Please find the attached copies of the minutes and twelve (12) resolutions approved by the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) of Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS) in an En Banc Meeting held on March 25, 2021 in

Please be informed that the PAMB passed seventeen (17) resolutions however, five (5) proposals on fishery-related projects were deferred in the meantime that the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) of MSPLS is still on-going and the carrying capacity of the marine areas of MSPLS is yet to be determined for the conservation and protection of Malampaya Sound.

Two (2) of the twelve (12) resolutions that were approved were on the proposed research studies regarding the "carrying capacity model for fishcage aquaculture" and "assessment of land use and land cover changes in a PA (MSPLS)." The remaining nine (9) resolutions were on the various proposed LGU projects in the different barangays within MSPLS while one (1) was on the implementation of Rapid Land Tenure Appraisal (RLTA) in the protected area.
