CELEBRATION OF WORLD WETLANDS DAY 2023 IN

NAUJAN LAKE NATIONAL PARK (NLNP)

Submitted is the accomplishment report of the activities during the 2023 Wetlands Day Celebration in Naujan Lake National Park on February 2, 2023.

A total of 44 participants from the DENR Oriental Mindoro (PENRO Oriental Mindoro and CENRO Socorro), Barangay Pasi II, LGU and volunteers were present in the activity. A 500-meter lakeshore clean-up activity was conducted and collected approximately 40 kilograms of garbage that further turned over to the Barangay LGU for proper disposal.

Further, the Bird Count Team recorded 1,970 birds comprising of 1,826 waterbirds and 144 non-waterbirds. The Bird Count is a continuation of the Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) conducted last January 12-13, 2023. The AWC was halted on the scheduled dates due to adversed weather condition.

Respectfully submitting the accomplishment report on the conducted clean-up and bird-counting activities as part of 2023 Wetlands Day celebration in Naujan Lake National Park on February 2, 2023. The participants during the activities are personnel from the PENRO Oriental Mindoro and CENRO Socorro together with officials and residents of Barangays Pasi I and Pasi II, Socorro.

A total of 12 sacks of garbage weighing approximately 40 kilograms were collected in the 500-meter lakeshore of NLNP. These were turned-over to the LGU of Barangay Pasi II for proper management and disposition. Further, a total of 1,970 birds (1,826 waterbirds and 144 non-waterbirds) were recorded by the Bird Count Team. This is higher than the 575 birds (547 waterbird and 28 non-waterbirds) counted during the Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) conducted on January 12-13, 2023. The bird count on February 02 is a resumption of AWC last January as the latter is ceased because of adverse weather condition.

The event is attended by 44 participants (29 male and 15 female) coming from DENR Oriental Mindoro (PENRO Oriental Mindoro and CENRO Socorro), Barangay Local Government Unit (LGU) and volunteers.



Respectfully submitting the accomplishment report on the conducted clean-up and bird-counting activities as part of 2023 Wetlands Day celebration in Naujan Lake National Park on February 2, 2023.

The event started at 07:00 am with a prayer. The program was facilitated by NLNP-Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) personnel. After the preliminaries, the CENR Officer Rodel M. Boyles delivered welcoming remarks and expressed his heartfelt gratitude for the support of participants. After which, he provided the briefer of the environmental event celebrated and its importance. The participants during the activities are personnel from the PENRO Oriental Mindoro and CENRO Socorro together with officials and residents of Barangays Pasi I and Pasi II, Socorro (see Figure 1).

The World Wetlands Day is celebrated annually on February 02 around the world. The Presidential Proclamation No. 74 Series of 1999 also declared the same date as the National Wetlands Day in due recognition to the vital role of the wetlands to Filipinos and protection of global biodiversity. With this year's theme, "It's Time for Wetlands Restoration," the event aims to focus and prioritize the rehabilitation and restoration of our wetlands.

Wetlands are habitats that are continually or occasionally inundated or flooded with water, either flowing or still, whether they were created naturally or artificially. It can be man-made (rice paddies, lagoons), coastal and marine, and inland (marshes, peatlands, lakes, rivers) (mangroves, intertidal mudflats, sea grass beds, coral reef). Since it contains the majority of the aforementioned wetlands, the NLNP is one of them. The ecological services that our wetlands supplied, including the provision of food, water, protection from natural calamities/disasters, and habitat for wildlife, were underlined by CENRO Boyles throughout his speech (see Figure 2). Dependents receive the same services that the NLNP does. The aforementioned ecological functions will be threatened if balance is lost.

He also stressed that an approach to continually conserve, manage, and protect wetlands and NLNP is through stakeholders' participation in the DENR's World Wetlands Day clean-up and bird count activity. With the efforts of all sectors, the benefits that result from it may be preserved and guaranteed.

Following the awareness campaign on the preservation, protection, and significance of wetlands, the participants went on to clean up of the lakeshore of Barangay Pasi I and II, Socorro, Oriental Mindoro (see Figure 3). The data of trash collected were recorded using Ocean Conservancy's Ocean Trash Data Form (2022/latest edition).




Figure 4. Bird count in NLNP.

Meanwhile, three (3) teams from PENRO Oriental Mindoro and CENRO Socorro departed to conduct bird count (see Figure 4) during the clean-up. This is to monitor the population of birds (waterbird and other avians) found in NLNP and identify threats present, if any.
