Forwarded is the Memorandum from the CENR Officer of Socorro, Oriental Mindoro regarding the above captioned subject.

The seven (7) municipalities and one (1) city covered by CENRO Socorro had already their FLUPs approved and adopted as early as 2015 and the latest is in 2021. With regards to implementation, most LGUs shared the same sentiment that the bulk of their funds were allotted in the COVID 19 responses that caused delays in the implementation of their FLUPs. Thus, they requested for amendments and/or updating of FLUPs once the service operations and funding normalizes.

Claudio, directing all the PENROs and CENROs to coordinate with our respective MENROs to amend the Forest Land Use Plans (FLUPs) and the signed MOAs to include specific areas identified for production and protection forests.

Relative thereto, please be informed of the following data:

CENRO Socorro covers 7 municipalities and 1 city, all of which have already had their FLUPs approved and adopted as indicated in the table below.
