

This is to inform that the undersigned staff of Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape (MMPL) Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) is under ongoing conceptualization of the MMPL activity booklet.

The CEPA officer of MMPL PAMO has downloaded GIMP, a free and open-source raster graphics editing tool used for image manipulation. The platform is used to create the main characters of the booklet as well as to design backgrounds such as trees, mountains and rivers. He starts by manually creating illustrations in a piece of paper followed by taking photo of the illustration using digital camera or cellphone. The images are then copied in the laptop and opened with GIMP. The images are then digitally enhanced and colored according to desired output.

At the moment, the CEPA officer is able to finished creating the basic design of the main characters, created few backgrounds and established the storyline as guide to develop the whole story and activities for each storyboards.

Furthermore, there are other virtual art platforms which are far better than GIMP, but require payments and registrations, therefore, choosing gimp as the primary tool for the production of the MMPL activity booklet.

Attached are geo-tagged pictures during designing of characters and conceptualizing storyline for the MMPL activity booklet using GIMP.



