

- e. Conduct COT extraction and coastal clean-ups within ENTMRPA;
- f. Prepare monthly accomplishment report/progress report on CMEMP implementation; BMS Activities; monitoring of marine ecosystem such as mangrove, coral, sea grass and fish resources; regular habitat surveys/monitoring; COT extraction and coastal Clean-ups Activities within ENTMRPA;

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- Assist in the data gathering for the inventory of coastal habitats for potential livelihood opportunities including vulnerability and pressure and driver within ENTMRPA;
- h. Assist in implementation of maintenance and protection of coastal and marine ecosystems within PA;
- Assist in field monitoring activities and mapping of selected areas of ENTMRPA;
- j. Assist in the regular monitoring of MPA in relation to MPA maintenance and protection within ENTMRPA;
- k. Assist in the monitoring of water quality and violations of relevant environmental laws within ENTMRPA;
- Assist in Green Fins implementation;
- m. Assist in the conduct of Community, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) and advocacy campaigns;
- n. Perform other related functions as instructed or assigned by PASu or CENRO concerned.

Section 3. For services rendered under this Contract, the Second Party shall receive a monthly compensation of Twenty-seven Thousand Pesos (P27,000.00), inclusive of tax, to be paid on monthly basis, chargeable against SCALING UP OF COASTAL AND MARINE MANAGEMENT-PROGRAM SUPPORT AND MANAGEMENT, HIRING OF CMEMP EXTENSION OFFICER FOR ENTMRPA fund of DENR-CENRO TAYTAY, PALAWAN.

In case of absence/s of the Second Party, the basis of deduction from the salary shall be the daily rate.

Subject to the availability of funds, the salary of Second Party shall be paid within the first week of the succeeding month provided that all documentary requirements were submitted on time.

Monthly premiums such as Philhealth and PAG-IBIG shall be voluntarily remitted by the Second Party.

Section 4. The Second Party shall perform the tasks herein specified with supervision by a regular employee of this Office. She will be subjected for the submission of the Performance Evaluation Sheet on or before July 15, 2023.

For the purpose of payment for services rendered, the Second Party shall submit the following to the Administrative Division:

- a. Detailed Accomplishment Report;
- b. Certified true copy of contract;
- c. Proof of Daily Record of Attendance; and
- d. Proof of Payment for PAG-IBIG and PHILHEALTH contribution

Section 5. If travel is necessary and recommended by her immediate supervisor, the Second Party shall be entitled to actual transportation expenses only, chargeable to the AVAILABILITY OF ENTMRPA fund of DENR-CENRO TAYTAY, PALAWAN, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

Section 6. This Contract may be terminated by either party for any reason as may be deemed appropriate before the expiration of the period indicated in Section 1 hereof, giving the other party prior written notice not less than fifteen (15) days before the intended date of termination.
