

In connection with the above-cited subject, the undersigned have the honor to render their inspection/investigation report of which the following were ascertained, to wit:

That this report pertains to the PENRO Memorandum dated March 2, 2017 which was received by this Office on March 10, 2017 regarding the request of Huwaran Cuyunon Tribes represented by Dionisio B. Mancera, Jr. et. al. to segregate a portion of their occupied land located at Purok Huwaran, Bgy. Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City from the operation of Proclamation No. 16;

That the undersigned proceeded on the subject area on even date which were assisted by Mr. Dionisio B. Mancera, Jr. and Mr. Joseph A. Batul and the team conducted a Global Positioning System (GPS) Luzon Philippine Datum reading to determine the actual position/boundaries of which the following were generated;

That the said City Government as administrator of Puerto Princesa Government Center and Nature's Park interposes no objection to the claim of Huwaran Cuyonon Tribe as claimant of their occupied area covered by Presidential Proclamation No. 16 per letter dated October 20, 2015 from the City Mayor of Puerto Princesa, Hon. Lucilo R. Bayron, addressed to the Office of the President;

That per certification dated March 15, 2017 issued by City Secretary, Samson A. Negosa, of the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Puerto Princesa, it certifies that Resolution No. 1120-2015 entitled, "A Resolution enjoining all the concerned offices/national agencies of the government to extend the necessary support for the segregation of the portion of land covered by the area being occupied by the Huwaran Cuyonon Tribe at Purok Huwaran, Bgy. Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City from the operation of Presidential Proclamation N. 16 (establishment of Government Center and Natures Park) which was passed by the 14th Sangguniang Panlungsod on June 1, 2015 appears to remain valid and still unamended to date;

That it was observed that the corresponding lot number being claimed/occupied by the Huwaran Cuyonon Tribe was never mentioned nor specified on the aforementioned letter dated October 20, 2015 and certification dated March 15, 2017 issued in favor of the Huwaran Cuyonon Tribe;

That as per advanced technical description and/or proposed site of Purok Huwaran as prepared by Engr. Aries S. Grande, it shows that the occupation of Huwaran Cuyunon Tribes only pertains to Lot No. 2685, Cad-800-D;

That the said National Reservation covering Lot No. 2685, Cad-800-D was already superseded and now covered by Proclamation No. 16 which was issued by then President Joseph Ejercito Estrada on September 11, 1998 entitled as "Reserving and Declaring as Puerto Princesa City Government Center and Nature Park a certain portion of the land of the public domain situated in Barangays Sta. Monica and Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City". It covers parcel of land (as shown on plan Swo-04-003556 being a portion of the consolidation of Lots 4201, 4202, 4103, 3838, 4198, 3828, 4198, 3828, 4153, 4075, 4196, 2685, 4151, and 4197 (Portion), Cad-800-D, Puerto Princesa Cadastre, situated in Barangays of Sta. Monica and Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City;

That it was observed that Lot No. 2684, Cad-800-D was not listed/included under the consolidated lots of approved Plan Swo-04-003556 upon review of the lot description of the said Proclamation;

That on July 30, 2001, Republic Act No. 9145 was signed by then President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, entitled, "An act to reclassify a portion of the land under Cadastral Survey 800-D, Module 2, Project No. 1-LC Map 203 in Barangay Santa Monica, Puerto Princesa City, Province of Palawan as Agricultural Land Open to Disposition", except, however, that portion covered by Presidential Proclamation No. 16, dated September 11, 1998, hence Proclamation No. 16 is still classified to be within Timberland Area;

That it was observed that there is a creek and/or flow of water in some portions of the subject area, hence, under Article 51 of Presidential Decree No. 1667 otherwise known as the "Water Code of the Philippines" dated December 31, 1976, the banks of rivers and streams and the shores of the seas and lakes throughout their entire length and within a zone of three (3) meters in urban areas, twenty (20) meters in agricultural areas and forty (40) meters in forest areas, along their margins are subject to the easement of public use in the interest of recreation, navigation, floatage, fishing and salvage;

That a portion of the boundary of the subject area adjacent to the property of Palawan State University was observed to be partially covered by mangroves, hence, portion of the subject area is covered by Proclamation No. 2152 dated December 29, 1981, "declaring the entire Province of Palawan and certain parcel of public domain and/or part of the country as MANGROVE SWAMP FOREST RESERVES";

