

2. Probationer/s shall, thereafter, report to the Chief Probation and Parole Officer at Occidental Mindoro Parole and Probation Office and to his/her/their Supervising Probation and Parole Officer least once a month unless otherwise modified by the Chief Probation and Parole Officer;
3. Probationer/s shall reside in Sitio Cambiswer, Barangay Poblacion, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro and shall not change his/her/their residence without prior approval of the Chief Probation and Parole Officer or the Court, as the case may be;
4. Probationer/s shall secure a written permit from the Chief Probation and Parole Officer or the Court if such travel outside the Province of Occidental Mindoro or outside the jurisdiction of the Parole and Probation Office shall exceed thirty (30) days;
5. Probationer/s shall not commit any other offense;
6. Probationer/s shall render community service and participate in tree planting activities, where probationer at the very least be able to plant twenty (20) fruit bearing or shaded trees in consonance with the reforestation program of the government, coastal clean-up project and other environmental protection program or similar activities during the period of his/her/their probation in coordination with the DENR of the Province of Occidental Mindoro;
7. Probationer/s shall allow the Supervising Probation and Parole Officer or authorized volunteer probation aide to visit him/her/them at home and place of work;

8. Probationer/s shall endeavor to be gainfully employed at all times and keep his/her/their Supervising Probation Officer informed of such employment. He/She/They shall devote himself to a specific employment and shall not change said employment without prior notice to the supervising officer and/or pursue a prescribed secular study or vocational training;
9. Probationer/s, shall refrain from associating with persons of questionable character;
10. Probationer/s shall meet his/her/their family and community responsibilities;
11. Probationer/s shall undergo medical, psychological or psychiatric examination and treatment and enter and remain in specified institution, when required for that purpose;
12. Probationer/s shall cooperate with his/her/their program of supervision and shall satisfy any other conditions related to his/her rehabilitation and not unduly restrictive of his/her/their liberty or incompatible with his/her freedom of conscience.

In the event that the probationer/ **RUSSEL VIAÑA y TRAMBULO** fail/s to comply or observe the preceding terms and conditions and/or committed any material misrepresentation on his/her/their Application for Probation, the Probation granted to him/her/they may be revoked or the conditions thereof will be modified by the Court.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the **CASH BOND** posted by **MARIA CORAZON ATENDER VALERIO**, for the temporary liberty of **RUSSEL VIAÑA y TRAMBULO**, in the amount of **TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP20,000.00)** Philippines Currency, under Official Receipt No. 5389578 dated October 25, 2021 is relieve from further liability and the same may be released to the bondsman named herein upon compliance with the following procedures:

- a.) Surrender to the Court the original copy of the Official Receipt/s corresponding or covering the cash bond/s;
- b.) Signing of the acknowledgment receipts, disbursement vouchers and other accountable documents in connection with the bail being withdrawn by the bondsman and
- c.) Presentation by bondsman of two (2) valid identifications and submission of the photocopy of the same to the court through the Officer-in-Charge/Clerk of Court, Office of the Clerk of Court, RTC-San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.

Let copy of this order be furnished to the Office of the Parole and Probation Office, 2/F Three Kids Building, Rizal St. Barangay Poblacion 6, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, the probationer, his counsel, the Office of the Clerk of Court San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, the Office of the Provincial Prosecutor, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, and the National Bureau of Investigation.
