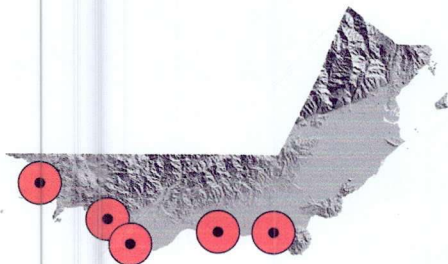
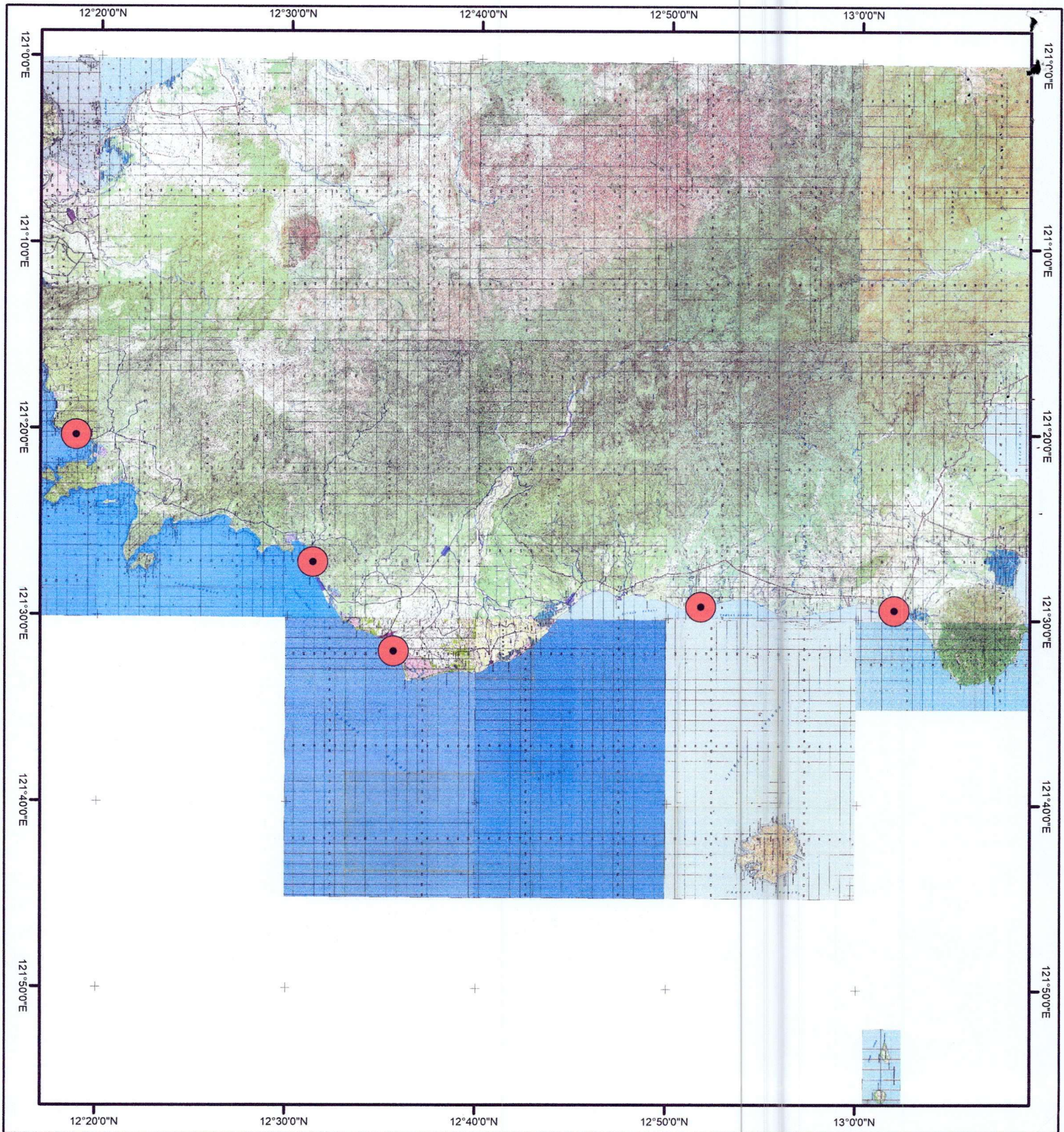
During the two (2) months inspection in the port, all teams did not see any illegal/smuggled forest products and wildlife.

