Submitted is the accomplishment report of the coastal clean-up activity during the 2023 Wetlands Day Celebration in Barangay Dalahican, Roxas, Oriental Mindoro on February 28, 2023. The theme of the activity is "Wetland restoration" to highlight the urgent need to revive and restore degraded wetlands.

A total of 29 participants from CENRO Roxas, Barangay Officials and volunteers were present in the activity. A 250-meter shoreline clean-up activity has collected approximately 50 kilograms of garbage such as plastics, food wrappers, fish nets, and other non-biodegradable wastes. The collected garbage was turned over to the Barangay LGU for proper disposal.

**MINDORO ON FEBRUARY 28, 2023** 

In observance to the celebration of the World Wetlands Day 2023 with the theme "Wetland restoration" through various platforms to inform the public and stakeholders on the importance and conservation needs of wetlands, especially wetlands within the respective jurisdiction. This Office have organized and spearheaded the conduct of Coastal Clean-Up in Barangay Dalahican, Roxas, Oriental Mindoro on February 28, 2023. This highlights the urgent need to prioritize wetland restoration and the steps we need to take to revive and restore degraded wetlands. This is in partnership with the Barangay Captain Danny Talamisan of Dalahican, Roxas and is proactive on different environmental activities.

The barangay chosen is one of the coastal barangays in the Municipality, where the area is a nesting site for the marine sea turtle, a local tourist destination, and a fish sanctuary is located. Due to increasing population in the area, trashes and litters have been observed to be one of the environmental problems the barangay has been facing.

Please be informed that the activity was participated by the employees of Department of Environment and Natural Resources-City Environment and Natural Resources of Roxas, Oriental Mindoro headed by Engr. Caesar E. Quebec, CENR Officer and one (1) Master Teacher I of DepEd-Danggay National High School. It was composed of 7 female and 22 male participants, a total of 29. The activity started at 6:12 AM in the area. Engr. Caesar E. Quebec stated the importance of conservation of the area to all participants and the aftermath of not protecting it. One of the Barangay Counselor expressed his support and to many more environmental activities with the DENR.

The cleanup has lasted for an hour in an approximately 250-meters shoreline stretch. A total of five (5) sacks with an estimated weight of 50 kilograms of wastes/garbage such as plastics, food wrappers, old clothes, fishnets and other non-biodegradable wastes were collected. In spite of the unfavorable weather condition, the activity of coastal clean-up was pursued. The collected wastes/garbage are turned-over to the barangay for proper disposal.

In conclusion, it was observed that the site is in need of proper waste disposal and barangay must strictly impose the ordinances on such environmental laws. Hence, continuous information campaign will be conducted and coordination with the barangay LGU for strict implementation of ordinances and imposition of penalties on violation to proper solid waste management shall be done.






