

As per compliance to the 1st quarter target of identification fire prone area, this office identified, mapping and monitor of fire prone area.


Under this activity, this office conducted fire prone area assessment at Barangay Sagpangan, Aborlan, Palawan within the Enhanced National Greening Program (eNGP) established CY 2017 together with Forest Protection Officers and assisted by the Chairman of Sagpangan Tribal Multi-Purpose Cooperative (STMPC) and barangay representative. The majority on site vegetation of the area were identified as secondary growth forest and a portion of grassland dominated by "buho and Cogon", which are located at elevated part of the identified fire prone area. Further, several kaingin making activity of the residents nearby the area were observed. This equivalent to 100% accomplishment in the target.