That under DENR Administrative Order No. 76 dated November 23, 1987, a strip of fifty (50) meters buffer zone in mangrove or swampland areas throughout the country fronting seas, oceans and other bodies of water and twenty (20) meters on both sides of river channels/banks maintained and developed to 2.16

and/or clarification to the PENR Office whether Lot No. 2684, Cad-800-D is actually covered by Proclamation No. 16 as described in its technical description considering that its lot description tells otherwise. Furthermore, is it requested to seek clarification at the Regional Office, Legal Services Division regarding the applicable salvage zone/buffer zone adjacent over the mangrove areas in accordance to existing environmental laws, rules and regulations. Finally, it is recommended that an actual survey on the ground be conducted in order to determine the extent of boundaries and/or actual occupation of Huwaran Cuyonon Tribes and thereafter, subject for further evaluation.







PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT PLAN









WHEREAS, presented to this August Body is a letter dated April 15, 2015 from Honorable City Mayor Lucilo R. Bayron, addressed to Hon. Luis M. Marcaida III, City Vice Mayor and to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, thru Mr. Samson A. Negosa, City Secretary, this City, indorsing the request of Huwaran Cuyonon Tribe for a Certification of No Objection on the part of the City Government on segregating a portion of land at the Government Center and Nature's Park for residential purposes of tribal members;

WHEREAS, the members of Huwaran Cuyunon Tribes are bonafide residents of Purok Huwaran, Barangay Tiniguiban, this City and some proofs showed that they have been in possession of the more or less 2 hectares of land in the subject area since 1980;

WHEREAS, however, on September 11, 1998, Presidential Proclamation No. 16 was duly approved by then President of the Republic of the Philippines Joseph Ejercito Estrada. The said Presidential Proclamation reserved and declared the vast portion of

land in Barangays Sta. Monica and Tiniguiban into Puerto Princesa City Government Center and Natures Park, including the area wherein the above subject land is located;

whereas, the City Government, being the administrator of subject estate, is mandated by law to ensure that all national government entities shall have its designated lot at the Government Center and Nature's Park. Therefore, the City Government is precluded to commit any other act that will run counter to the mandates of P.P. No. 16;

WHEREAS, during the meeting of the Committee on Landed Estate and Urban Development on May 27, 2015, the representatives from the City Housing and the City Planning and Development Coordinator Offices interposed no objection and favorably attested to the fact that the tribal members are the actual claimants and occupants of the subject parcels of land;

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.

DECLARING OPEN TO DISPOSITION FOR SOCIALIZED HOUSING PURPOSES CERTAIN GOVERNMENT-OWNED LANDS DEFINED UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7279, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING ACT OF 1992, AND PROVIDING FOR DISPOSITION THEREOF

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 7279, otherwise known as the Urban Development Housing Act of 1992 (UDHA), government-owned lands which have not been used for the purposes for which they have been reserved or set uside for the past ten (10) years from the effectivity of UDHA including government-owned idle lands and alienable lands of the public domain - and are suitable for socialized housing - shall be subject to disposition in favor of UDHA beneficiaries or for socialized housing purposes;

WHEREAS, mass housing has been reaffirmed by this government as a centerpiece program in its poverty alleviation efforts pursuant to Executive Order No. 20 dated 28 May 2001;

WHEREAS, mass housing may be effected, among others, through the regularization of land tenure of informal settlers on governmentowned lands which have not been used for the purposes for which they have been reserved or set aside for the past ten (10) years from the effectivity of UDHA including government-owned idle lands and alienable lands of the public domain and are suitable for socialized housing; and

WHEREAS, through numerous laws and executive issuances, the Housing and Urban Development Coordinating Council (HUDCC), has been identified as the sole lead agency in the implementation of the government's shelter/housing program.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, President of the Philippines do hereby declare and order:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Certain Government-Owned Lands under UDHA as Available for Disposition to Qualified UDHA Beneficiaries or for Socialized Housing Purposes. Lands owned by the Government or any of its subdivisions, instrumentalities, agencies or government-owned

or controlled corporations such as but not limited to military reservations, lands reserved for government offices, facilities and other installations, and other land assets which have not been used for the purposes for which they have been reserved or set aside for the past ten (10) years from the effectivity of UDHA as well as government-owned idle lands and alienable lands of the public domain which are suitable for socialized housing are hereby declared open to disposition to qualified UDHA beneficiaries or for socialized housing purposes: *Provided*, that other lands defined under Section 5 of the UDHA whose use or purpose has ceased to exist and identified as suitable for socialized housing shall be subject to this provision.

