SUBJECT : CREATION OF PENRO/CENRO ASSESSMENT VALIDATION TEAM (AVT) OF GRADUATED NGP SITES QUALIFY FOR ENHANCEMENT PLANTING WITHIN THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO.

The Team shall assess and validate the graduated NGP sites qualify for Enhancement and submit report to the RED for review and approval.



The Assessment and Validation Report (AVR) shall include the following:

- A. The NGP sites, which are within production, protection forest and were damaged by force majeure with survival rates of 30% to 50% either based on the result of the third party validation.
- B. Seedling available are suited and the nearest boundary of which not more than 700 meters away from the access road.
- C. Updated shape files, geotagged photos, and drone video shots.
- D. Enhancement Planting (EP) area planted with a scale of 1:5000. Subdivide the planting area into small planting blocks of not more than 3 hectare size. Reflect the 5 meters interval contour lines, forest road, and river/stream in the Planting Area Plan.

All expenses to be incurred in the conduct of the assessment and validation of graduated NGP sites qualified for Enhancement damaged by force majeure is chargeable against NGP Project Monitoring and Supervision (PMS) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

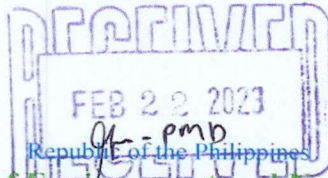
This order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force unless revoke by the approving authority.


