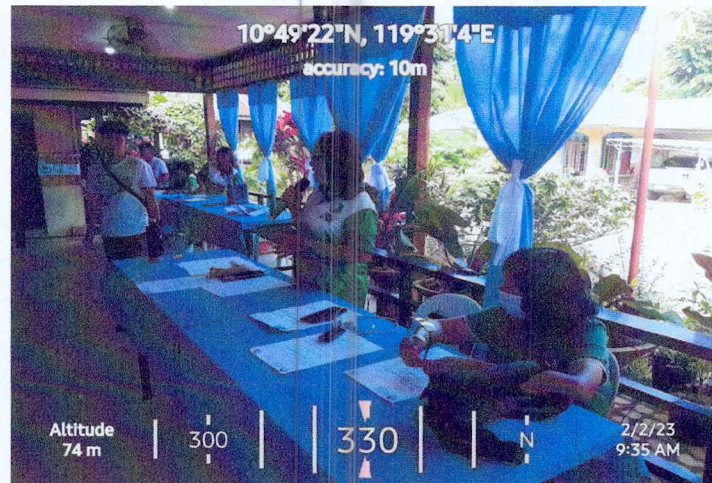

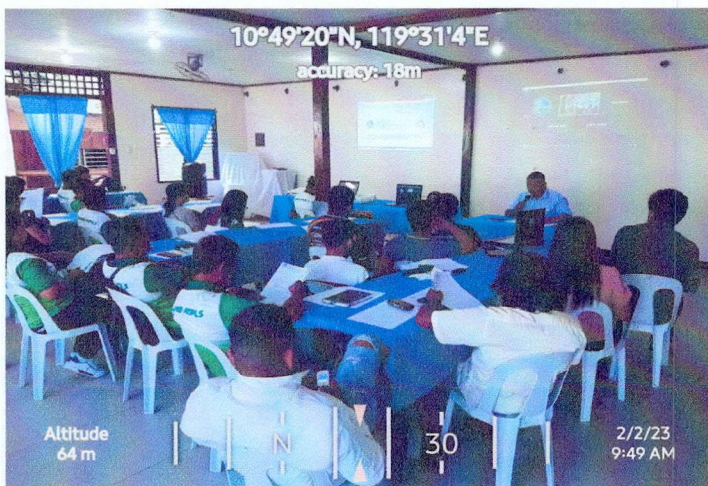


Figure III. Reading and approval of the previous meeting.

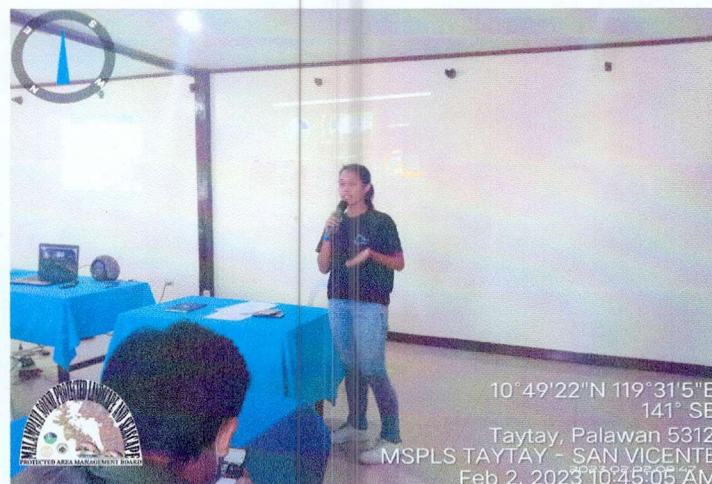
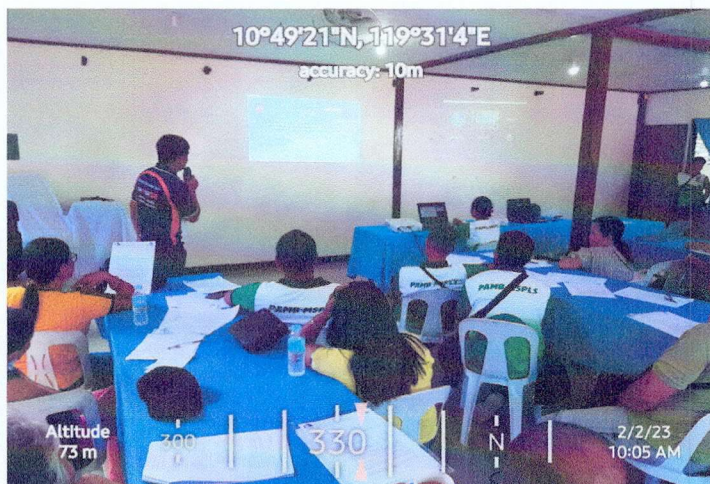


Figure IV. Mr. Felisardo Casuno of DPWH and Ms. Jessica Labaja of LAMAVE presented and discussed their project.

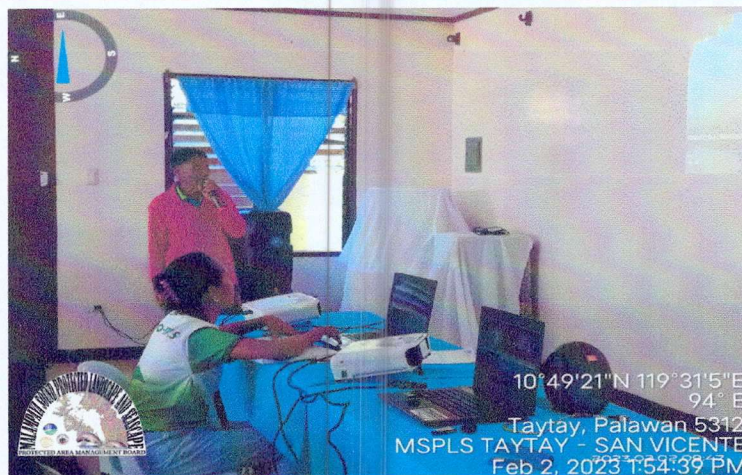

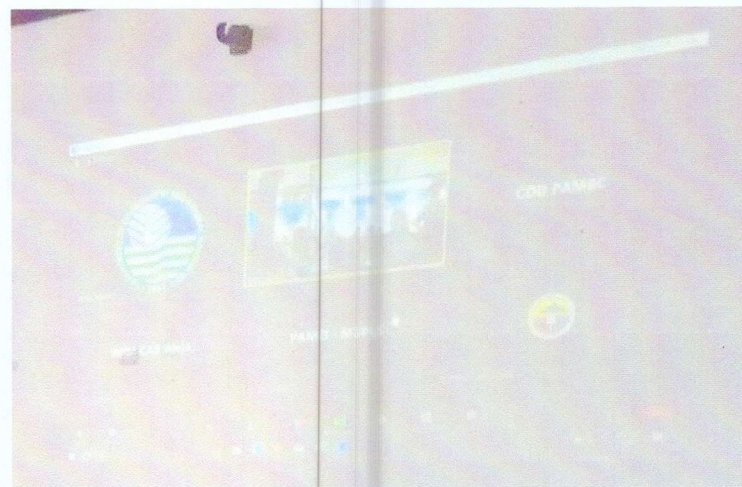