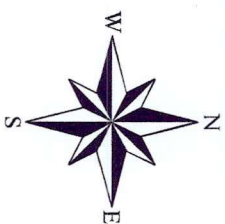

That, on February 14, 2023, the team conducted monitoring in Puerto Galera Seaports located in Barangays of Balatero and Muelle, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro. During the monitoring we coordinated with OIC, Ma. Elena A. Gozar of Port of Puerto Galera and CG PO2, William Notario of Coast Guard Puerto Galera, accordingly there is no incident of transport/arrival of wildlife in the said ports on month of January, 2023 to February, 2023. Also there is no incident of transport/arrival of Wildlife during that day.

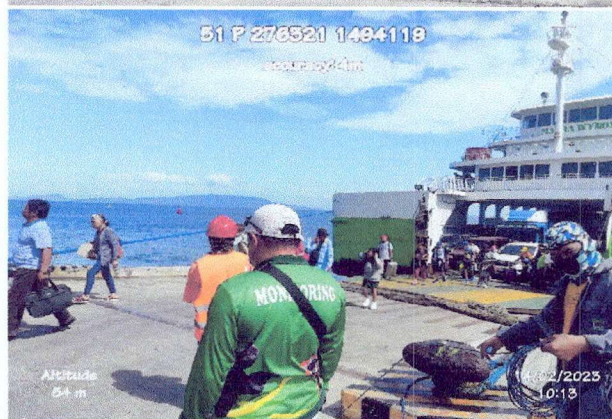

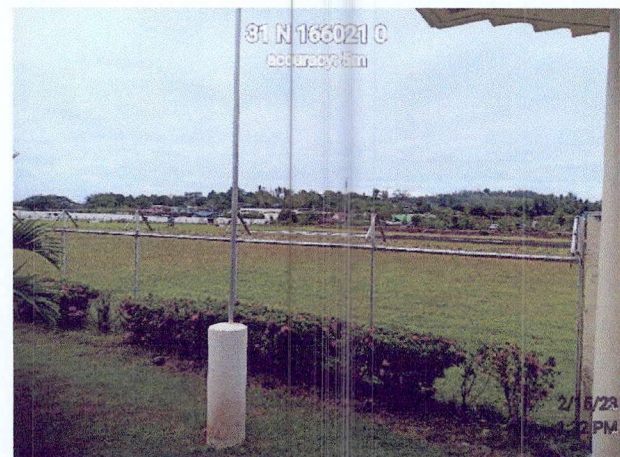
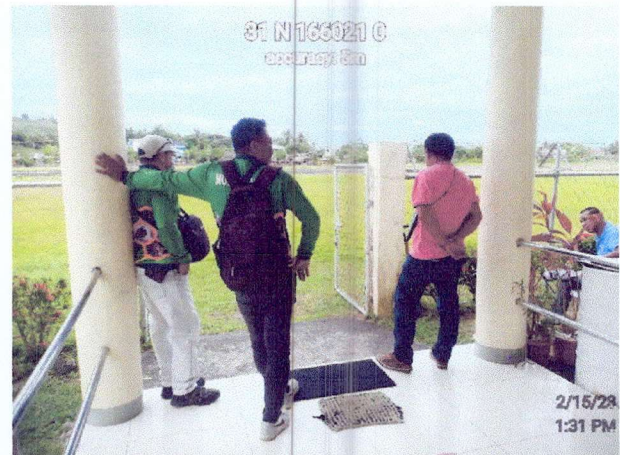
