February 14-16,	15.80 km.	Successfully imported to SMART connect from cyber tracker installed to mobile device but failed to sync, this data has corresponding report submitted on this office.
February 22-23, 2023	12 km. (estimated distance patrolled)	Data was not imported to SMART connect from cyber tracker installed to mobile device due to experiencing a technical problem such as unable to Log-in with our LAWIN-SMART connect account.
