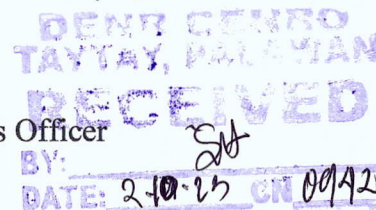

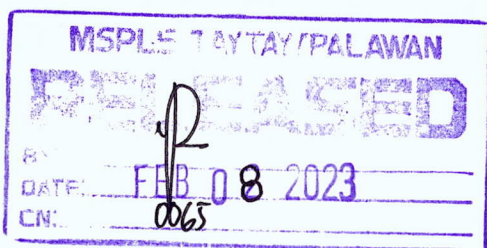

165 Protected Area na ang klasipikasyon ng lupa na kinatatayuan ng mga establishment ay Timberland.

166 Minarapat po na magpasa ng isang resolution na kailangan na ang lahat ng establishment ay mag-

167 apply ng Special Agreement within Protected Area (SAPA) kagaya ng mga resorts, lodging house,

168 restaurant at iba pang mga establishment na nasa loob ng protected area.

170 Pahayag ni Municipal Administrator Robinson Morales na ang mga commercial establishment

171 na stated sa title ay dapat linawin. May definition/kategorya kung ano ang mga commercial

172 establishment kapag sinabi commercial establishment ang purpose ay pagkakitaan dahil mula sa sari-

173 sari store, ay consider commercial establishment. Mungkahi na alamin muna at magkaroon ng

174 kategorya at identified kung saan-saan barangay ang mayroon mga commercial establishment na nasa

175 loob ng timberland.

177 Ayon naman sa Tagapaguna kinakailangan pag-usapan at pag-aralan mabuti kasama ang LGU

181 Dagdag katanungan ni PO representative Villarma ang mga CSC na nasa loob ng protected area

182 karamihan ay expired at sinasabi na hindi na ito marerenew. Paano kung sila ay mag-apply ng SAPA

183 hindi nila ito kaya.

Paliwanag ni CENRO Alan L. Valle kung edefined natin ang commercial establishment ito ay any business na mayroon o kumukuha ng ng business permit samantala ang commercial establishment ito ay may definition sa RA 11038 ng ENIPAS. Subalit sa malalaking negosyo kailangan silang mag-apply ng SAPA lalung-lalo na sa parte ng Barangay Liminangcong ang daming negosyo at malalaki commercial establishment. Kaya kung edefine ang commercial establishment ang RA 11038 ang gagawin reference. Lahat ng establishment na binibigyan ng munisipyo ng business permit ay commercial. At sinasabi naman ni PO representative Dela Cruz na mag identify tayo ng amount, ay ang PAMB ay maaring gumawa ng mga policy tungkol sa mga commercial establishment, kailangan lang ayusin ang Resolution dahil general kasi ang sinasabi ay commercial establishment within PA ay mag-apply ng SAPA. Mungkahi na dapat gumawa ang PAMB ng another resolution na e identify kung ano ang talaga ang limit dahil meron naman karenderya lang baka kulang pa ang puhunan niya pangbayad ng rental. Ang pagbabayad ng rental ng SAPA ay nakabase sa zonal value ng lugar.

Ang concern naman ni PO rep. Villarma ay ang mga CSC na nasa loob ng protected area na nag expire at ang sabi ay hindi na pwedeng erenew. Kung ang mga CSC ay na award bago ang proclamation ng MSPLS ay maaari naman mag-apply ng Protected Area Community Based Resource Management Agreement (PACBRMA) madali na lang po dahil mayroon na kayo CBFMA hintayin na lamang po na matapos ang agreement at gagawin ng PACBRMA dahil nasa loob ng PA.

Tagapanguna, malinaw po ang sinabi ni CENRO Alan , sa ngayon po deferred muna natin ang usapin at hintayin natin ang gagawin ng Secretariat dahil general ang nasabing resolution.

Sinusugan ni PO representative Villarma ang naunang mungkahi na pending muna ang nasabing Resolution at ang Secretariat ang mag-ayos para minor na lang ang pag-usapan sa susunod na meeting.

At pinangalawahan ni PO representative Dela Cruz ang mungkahi ni Municipal Administrator Morales na pansamanatala ay defer muna at pag-usapan dagdag pa na maglagay seguro ng amount ng puhunan at iba pa information na dapat isama para matawag na commercial establishment dahil kahit sari-sari store commercial pa din ang kategorya. Halimbawa ang puhunan ay P100k, samantala bago makakuha ng SAPA ang gagastusin ay more than P100k parang hindi na kukuha ang maliliit ang ang puhunan kundi iyong malalaki na lang ang puhunan.

