of DAO 2016-31 wherein the "patent was procured through fraud and/or misrepresentation". Thus, an Office-Initiated

Investigation under Section 27 is inapplicable, hence, you are required to file a verified Petition under Section 30 with the PENRO having jurisdiction thereof, containing the name of the holder of the title, his/her address, the material allegations, the law and the grounds/basis/es relied of the petition, and the documentary and other forms of evidence to support the allegations, and supported by the following documents:

- Certificate to file action from the barangay concerned;
- Verification and Certification of Non-Forum Shopping;
- c. Proof of Payment of the Petition fee:
- d. Certified true copy of the title or patent; and
- A recent 2x2 picture of the petitioner and his/her duly authorized representative and the subject lot/s.

The Petition and its supporting documents shall be filed in three (3) copies. The respondent shall also be furnished a copy thereof.





Respectfully forwarded is the attached Memorandum dated April 12, 2023 of a... Engr. Alan L. Valle, OIC, PENR Officer, Oriental Mindoro regarding the above-cited subject.

In the said Memorandum, it was relayed to the PENRO by the CENRO Socorro and CENRO Roxas that the Municipal Assessors of their "municipalities do not accept application for tax declaration issuances without a copy of title or patent, unlike previous years that they issued tax declaration to untitled lands."

Per DAO No. 2021-38, an updated tax declaration is one of the requirements in the processing of agricultural free patent.

If the tax declarations will not be issued over untitled agricultural public lands, it will hamper the accomplishment of agricultural free patents in Oriental Mindoro.

We are also attaching a copy of the letter dated April 12, 2023 of the OIC, PENR Officer, Oriental Mindoro addressed to Mr. Caesar A. Pangilinan, Provincial Assessor, Oriental Mindoro, requesting for the legal basis or guidelines that the Assessors are now implementing regarding this new policy in order for them to refer it for a possible review of the IRR of DAO No. 2021-38.



Forwarded is the Memorandum dated April 1-1, 2023 of the Assistant Secretary for Policy, Planning and Foreign-Assisted and Special Projects and Director, Biodiversity Management Bureau In Concurrent Capacity regarding the draft Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP) for CY 2020-2029 of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA).

The BMB Memorandum provided the following general comments and recommendations for PAMO ENTMRPA to consider in the finalization of the draft PAMP pursuant to relevant provisions and guidelines of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the ENIPAS Act of 2018:

Identification of management zones is a requirement for the development of programs
and standards to achieve goals and objectives of the protected area. Please take note
that identification and designation of SPZ and MUZ is a major component of the
PAMP since all activities that shall be allowed, regulated/controlled, and restricted are
dependent of the appropriate location of SPZ and MUZ of the protected area.

The zoning should be consistent with the data requirements indicated in BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2018-01 and BMB Memorandum dated February 6, 2020 on the "Prescribed Primary and Secondary Thematic Datasets for the Preparation or Updating of Management Zones of Protected Areas" and in consultation with the concerned stakeholders particularly the PAMB members.

- Adoption of the correct color coding of the management zones as prescribed in BMB Memorandum dated February 18, 2020 on "Prescribed Map Template for the Designated Management Zones of the Protected Areas under the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS)."
- Include in the Executive Summary of the PAMP information about the previous management plan and the present status of its implementation, highlighting the similar or different approaches and strategies to be undertaken for the updated management

Respectfully submitted is the apprehension report on illegal logging and case filed for the 1st quarter of CY 2023.

Please be informed that there were a total of forty-three (43) apprehensions in the entire region with most of the reports came from the province of Palawan. The said apprehensions had a total of **7** 1,119,623.90 for the estimated fair market value of the forest products excluding the market value of the apprehended eleven (1) units of chainsaw and four (4) units of conveyance.

Further, only one (1) case filed by CENRO-Roxas, Oriental Mindoro pending at the Provincial Prosecutors Office, Oriental Mindoro.
