Samariniana, Brooke's Point. Nasaad din sa liham na ang JCBB Construction ay nagsasagawa ng quarry sa Tamlang Dam na nasa itaas ng inyong lupa. Kaugnay nito, nagsagawa ng imbestigasyon ang ating tanggapan at nakadetalye sa ibaba ang naging resulta ng imbestigasyon.

1. Ang nabanggit na pinsalang naidulot sa inyong lupa ay hindi nakita ng aming grupo sapagkat walang nakapagturo ng tamang lokasyon at iba pang detalye hinggil sa destruksyon. Gayon pa man, parte ng natural na pangyayari sa ilog ang pagbago nito ng daluyan at paglaglag ng lupa sa tabing-ilog at batay sa Seksyon 57 ng Presidential Decree No. 1067.

"When a river or stream suddenly changes its course to traverse private lands, the owners of the affected lands may not compel the government to restore the river to its former bed xxx. However, the former owners of the new bed shall be the owners of the abandoned bed in proportion to the area lost by each."

- 2. Isang Cease and Desist Order o CDO ang naihain na ng Mines and Geosciences Bureau MIMAROPA Region noong ika-27 ng Octobre 2022 sa JCBB Construction. Ang nasabing dokumento ay nag-uutos na ihinto ang illegal na gawain hanggang wala pang nakukuhang permit o clearance mula sa mga kinauukulang ahensya/kagawaran ng gobyerno. Ang paglabag sa kautusang ito ay maaring magresulta sa pagsasampa ng kaso
- 3. Ang ulat ng imbestigasyong aming isinagwa ay inendorso sa Provincial Mining Regulatory Board Palawan (PMRB Palawan) at MGB MIMAROPA para sa kanilang karagdagang legal na aksyon

Nawa ay aming nabigyan ng karampatang pansin ang inyong hinaing. Kung kayo ay may karagdagang katanungan, kayo po ay aming hinihikayat na sumangguni sa aming opisina.

Last January 24, 2023 the undersigned, personnel of the MGB MIMAROPA and the CENRO Brooke's Point conducted a field investigation to address the abovementioned subject pursuant to TO No. 2023-1-24-106.

#### **Background Information**

A complaint letter by a certain Mrs. Febe Tamaño, was received by this office – last January 9, 2023 – detailing their concern regarding the effect on an alleged quarry activity of the JCBB Construction in the Tamlang Dam. This was claimed to have resulted to the shifting of the river channel and damaging their land under lot no. 3129 (*Annex A*).

# Facts and observations:




Figure 1. Location map of the investigated report of illegal quarry activity in Sitio Tamlang, Barangay Samariniana, Brooke's Point, Palawan

- 1. The subject area is an irrigation dam in Sitio Tamlang, Brgy Samariniana, Brooke's Point, Palawan geographically located at 8°45'1.81"N, 117°43'44.87"E (*Figure 1*). It is ~18.5 kilometers away from CENRO Brooke's Point, and is accessible enough to be reached within ~30 minutes of vehicle travel.
- 2. The company conducting the quarry activities in the complaint letter JCBB Contruction has already been issued with a **Cease and Desist Order** by the MGB MIMAROPA for the extraction of sand and gravel materials without permits in Brgy. Samariniana last October 27, 2022 (*Annex B*).

- 3. A courtesy call was conducted in the Brgy. Samariniana to inform them regarding the purpose of the investigation as well as to request a barangay personnel who can accompany the team. Mr. Pavico, a Barangay Tanod, and Mr. Montimer, a PMRB personnel accompanied the team during the investigation. A barangay kagawad interviewed during the visit also mentioned that there has been no recent quarry activity within the dam.
- 4. The team then proceeded to the residence or Mr. and Mrs. Tamaño to hear their statements and to request someone who can point out the location of the reported damages. The complainants repeated their concerns in the letter. They also mentioned that the JCBB Construction is still conducting limited quarry activities during the weekends and holidays.
- 5. Upon requesting Mr. Tamaño to guide the team to point out and detail upon the reported location and damages to his land as a result of the quarry activity, he firmly refused and stated that his son should be in the area who can instead help the team. The team then proceeded to the irrigation dam, but no sand and gravel quarrying activities and equipment was observed in the dam and in the river below it. The accompanying Tanod and PMRB personnel also mentioned that the level of aggregates have been reduced since their respective recent visits in the dam sometime in December 2022.
- 6. The team was not able to verify the reported damages to their land as claimed by the complainant as the aforementioned son of Mr. Tamaño was not met by the investigating team.

## Findings and Recommendations:

- 1. Although there was no observed activity in the dam, the lowering of the levels of the aggregate deposit in the dam suggest that limited activity still persists in the area.
- 2. The barangay is advised to continuously monitor the sand and gravel activities in the area in accordance to the powers, duties, and functions of the chief executive of the barangay as stipulated in Item B.9, Section 389 of the Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991:

"Enforce laws and regulations relating to pollution control and protection of the environment;"

- 3. To the JCBB Construction, the company should strictly adhere to the issued Cease and Desist Order and should not conduct any quarrying activities without the pertinent quarry permits.
- 4. To the complainant, the connection between the reported quarry activity and the lateral erosion/movement of river channel that damaged the land was not established during the investigation due to the lack of detail description and information. However, should their claim be true, their possible actions should be in accordance to Article 58 of the Presidential Decree No. 1067 or The Water Code of the Philippines:

"When a river or stream suddenly changes its course to traverse private lands, the owners of the affected lands may not compel the government to restore the river to its former bed; nor can they restrain the government from taking steps to revert the river or stream to its former course. The owners of the land thus affected are not entitled to compensation for any damage sustained thereby. However, the former owners of the new bed shall be the owners of the abandoned bed in proportion to the area lost by each.

The owners of the affected lands may undertake to return the river or stream to its old bed at their own expense; Provided, that a permit therefor is secured from the Secretary of Public Works, Transportation and Communication and work pertaining thereto are commenced within two years from the change in the course of the river or stream."

#### Dear Mrs. D. Bautista:

Please be informed that CENRO – Brooke's Point confirmed that you have been conducting sand and gravel operation Barangay Samariniana, Brooke's Point, Palawan without a valid mining permit.

The above-cited extraction and disposition of sand and gravel materials without a mining permit is equivalent to theft of minerals pursuant to Section 103 of Republic Act (RA) No. 79421, which provides that:

"Theff of Minerals – Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement lease, permit, license, or steals mineral or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants..xxx"

Hence, you are hereby ordered to immediately **CEASE AND DESIST** from conducting sand and gravel activities without a valid mining permit. This is without prejudice to the filing of appropriate charges against you with the proper court for violation of the applicable provisions of RA No. 7942.

Please be guided accordingly. Thank you.