2. Resolution No. 09, "Resolution enjoining the active participation of concern BLGU's in the conduct of monitoring of corals, seagrass and mangroves within MSPLS."

Ipinahayag ni PASu Pador ang nilalaman ng nasabing resolusyon, binanggit nya na ang Barangay Alacalian ang may pinakamalapad na mangrove areas, at ngayon taon ay may target ang Protected Area Management Office ng assessment ng mangroves, seagrass at corals, isa po sa mga ginagawa ay upang makita at malaman kung may pinsala ang mangrove areas, may mga cuttings ba na nangyayari, pag-uuling at may mga tambak ba ng basura. Sa mga corals naman ay kung affected ng cyanide, may dynamite fishing, presence ng crown of thorns; at kasama rin po ang seagrass, napakalaki po ng kanilang ambag sa ating ecosystem lalung-lalo na po sa ating marine area. Ginawa ang nasabing resolution para tuwing magconduct ng assessment at monitoring ang taga PAMO-MSPLS ay mayroon representative na kasama sa bawat barangay na pupuntahan.

Dagdag ng tagapanguna na napakahalaga ng ating mga mangroves, corals at seagrass.

Sa kadahilanang wala ng iba pa katanungan sa nasabing usapin inirekomenda ni PO rep. dela Cruz ang pag-apruba at sinegundahan ni Kagawad Virgilio Diaz ng Barangay Pancol.

Ibinahagi ni Barangay Kagawad Aileen L. Rodriguez ng Bato ang kanilang proyekto tungkol sa pagtatayo ng pansamantalang collection cage para sa kabitsen (*Anadara granosa*) na gawa sa kawayan na matatagpuan sa marine area ng Barangay Bato, Taytay, Palawan. Ayon sa kanya, ito ay magsisilbing imbakan/caging ng mga bagong nakolekta kabitsen (*Anadara granosa*) hanggang sa nakatakdang oras ng pagkolekta ng inaasahang mamimili. Dagdag pa niya na maghahanap din sila ng potensyal na mamimili ng kabitsen (*Anadara granosa*) kung saan maari nilang ibigay ang nasabing

245 produkto sa dami upang magbigay ng mas maraming kita sa mga miyembro ng kanilang association.
246 Kaya hinihiling nila na mabigyan sila ng legal na permit at area para sa kanilang proyekto para
247 makapagsimula na sila sa pagproseso ng kanilang kabitsen (*Anadara granosa*) kulture.

249 PB Julito Rojo ng Libertad may concern po ako regarding sa mga kabetsin dahil may
250 nakakarating sa aming barangay na maliliit. Ang tanong ko paano dadami iyon kung maliliit palang ay
251 kinukuha at binibenta na. Sana ang kuhain ay iyong nasa tamang laki na at iyon ang ibenta nila para
252 hindi maubos at may kuhain pa.

254 Dagdag paliwanag ni PB Nava na kaya bumuo ang fisherfolk's ng Bato para sa kabitsen ay
255 para maregulate ang pangunguha, dahil hindi lang taga Barangay Bato ang nangunguha, dumarayo ang
256 taga Barangays Paglaum, Abongan, Talog, Old Guinlo, New Guinlo. Kung maaprubahan ang proyekto
257 ay maaayos ang pangunguha ng kabetsin at kung may mga taga iba barangay na mangunguha ay
258 maaari naman subalit dapat ay ibebenta sa fisherfolk's ng Bato para maalagaan, mapalaki at hindi na
259 dalhin kung saan-saan barangay. May mga sizes ng dapat kuhain na kabitsen kapag lumampas sa sizes
260 hindi na kukuhain ng negosyante dahil ito ang magpapadami para tuloy-tuloy ang pakinabang.

262 Dagdag ni PASu Pador marami uri ng shells sa Malampaya Sound hindi lamang kabitsen, ayon
263 sa ginawa pagsosona ng marine area ng Bato mayroon sona para mga fishery structures, at sa panig ng

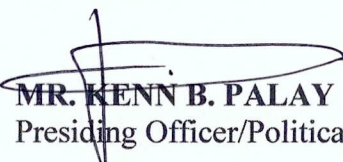

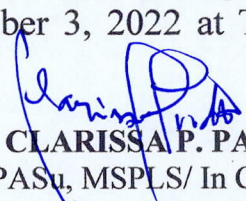


Figure II. PASu Clarissa P. Pador, presented the provisional agenda for approval of the PAMB members.