SEC 2. Designation of the National Housing Authority (NHA) as Lead Agency in the Disposition Program. The NHA, under the supervision of HUDCC, shall take the lead in the disposition of the lands in the preceding section: Provided, that disposition activities shall include the preliminary stages of identification and evaluation of lands suitable for disposition under this Order.

The HUDCC is hereby directed to submit immediately an updated list of government-owned lands suitable for socialized housing purposes.

The HUDCC shall make recommendation for the President relative to the disposition of the lands subject hereof.

All government agencies, instrumentalities, subdivisions or government-owned or controlled corporations which HUDCC may call upon to participate in the disposition program pursuant to the provisions of this Order are hereby directed to give full cooperation and support to HUDCC.

- SEC 3. Regular Reporting to the Executive Secretary. The HUDCC shall make regular reports to the Executive Secretary for purposes of monitoring the status of implementation of the provisions of this Order.
- SEC 4. Funding for the Implementation of the Provisions of this Order. The initial funding requirements for the implementation of this Order shall be sourced from HUDCC and the subsequent funding requirements shall be incorporated into its budget.
- SEC 5. <u>Amendatory Clause</u>. All previous issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order shall be deemed revoked or amended accordingly.

WHEREAS, towards this end, Section 2 (b) of said Act further provides, that: "The State shall protect the rights of ICCs/IPs to their ancestral domains to ensure their economic, social and cultural well-being and shall recognize the applicability of customary laws governing property rights or relations in determining the ownership and extent of ancestral domain";

WHEREAS, presented to this Honorable Body is endorsement letter dated February 8, 2021, from Mr. Dionisio B. Mancera Jr. IPMR-Tiniguiban, President, Huwaran-Cuyunon Tribes, requesting for the intervention of the Sangguniang Panlungsod regarding their request for the segregation of the portion of land being occupied by the Huwaran Cuyunon Tribe at Purok Huwaran, Bgy. Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City, from the area covered by Proclamation No. 16-1998 otherwise known as "Reserving and Declaring as Puerto Princesa City Government Center and Nature Park a Certain portion of the land of the public domain situated in Barangays Sta. Monica, and Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City";

PROCLAMATION NO. 16, SERIES OF 1998

This is in response to the Memorandum dated March 19, 2018 of the CENRO Puerto Princesa City seeking legal opinion on the above-captioned subject matter.

Mr. Dionisio B. Mancera of the Huwaran Cuyunon Tribe of Brgy. Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City is requesting for a survey authority to segregate the area they are occupying in Barangay Tiniguiban, and for the same to be awarded to them.

Based on the Completed Staff Work (CSW) dated August 15, 2017 submitted by the CENRO Puerto Princesa City, the subject area occupied by the Huwaran Cuyonon tribe is located within a reservation pursuant to Proclamation No. 16, Series of 1998.

Proclamation No. 16, Series of 1998, is an issuance Reserving and Declaring as Puerto Princesa City Government Center and Nature Park a Certain Portion of the Land of the Public School of Studies in Barangays Sta. Monica, and Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City. Said Domain Situated in Barangays Sta. Monica, and Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City. Princesa City Government Center and Nature Park a Certain Portion of the Land of the Public reservation is under the jurisdiction and arministration of the City Government of Puerto Princesa, subject to private rights, if any there be.

The Proclamation expressly provides that:

The City Government shall relocate the occupants of the area that would be affected/displaced in the implementation of the proclamation and shall provide the resettlement site, including disturbance compensation and other relocation expenses as provided under existing laws, rules and regulations. (Emphasis ours)

Per the above CSW, the area is classified as forest/timber land under Land Classification (LC) Map No. 203, Project No. 1, certified on December 29, 1923, hence, no

private rights could have possibly vested, it being part of an inalianable land of the public domain. Further, the area has also been expressly exempted from the coverage of Republic Act No. 9145, approved on July 30, 2001, which reclassified a portion of the land under Cadastral Survey 800-D, Module 2, Project No. 1-LC Map 203 in Barangay Sta. Monica, Puerto Princesa City as agricultural land open to disposition.

Thus, it is very clear that the land in question is solely reserved for purposes of building a government conter and a nature park, it cannot be used for any other purpose except as indicated in the proclamation and neither can it be distributed for private ownership. As the reservation is under the jurisdiction of Puerto Princesa City, our Office does not have the authority to grant the request of Mr. Dionisio B. Mancera to segregate and award to them the portion that they are actually occupying within the reservation.
