

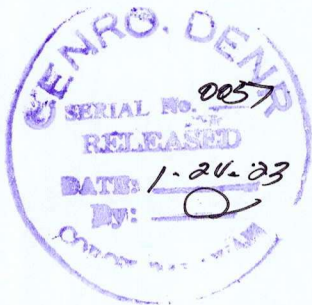


Respectfully forwarded is the report of Forest Technician II Paul Vincent P. Palao regarding the above subject.

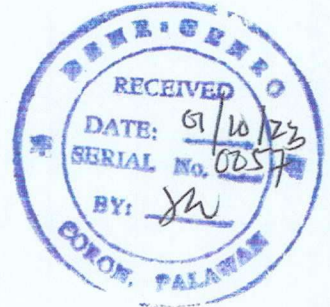




In compliance to the verbal instruction received on January 4, 2023 from MR. RODNEY G. VERIAN, OIC-CENRO of DENR Coron, the undersigned, together with the assigned Forest Protection Officer Mr. Ryan Aboratigue and with PCSDS Representative Ms. Angelica Bacus, conducted investigation and verification regarding the alleged prohibited capture or safekeeping of the above-mentioned juvenile bird species at Alligator Island, Barangay Halsey, Culion, Palawan this January 5, 2023.

Based on our investigation and ocular inspection,
the following observations were taken into account:

1. According to the property caretaker of Alligator Island, Mr. Telesforo Labitag, Jr., the said bird species was only rescued while bobbing in the seawater surrounding the island last January 1, 2023.
2. That the property caretaker noticed the said bird species had apparently plunged into the waters and been unable to flew back to safety because its feathers were already drenched with seawater.
3. He had also observed that a mother/adult hawk was trying to rescue, to save the young hawk from drowning in the seawater.
4. Since the young bird was observed to have been free from severe stress and free of any injury, the undersigned, together with the forest protection officer and PCSDS representative, released the juvenile hawk from this same island, as it is further observed that the island is also the habitat of the adults of these same bird species.

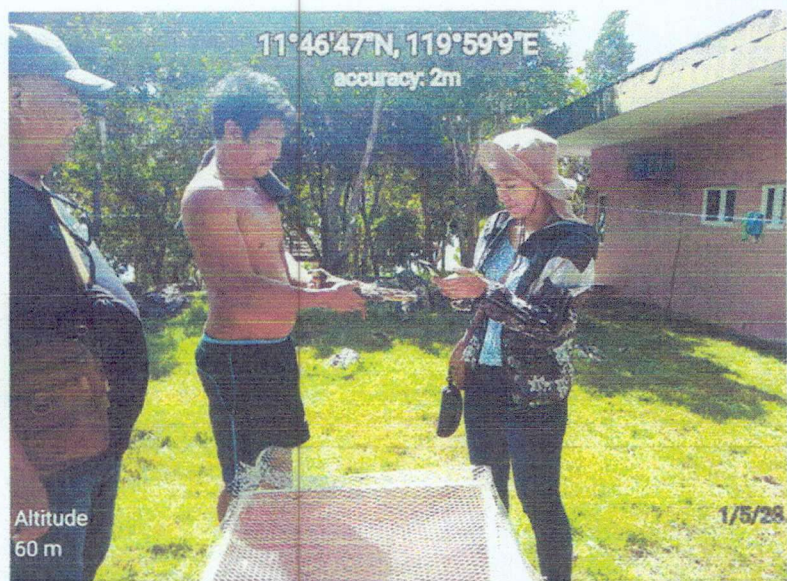
